NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, a remarkable 25 games over .500 at 41-16 (.719)

- 41 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 4 ahead of the next winningest team ... of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .719 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Modesto Nuts (36-15 / .706 / Mariners Single-A)
- 23 wins in May were the most of any Minor League Baseball team ... 23 wins were also the most in a single month for an MiLB team since the Ogden Raptors went 24-4 in July 2019.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 6 straight series and 27 of its last 32 games ... 23 of those 32 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 20 of the team's 27 wins in this stretch.

- Omaha is 16-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... 22 games decided by 1 run are tied for the most in the Minors ... the Chasers have won their last six 1-run games and 9 of their last 12.
- Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, but 17 of 32 games since have had a save awarded (from 7 pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors since May 1 ... **Will Klein** has 5 saves in that span, while **Carlos Hernández** has 3 **Dan Altavilla**, and **Walter Pennington** and **Sam Long** each have 2 ... **Steven Cruz** and **Evan Sisk** each have 1 save in the last 32 games.
- In total, 40 of Omaha's 57 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (71%), including 12 of 16 losses this season.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 337 to 252 this season, a +85 run differential.

- A +85 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the second-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +92.
- Omaha ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +146 (367 to 221).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 20-3 record (.870 winning %), compared to 21-13 (.618 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 26-4 (.867 winning %), while the team is just 15-12 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.556 winning %).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .203 average (4th in MiLB), while the .669 opposing OPS ranks 2nd-best and a 3.75 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 3rd-best in Triple-A.
- Last Friday's win was the 13th time this season Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run ... that is an average of once ever 4.38 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
- The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) at the Triple-A level in 2024 have come from Omaha pitchers ... **Evan Sisk** has not allowed a run over his last 14 games, 14.0 innings since April 20 ... **Dan Altavilla**'s scoreless streak ended last weekend, what was 13.2 innings over 13 games since April 23.
- LHP **Walter Pennington** has 62 strikeouts in 39.1 innings this season, largely pitching in relief (22 relief appearances/2 opener starts) ... his 62 strikeouts are 6th-most in the International League, while 50 strikeouts as a reliever lead Minor League Baseball ... his 40.8% strikeout rate is 2nd in MiLB (min. 35.0 IP).

PENNY PUNCHIES

Lefty **Walter Pennington** was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week for his performance last week in Omaha's series win over Indianapolis.

- Pennington struck out 12 batters over 6.1 scoreless innings and allowed just one hit while not walking a batter ... 12 K was tied 2nd in the league, with the most strikeouts among pitchers with 6.0 or more scoreless innings.
- He appeared in 3 games, including a start in the second game of a doubleheader sweep on Thursday ... he struck out 4 over 2.0 perfect innings in relief on Monday, tied a career high with 6 strikeouts over his 3.0-inning start and then struck out 2 over 1.2 perfect innings on Sunday to finish the game and earn the win.

JUNE SWOON

After ending May on a 4-game winning streak, the Storm Chasers have opened the month of June on a 4-game winning streak as well.

- Omaha is one of 11 full season Minor League teams that has not yet lost in the month of June, one of four Triple-A teams.

TODAY'S START

- Hoffmann is making his 5th start of the season with Omaha and his 9th start overall in 2024.
Opened the season in Omaha's rotation, but was placed on the Injured List April 17 ... made 3 rehab starts in the Arizona Complex League between May 21 and June 1, activated from Omaha's IL on June 4.

LAST OMAHA START: TUESDAY, APRIL 16 @ NASHVILLE

Made his fourth start of the season and struggled, unable to make it out of the 2nd inning ... in the 1st inning, hit two batters and walked one, but stranded the bases loaded ... in the 2nd inning, allowed 5 runs (2 earned) and couldn't finish the inning, as a leadoff error was followed by a double, two-run homer, three singles and another double, with a pair of strikeouts worked in ... placed on the IL the next day.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games (1 start) and went 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (1 ER in 4.2 IP), with 4 strikeouts.
In his 2024 season debut on March 31 vs. Iowa, retired 15 of his final 18 after the homer, including his last 7 straight.
Made 3 rehab appearances with the Arizona Complex League Royals (R) and combined to allow 1 unearned run over 6.0 innings, with a walk and 8 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Opened the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and made 19 starts for the Nationals with 1 relief appearance (as the bulk pitcher) before getting promoted to Triple-A on August 12, where he ended the season ... combined to go 7-9 with a 5.53 ERA (77 ER in 125.1 IP) and 133 strikeouts (9.55 K/9) between the Nationals and Storm Chasers.
Was supposed to make his Triple-A debut on August 13 vs. Iowa (CHC), but the game was rained out ... instead pitched twice in next series, including his Triple-A debut August 15 at Toledo (DET), where he retired 6 of his first 7 with 3 strikeouts, before allowing a 5-run third inning ... tied a season-high at the time with 8 strikeouts on August 20 at Toledo, but also set a career-high with 6 walks.
Threw exactly 5.0 innings in 5 of his last 6 Omaha starts ... held his opponent to 5 hits or less & 3 runs or less in 6 of his last 7 Chasers starts.
2022: Split his season between the Rome Braves (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) traded from the Braves to the Royals on July 11 along with OF Drew Waters and INF CJ Alexander for a draft pick (Competitive Balance A, #35 overall).
Opened the season with the Rome and made 15 starts in the South Atlantic League, going 7-2 with a 2.36 ERA (21 ER in 80.0 IP), with 90 strikeouts to just 21 walks (4.29 K/BB) ... promoted to the Mississippi Braves (AA) on July 8 but did not appear in a game for the M-Braves, with the team three days before being traded.
Threw at least 5.0 innings in 13 of his 15 starts with the Rome Braves, seven of them being at least 6.0 innings, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts on April 27 vs. Greensboro (PIT) and June 16 at Asheville (COL) ... recorded three scoreless starts, including 2 of his last 3.
Recorded a career-high 13.0-inning scoreless streak from June 16 to 29 spanning parts of 3 starts ... also did not allow a run across his last 9.0 innings in the Braves system before the trade, ending with 6.0 shutout innings July 6 vs. Asheville, where he struck out eight.

- 2021: Before being drafted, pitched for the Mahoning Valley Scrappers in the first year of MLB's Draft League, 1 of 39 players to be drafted from the circuit when the Braves took him in the 12th round ... over 5 relief appearances, allowed 2 earned runs in 7.2 innings, striking out 13.
Ended his season with a pair of back-to-back scoreless starts for a total of 12.0 scoreless innings, named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week both weeks to end the year ... on September 9 vs. Columbia (KC), threw 5.0 hitless innings against the in the second game of a doubleheader ... on September 15 @ Myrtle Beach (CHC), threw 7.0 innings and allowed 3 hits with a season-high 8 strikeouts.

- COLLEGE (2019-2021): Pitched 3 years at 3 schools with a 34-game undefeated streak to end his collegiate career that stretched back to his last start at Oakland as a freshman ... including summer ball, went 16-0 in those starts and allowed 3 runs or less in 31 of 34 starts.
JUNIOR (2021), ILLINOIS: Served as the team's Friday night starter, making 11 starts and led the Fighting Illini with a 2.87 ERA and 62.2 IP ... named All-Big Ten Third Team, going 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA (20 ER in 62.2 IP) and 64 strikeouts to 15 walks ... only the sixth Illini pitcher since 1980 to not suffer a loss in a season (min. 10 starts).
SOPHOMORE (2020), JOHN A. LOGAN CC: Across five starts (26.0 IP), went 5-0 with a 2.08 ERA, 7 walks and 46 strikeouts.
FRESHMAN (2019), OAKLAND UNIVERSITY: Started 12 of 13 games (56.0 IP), went 2-6 with a 6.75 ERA, 33 walks and 46 strikeouts ... second on the team in ERA and third in innings pitched ... in the summer of 2019, played for the Traverse City Pit Spitters of the Northwoods League and was named the 2019 Northwoods League Pitcher of the Year and 2019 Northwoods League All-Star.

- MISCELLANEOUS: 2018: Graduated from Plainfield East HS, where he was a two-year letterwinner and played for head coach Adam O'Reel ... was named All-Southern Prairie Conference, has the Plainfield High School all-time strikeout record.
Is color blind, mixes up red/orange and blue/purple ... doesn't affect his everyday life.
Uses conditioner and coconut oil to maintain his curly hair, has been growing it out for the last 3 years.
