HISTORIC COMEBACK LEADS TO 10-9 WIN

Down to their final six outs on Sunday, Jacksonville scored six runs in the eighth and two more in the ninth to turn a 9-2 deficit into a 10-9 victory over Memphis. Home runs on three consecutive pitches from Troy Johnston (three-run homer), Deyvison De Los Santos and Tristan Gray scored the first five tallies of the eighth. Javier Sanoja added an RBI double to make it 9-8. In the ninth, Griffin Conine's single knotted the score before an error brought home Agustín Ramírez as the winning run at 10-9 for Jacksonville's biggest come-from-behind win since June 8, 2006.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Between 2014-2022 Jacksonville had not notched a comeback of at least six runs. The Jumbo Shrimp notched a pair of come-from-behind victories of six runs during the 2023 season, but the club one-upped that on Sunday against Memphis. Down 9-2 in the bottom of the eighth, Jacksonville erupted for six runs in the eighth inning and then plated two more in the ninth to walk off on the Redbirds. The victory was Jacksonville's biggest come-frombehind win since overcoming a 7-0 deficit against Huntsville on June 8, 2006.

LADIES FIRST

Thanks to their wild comeback from a seven-run deficit on Sunday in a 10-9 win over the Redbirds, the Jumbo Shrimp earned their first home series victory in a six-game set since April 16-21, when they took four of six from Norfolk. Interestingly, Memphis scored first in all six games of last week's set with Jacksonville. Nonetheless, the Jumbo Shrimp rallied to win four games. The last time an opponent scored first in each contest of a six-game series was April 30-May 5, when Scranton/Wilkes-Barre swept Jacksonville.

WHEN THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Jacksonville catcher Will Banfield suffered through a disastrous 10-game stretch from May 30 through June 14, going 0-for-36 at the plate. In the 29 games since then, however, the Snellville, Ga. native completely turned his season around. Since this stretch began with a three-hit game on June 16, Banfield is 35-for-14, slashing .337/.368/.548/.916 with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 21 RBIs, six walks and 18 runs scored.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 28-34 (.452) record. Jacksonville has scored only 264 runs at home (4.3 per game), the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 273 (4.9 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 251 runs (4.5 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 15thfewest runs of any team at home (307, 5.0 per game).

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's eight wins during the month of August, seven have come by three runs or fewer, including five by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 41 games this season decided by one run, matching Iowa (24-17) for the most in the International League. After registering 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. Jacksonville's 77 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 65.3 percent of the club's 118 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 40-37 (.519) in those contests.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 73 of his last 85 games, notching 32 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 108for-337 (.320/.384/.484/.868) with 27 doubles, five triples. six home runs, 50 RBIs, 36 walks and 45 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja is tied for first in the International League in both doubles (29) and triples (6), fifth in batting average (.303), tied for fifth in hits (114) and tied for 13th in extrabase hits (41).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has scored at least four runs in 18 of their last 22 games (81.8 percent) They did so just three times in the previous 10 contests... The Jumbo Shrimp are just a halfgame behind the Sounds for sixth place in the second half International League standings.

ABOUT JONATHAN

-Bermúdez was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 23rd round of the 2018 draft out of Southeastern University in Lakeland, Fla.

-Bermúdez began his collegiate career at Miami-Dade College in 2014 before transferring to Polk State College (Winter Haven, Fla.) before transferring to Saint Leo University (St. Leo, Fla.). He concluded his career at Southeastern University (Lakeland, Fla.) in 2018.

-The Houston Astros' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year, Bermúdez went 5-6 with a 3.24 ERÅ across 25 appearances, including 20 starts, between Double-A Corpus Christi and Triple-A Sugar Land In 111.0 innings, he ceded just 93 hits (7.5 H/9) and 34 walks (2.9 BB/9) while striking out 146 batters (11.8 K/9).

-In 2021, Bermúdez was second of Astros minor leaguers in total strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (111.0). His combined 3.32 ERA and 4.29 strikeout-to-walk-ratio were tops of any Astros minor leaguer to log at least 70 innings pitched. His ratio of 11.8 strikeoutsper-nine-innings was second-best of Astros minor leaguers with at least 70 innings pitched.

-Grew up a fan of the New York Yankees in Coamo, Puerto Rico. His favorite player was left-handed pitcher Andy Pettitte.

-In his spare time, Bermúdez enjoys cooking, and his favorite dish is arroz con pollo.

-Jonathan has one brother, John. They are the son of Juan Bermúdez and Marcy DeJesus.

2024 SEASON

-Bermúdez was first promoted to Jacksonville on June 9 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Bermúdez was 11th among qualified pitchers in strikeouts (56) and 24th in innings pitched (48.0).

-With Pensacola, Bermúdez held right-handed hitters hit .204/.309/.425/.734 in 190 plate appearances. Left-handers batted .158/.279/.200/.479 in 108 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

-Over 251 plate appearances, right-handed hitters slashed .248/.350/.459/.809 against Bermúdez. Comparatively, Bermúdez help left-handed hitters to a .255/.314/.376/.690 line across 151 plate appearances.

-Bermúdez was released by the San Francisco Giants on March 27. He signed with the Marlins on Aprl 26.

2022 SEASON

-On August 23, 2022, Bermúdez was claimed off waivers by the San Francisco Giants. On September 1, Bermúdez was removed from the 40-man roster and sent outright to the Triple-A Sacramento River Cats. Spending the remainder of the year with Sacramento, he was 0–3 in five starts with a 9.22 ERA over 13.2 innings in which he gave up seven home runs and struck out 16 batters.
