YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a four-game losing streak with a 4-2 win over the Reading Fightin Phils. **Bryan Torres** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the fifth inning with a sac fly. **Sean Hjelle** pitched a career-high 7.0 innings and allowed one hit and no runs. Reading took a 2-1 lead in the top of the eighth inning with an RBI triple by Matt Kroon and a sac fly from Arquimedes Gamboa. In the bottom of the eighth, **Diego Rincones** put Richmond back in front with a two-run double. **Simon Whiteman** added a bases-loaded walk to extend the lead to 4-2. **Joey Marciano** picked up a pair of strikeouts to close out the save in the top of the ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only trip to Richmond this season for Reading. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium when the teams previous met from May 25-30.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10 of the last 12 games after winning 12 of the previous 16 to close within one game of first place in the division. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 9.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.92 ERA for the season.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS have lost four straight games and 15 of their last 19 games. Reading's offense is ranked 11th in the Double-A Northeast with a .228 batting average and are tied for third with 91 home runs. Reading's pitching staff is ranked 11th in the league with a 5.11 ERA. Reading's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including SS Bryson Stott (No. 2), RHP Francisco Morales (No. 3), RHP Hans Crouse (No. 4), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 21), LHP Kyle Dohy (No. 24) and RHP James McArthur (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Trenton Toplikar** makes his 12th start of the season and his 16th overall appearance. Last time out, Toplikar pitched 5.2 innings and allowed four runs (two earned) in a no-decision against the Baysox last Thursday. It was his longest start since June 18. Toplikar made his first start of the season on May 27 at Reading and allowed two runs over 3.2 innings. He has pitched in relief four times this season, posting a 0.96 ERA. Toplikar was drafted in the 16th round by the Giants in 2018 out of UC Riverside. In 2019, Toplikar began the season with High-A San Jose and made eight starts and seven relief appearances, going 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA. He was sent to Low-A Augusta on June 12 of that season and worked as a starter the rest of the year, going 5-2 with a 3.62 ERA in ten starts. **For more on Toplikar, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander Jack Perkins makes his 10th Double-A start and his first against Richmond. He last pitched last Wednesday against Somerset, allowing three runs in 4.0 innings. Perkins was selected in the 11th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Philadelphia Phillies out of Stetson. He began this season with High-A Jersey Shore, where he went 0-1 with a 5.51 ERA in five outings (three starts). Perkins was promoted to Double-A Reading on June 12. At the plate, he hit an RBI triple in his first Double-A start on June 12 against Hartford and added a solo home run in his next game on June 18 against Harrisburg. The homer is the only one hit by a pitcher in the Double-A Northeast this season. Since then, he has gone 0-for-6 at the plate.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 25 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 105 walks, which sits him tied for second in the team's history in career walks with **Jarrett Parker**. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for eighth in the circuit with 82 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 125 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .388 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history. Richmond's 80 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 24 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .307 (27-for-88) with six home runs, five doubles and 20 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 13 homers this season and second with 36 RBIs. He is hitting .170 (8-for-47) over his last 12 games since July 18 with 20 strikeouts.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .356 (21-for-59) over his last 16 games since July 15 with six doubles, one homer and five RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 13 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 30 steals in 33 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season. On Sunday, Whiteman played the center field for the first time in his professional career and made a diving catch.

TORRES ON A TEAR: **Bryan Torres** is currently riding a 12-game hitting streak dating back to July 3, which is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres is batting .378 (17-for-45) with two doubles, a triple and seven RBIs. He has picked up two hits in four of his last seven games played. Torres has also collected four RBIs in his last four games. He is batting .298 this season in 33 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.

VIRTUAL REALITY: **David Villar** is hitting .300 (9-for-30) over his last eight games since July 24, adding two doubles and one RBI. In 40 games dating back to June 16, Villar has hit .307 (46-for-150) with six homers, 12 doubles and 16 RBIs. Villar has hit 11 home runs this season, but has not homered in his last 18 games, which is his longest streak without going deep on the 2021 season.

LEFT ON BASE: Over the last 12 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .144 (15-for-104) with runners in scoring position and have left 110 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .133 (8-for-60) with the bases loaded, which is the second-lowest mark of the 120 full-season minor league teams this year.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for seventh with 48 RBIs. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 13 stolen bases. **Joey Marciano** (28/T-4th), **Frank Rubio** (27/T-6th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (27/T-6th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (26/T-8th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **RJ Dabovich** is tied for sixth in the league with six saves. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for ninth in the circuit with five saves. **Sean Hjelle** is ranked second with a 3.15 ERA, eighth with 69 strikeouts, tied for fifth with 14 starts, tied for eighth with 65.2 innings pitched, sixth with a .241 BAA, fourth with a 1.20 WHIP and sixth with a .600 winning percentage.

FREE FALLING: The Flying Squirrels have lost 10 of the last 12 games since July 21. On August 1, their record dropped .500 for the first time since May 5 (1-1). In that span, Richmond has been outscored 56-39, with losses coming an average of 1.7 runs. Four of the losses have been by one run and three have been by two runs. Prior to this stretch, the Flying Squirrels were tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron. The team has fallen back to fifth and is now nine games back.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL) and **Sean Hjelle** (14). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baseline Runner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Three players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
