LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones rallied to stun the Renegades, 8-7, on Friday night at Heritage Financial Park...Down a run entering the 9th, Brooklyn took the lead thanks to run-scoring singles by CF Rhylan Thomas and C Kevin Parada, as well as a ground out...Hudson Valley scored on an error in the bottom of the 9th, but 3B William Lugo made a diving stop on a 3B Marcos Cabrera ground ball to get a force at 2nd base to end the game...LHP Eli Ankeney registered the final 2 outs for his first career save...All 9 Cyclones in the lineup picked up at least 1 hit...LF Alex Ramírez robbed a home run in the 2nd and set a franchise record with a 6-for-6 night at the plate with 3 runs scored, 3 stolen bases, and an RBI...RF Stanley Consuegra, DH Chase Estep, SS Junior Tillen, and Thomas all tallied multi-hit performances...Thomas and Lugo each drove in 2...2B D'Andre Smith also recorded an inside-the-park home run in the 7th...CF Spencer Jones and RF Christopher Familia had 3-hit nights for Hudson Valley, with the latter driving in 2...1B Spencer Henson clubbed a solo home run for the 'Gades in the 2nd.

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on Friday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Ramírez is the first Cyclone with 5+ hits in a game since 2B Luke Ritter went 5-for-6 vs. Lowell on June 28, 2019...He is 1-of-2 players in franchise history (since 2005) with 5+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...CF Gregory González went 5-for-6 and stole 3 bases on August 18, 2005, vs. Williamsport... Since the start of June, Alex is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32), 3rd in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.035), and tied for 4th in walks (24) (min. 170 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (72) and is 19 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He is 2nd in doubles (31), 3rd in hits (135), tied for 3rd in total bases (198) with OF Antoine Duplantis and 4th in runs scored (72).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The 33 swipes break INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 102 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (108), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (108), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (108), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (105) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 61 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 42.

AROUND THE CAROUSEL: 2B D'Andre Smith picked up his first home run as a Cyclone with an inside-the-parker in the 7th on Friday night at Hudson Valley...lt was the 2nd inside-the-park home run clubbed by Brooklyn in 2023...C Kevin Parada capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of June 23's win vs. Hudson Valley...They are the first 2 inside-the-park home runs by Cyclones players since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by Joe Jiannetti on July 19, 2001.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Friday night, the Cyclones jumped over .500 on the season at 44-43...Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn has won 11-of-14 (.786) and 17-of-23 (.739) going into Saturday's contest...The Cyclones are 16-6 in the second half and lead the North Division of the SAL by half a game over Aberdeen (15-6)...Brooklyn is percentage points (.727) behind Hickory (15-5; .750) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 17th come-from-behind victory and 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...Friday night marked Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings...The first came in July 7's win at Wilmington...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

HIT 'EM UP: The Cyclones tallied a season-high 18 hits in their 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 18 knocks were the most by Brooklyn in a single game since they accrued 19 hits in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The Cyclones' offense has racked up double-digit hits in 6 of their last 13 games dating back to July 4's series opener at Wilmington...Since that date, Brooklyn is 10-3 and averages 9.46 hits-per-game and 5.38 runs-per-contest.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.75 ERA (149 ER in 488.0 IP) over their last 56 games, holding a 33-23 record in that span...The Cubs' Single-A Myrtle Beach (3.18) is 2nd in the minors and traisl the 'Clones by nearly half a run (0.43)...The Cyclones have hurled 6 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 11.3%...Addinonally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted fewer home runs (21) than any other squad and holds the lowest opposing OPS (6.06), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.71) in that time period...RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.70) and Tyler Stuart (1.71) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 50.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.14) in the entire South Atlantic League and throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.16) is 2nd in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.52) is 2nd in the circuit.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...Tidwell has earned the win in 5 of his last 6 outings with Brooklyn winning all 6 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 25 hits over 38.0 innings...He has walked only 10 (6.9 BB%) and struck out 47 (32.4 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 11 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 7-0 with a 1.70

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns to the road to open a 6-game road trip against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Spencer Jones (7), RHP Drew Thorpe (8), and C Antonio Gómez (29)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21 and the first meeting on Coney Island from June 20-25...The Cyclones went 4-2 in both sets, taking 4-straight games to close out the most recent series...The Cyclones are 136-139 (.495) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

ERA (11 ER in 58.1 IP) with just 35 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 30 and struck out 80 (34.0 k%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .172 batting average (35-204) against him...In that time, Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League and is 2nd in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (80)...Tiple-A Louisville's RHP Connor Phillips (82) leads the minors...He is also 2nd in batting average against (172) behind former teammate and current Double-A Binghamton RHP Christian Scott (169) and ERA (1.70) since that date (min. 50.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (195), is tied for 2nd in wins (7), 3rd in strikeouts (107), 4th in ERA (3.29), 8th in innings pitched (76.2), and 10th in WHIP (1.25).

PARADA POWER: C Kevin Parada registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on Saturday, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif, native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-homer games in the same season...INF Nick Evans powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .313/.378/.563 with a .940 OPS and 151 wRC+ in 33 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches... The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Saturday ranked 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33) and doubles (19), and 6th in hits (22) and total bases (139)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 2nd in total bases (72), tied for 3rd in hits (40), 5th in slugging (563), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (15) and home runs (7), 7th in OPS (.941), and 8th in batting average (.313).

ACE GERVASE: RHP Paul Gervase has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 24 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 2nd in ERA (1.19) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 35.0 IP)...The 2022 12th-round pick is 3rd in MiLB in opposing batting average (127)...Since June 6, Gervase holds a 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP) with a hold and 4 saves over 11 relief outings...In MiLB, the former Louisiana State arm is 3rd in opposing batting average (.094) among MiLB relievers (min 15.0 IP), tied for 3rd in hits allowed (5), 4th in opposing OPS (.363), 6th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (15.75), and 7th in ERA (0.56)...He holds a strikeout rate of 43.8% in that time.

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .315/.384/.589 with a .973 OPS and a 154 wRC+...In 20 games, Lugo is hitting .315 (23-73) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, and 9 walks (10.5 BB%) to only 10 strikeouts (11.6 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 42 points (181 to .223)...Among SAL players, Lugo is 2nd in RBI (20), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (11), 7th in slugging percentage (.589), tied for 7th in total bases (43), and 8th in OPS (.973) since that date.

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF Rhylan Thomas made a spectacular game-saving catch to close out Brooklyn's 4-3 win at Hudson Valley on Thursday night...The 23-year-old also picked 2 hits and RBI on Friday and enters Saturday on a 6-game hitting streak...Thomas is 8-for-20 (400) at the plate with a 1.005 OPS, 4 runs scored, a home run, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...In 9 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 11-for-31 (355) at the dish with an .852 OPS, 4 runs scored, a home run, 6 RBI, and 3 walks to only 2 strikeouts.

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF Stanley Consuegra collected his first career multi-home run game for Brooklyn on Wednesday afternoon...The 22-year-old ripped a solo home run in the 4th and 6th innings, the latter of which traveled an estimated 464 feet...Consuegra is the 3rd different Cyclone to tally a multi-home run game in 2023, joining C Drake Osborn (6/17) and C Kevin Parada (6/23 & 7/15)...He has also tallied 3-straight multi-hit games since Wednesday (6-for-13)...The Dominican native has picked up at least one hit in 14-of-17 games since being reinstated...In that time, Consuegra ranks tied for 4th in the circuit in home runs (4) and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (8).

JUNIOR MINT: INF Junior Tilien clubbed a go-ahead 3-run home run with 2 out in the 9th on July 7 at Wilmington as part of a multi-hit night...The 20-year-old has picked up a knock in 12 of his last 4 games entering Friday...Tilien is 17-for-his-last-54 (.315) with 8 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, and 4 walks...During the streak, Tilien is slashing .315/.362/.574 with a .936 OPS and 149 wRC+.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP Cameron Foster has found his groove on the bump over the last few weeks...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-0 record with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER in 28.2 IP) with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts over 6 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.6% from his overall numbers (26.5% from 22.9%) and his walk rate is down 1.5% (8.5% from 10.0%)

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), RHP Tyler Stuart (18), and RHP Jordany Ventura (22)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no-decision on Sunday afternoon vs. Greensboro...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 4.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a season-high-tying 8...Tossed 67 pitches and 42 strikes (62.7%)...Relieved by RHP Brendan Hardy to start the top of the 5th with Brooklyn leading, 3-0...Grasshoppers scored 8 in the 5th and 5 in the 6th and went on to defeat the Cyclones, 13-5...Game was pushed back 2 hours due to weather and featured an 11-minute delay.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-yearold set a new-career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 6 appearances (5 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds a 2-2 record with a 3.65 ERA (10 ER in 24.2 IP), 11 walks (11.1 BB%), and 35 strikeouts (35.4 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with a 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by Baseball America...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
