**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones opened up the road trip with a convincing 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (3.2 IP), RHP **Jace Beck** (2.1), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.2), RHP **Michael Krauz** (0.1), and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (1.0) combined on a 5-hit shutout...Beck earned his 3rd win and tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts...C **Kevin Parada** started the scoring with an RBI single and RF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a 2-run double...Parada and SS **William Lugo** each registered multi-hit games for Brooklyn...All 9 batters reached base at least once for the Cyclones...BlueClaws LF **Marcus Lee Sang** tallied 2 knocks and reached base 4 times.

**LET'S PLAY TWO!** The Cyclones will play in their 3rd doubleheader of the 2023 season on Wednesday...Brooklyn was swept in their initial twinbill on May 10 at Wilmington...Cyclones dropped the opener, 7-4, and the nightcap, 7-1...Brooklyn served as the home team in Game 2...The 'Clones split their last double-dip on May 21 at Hudson Valley...Brooklyn tosses a shutout in the opener, 6-0, and lost the nightcap in 9 innings, 3-2...In 2022, the Cyclones played in 10 twinbills, registering a split record of 10-10...This is Brooklyn's first doubleheader against Jersey Shore since June 3, 2022, at Shore-Town Ballpark...The Cyclones dropped the lid-lifter, 2-1, and won the finale, 2-1.

**THE DONUT SHOPPE:** Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occurred in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that day.

**THEY'RE NO. 1:** The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 12 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 15 earned runs (22 total) on 69 hits through the last 106.2 innings...That is good for a 1.27 ERA...That mark is a full run better than the 2nd-best mark in the SAL and High-A (Greenville, 2.41)...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Class-A Columbia is 2nd (1.98)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 43 (10.1 BB%) and struck out 133 in that span (31.4 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 58-22, over the 12-game stretch...Brooklyn is 9-3 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones have the only sub-4 ERA in the SAL with a league-best 3.75 mark.

**BULL-PEN ON PARADE:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.17) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Rome (3.51) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.35) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 5th best in all of MiLB...The 3.26 ERA is 5th best in all of Minor League Baseball...RHP **Paul Gervase** (0.52), RHP **Wilkin Ramos** (2.08), and RHP **Manny Rodríguez** (2.66) have all mustered sub-3 ERA's in relief for the 'Clones (min 15.0 IP).

**AT HIS BECK-ON CALL:** RHP **Jace Beck** has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strike-out rate of 45.1% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is 4th in strikeout rate (45.1%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is 2nd-best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cleveland's RHP **Tyler Thornton** (20.40) leads at High-A Lake County.

**BLADE RUNNER:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball...Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him...In that span, the 2022 2nd-round pick is tied for 3rd in the SAL in strikeouts (19).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** C **Kevin Parada** added another two-base hit on Sunday afternoon and is tied with Hudson Valley's OF **Spencer Jones** and Greenville's INF **Baze Jordan** for 2nd in the SAL in doubles (13)...Only Winston-Salem OF **Wilfred Veras** (20) has collected more...In May, Parada is also 3rd in the circuit in two-baggers (9) and tied for 4th in the league in extra-base hits (13).

**RAMÍ ROCKETS:** OF **Alex Ramírez** has reached base safely in 10-straight games since May 18...In that time, the 20-year-old is slashing .289/.386/.474 with a .860 OPS...Ramírez has 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 6 walks in those contests...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (103), doubles (25), RBI (57), and total bases (154)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (36) in extra-base hits (34).

**THRILL OF THE 'CHASE':** After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** has picked

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs **Orion Kerker** (25) and RHP **Tommy McCollum** (29) are featured...INF **Hao Yu Lee** (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30...The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...The former Kentucky Wildcat had a 9-game hitting streak stretching back to May 14 at Wilmington snapped on Sunday...In his last 17 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .305/.359/.525 with a .885 OPS...Estep has accumulated 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, and 10 RBI in 64 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 135 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 14 of those 17 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 149 points in that time (.047 to .196).

**IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Wednesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (179), at-bats (589), plate appearances (705), runs scored (93), walks (96), and stolen bases (44)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) last Tuesday, added an RBI on Saturday, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (189), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (111).

**OMAR ON THE RUN:** In addition to his 18 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 88 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (94), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (93)...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 37...Omar is already 14 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**BIG STU:** At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old had his scoreless inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings on Sunday, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.13) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP **Dustin Saenz** (2.03)...Stuart is also 6th in the circuit in WHIP (1.15) and tied for 8th in batting average against (.213)...The Kankakee, Ill. native is also 1st inLOB% (89.4%), 2nd in FIP (2.89), 3rd in xFIP (3.51), and 5th in strikeout rate (30.8%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

**RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN:** RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has faced only one batter over the minimum...In 4 appearances, Tebrake has not allowed a run and walked only 2 over 6.0 innings, registering 8 strikeouts.

**GREAT SCOTT!** RHP **Christian Scott** punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory on Saturday vs. Winston-Salem...The Coconut Creek, Fla. native posted 5 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of last Sunday's double-header at Hudson Valley, Scott has not yielded a run on 2 hits over 9 innings...The former Florida Gator has not walked a hitter and punched out 10...In 4 starts since returning to Brooklyn on May 5, Scott is 1-0 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER in 14.2 IP), 1 walk, 15 K's, and a WHIP of 0.82.

**JEFE JEFFREY:** RHP **Jeffrey Colón** matched his then-team-season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C **Kevin Parada** and CF **Alex Ramírez**...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include **Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), **Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (24/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.
