

The Brady Bunch

Brady Basso, Jack Cushing and Tyler Baum combined on a six-hit shutout and Lazaro Armenteros drove in all three runs as the RockHounds won their third straight over Frisco, blanking the RoughRiders, 3-0, Thursday night at Momentum Bank Balipark.

Basso turned in the finest performance of his pro career (see "Baseball Basics," below) going five in and allowing just three hits, with no walks and five strikeouts, to earn the win.

Drew Swift set the table twice ... with a walk in the first inning and a double to left-center in the third ... and Armentiros the rest with a two-run home run to the right field short porch in the first and a line drive RBI single to center in the last of the third.

The first two hits Basso allowed were wiped away on a pair of outstanding 6.4-3 double plays, turned by Swift, Casey Yamauchi (see "Kibbles & Bits, below) and William Simoneit. Frisco loaded the bases with one out in the eighth, but Baum struck out Jax. Biggers (who has homered twice in the series) and got Rangers top prospect Evan Carter on a ground out to escape the jam.
