LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox scored two runs in the final two innings to come from behind and defeat Erie 2-1 in the penultimate game of the regular season. **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** drove in **Dylan Beavers** from third on an RBI groundout to tie the game at one in the eighth before a sacrifice bunt throwing error by Tyler Owens scored **Douglas Hodo III** from second in the ninth. **Jakob Hernandez** recorded his first win of the season with two scoreless innings and three strikeouts. It's the third one-run victory of the series for the Baysox.

ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has reached safely in 20 of his first 26 games at the Double-A level. The Orioles No. 4 prospect stole his 72nd base of the season on Friday, which is the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield has 17 games with multiple stolen bases overall this season and eight multi-hit games already for Bowie. Bradfield is hitting .400 (16-for-40) against Erie this season.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is one of two players in the Eastern League with at least 15 homers and at least 30 stolen bases and one of four players to do so in all of Double-A. Beavers is also tied for second in the Eastern League in walks (67) and is fourth in stolen bases (31). His .343 on-base percentage leads the team as he has reached base in 93 of 118 games played.

CAN YOU TAKE ME HIGHER?

C **Creed Willems** is raking in his final series of the regular season. The 21-year-old is 7-for-16 (.438) with a double, homer and six RBI this week. On Wednesday, he delivered his first three hit and four RBI game at Double-A, going 3-for-5 with four RBI and a two-run homer. The Orioles No. 22 prospect has slugged 34 homers since the beginning of the 2023 season.

DOUGIE DOUBLES

After going 1-for-20 to start his Double-A tenure, OF **Douglas Hodo III** is now batting .524 (11-for-21) over his last six games with six doubles and three RBI. Six of his 12 Double-A hits have gone for two bags. Hodo has also stolen 50 bases on the season between High-A and Double-A, tied for second-most in the O's system.

MILESTONE COMPLETE

In the third inning of yesterday's game, RHP **Trace Bright** recorded Bowie's 1,305th strikeout of the season, setting a new single-season franchise record. The 2022 Baysox previously held the all-time strikeout record (1,304). Bowie is second in all of Double-A in strikeouts (1,311) this season.

A WIN TODAY WOULD...

A win today would complete Bowie's first series victory in a month. The Baysox last series win was from August 13-18 at Altoona when they took four of six against the Curve. Bowie would close out the regular season with an overall record of 63-74 and a second half record of 31-38. The Baysox have already won the season series over Erie.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the first half Southwest Division champion Erie SeaWolves are 36-26 in the second half as they look to defend their title. The Double-A Affiliate of the Detroit Tigers most recently won four of six in Reading, including the last four in a row. Erie's active roster currently includes only one of the Tigers' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), which is RHP Eric Silva (No. 29). Tigers No. 2 prospect Jackson Jobe was recently promoted to Triple-A Toledo.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Angel Reyes makes his third start of the season and his 22nd appearance for Erie in what is expected to be a bullpen game for the playoff-bound SeaWolves. Reyes has bounced around this year between High-A West Michigan and Triple-A Toledo. This is Bowie's first time facing Reyes this season. The 26-year-old was drafted by the Tigers in 2018 in the 19th round out of NAIA University of Science & Arts in Chickasha, Oklahoma.
