TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve open the second half of the season with a six-game set against the Chesapeake Baysox. The Curve are 7-4 against them this year, taking 4-of-6 of the games in a series in late-April.

Trey Gibson makes his first start against the Curve this year and ranks as the No. 14 prospect in the Orioles system according to MLB Pipeline. A power arm, Gibson opted to attend Liberty after the draft was shortened to 5 rounds in 2020 he opened eyes with a standout freshman season, regressed as a sophomore and was suspended for his junior year, signing with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent after a stint in the Cape Cod League in 2023. A Virginia native, Gibson's father played football at Catholic University of America and his uncle, Zach, played football at Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

A NEW GUY WHO THROWS HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin blew away the Baysox in his Double-A debut on Tuesday, June 24. Harbin, who has not allowed a run since May 13, covering 18.1 innings, set down all 5 men he faced in his team debut, earning 3 strikeouts. <u>Since he last allowed a run on May 13, Harbin is 1-0 in 18.1 IP, 9 H, 11 BB, 29 K (.150 BAA)</u>. He has tossed a scoreless outing in 20-of-23 outings this season between Greensboro and Altoona.

Righty Brandon Bidois tossed two scoreless on Wednesday, June 25 at Chesapeake for his Double-A debut. Bidois struck out three of the 14 batters by Curve pitchers in the win. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 16-of-18 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in nine of his 18 outings this year, totaling 31 striekouts in 25.0 innings this year.

ONE HALF IN THE BOOKS: The Curve fit in 68-of-69 scheduled games in the first half, finished 9th among Eastern League teams with a .218 batting average and 7th with a 3.97 team ERA. Mitch Jebb finished the first half 7th in BB (34) and 8th in SB (18). Jebb reached base safely in 10-of-his-last-12 games and ranked 5th among Pirates Minor Leaguers with a .365 OBP. RHP **Wilber Dotel** ranked 3rd in the league with 74 K's, 9th in ERA (3.54), 6th in WHIP (1.18) and 8th in BAA (.226).

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 39 batters this season, third-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 32-of-33 career outings with the Curve, racking up 71 in 52.1 IP.

THE TERMINATOR AGES: Infielder Termarr Johnson, who has not yet faced a pitcher younger than him in his professional career, turned 21 on June 11. Johnson played 67 games at Double-A, the third-most by a player under the age of 21 in franchise history. Andrew McCutchen (138 games) and Jose Tabata (83 games) are the only players in franchise history to play more games than Johnson before their 21st birthday.

In his last 14 games, Johnson is 17-for-55 (.309) with 2 2B and 3 RBI. He had his first 3-hit game of the season on June 20 against Richmond and has 6 multi-hit games in his last 14.

WEATHERFORD BOYS: The Curve roster features two Weatherford, TX natives in Beau Burrows and Brenden Dixon. Burrows, who signed with the Pirates on May 12 out of the Mexican League has tossed 6 scoreless outings with Altoona allowing just 1 hit and 2 walks with 10 strikeouts in 8.1 innings.

Dixon is batting .310/.434/.476/.910 OPS in his last 16 games, recording four multi-hit games since May 27. He's reached base safely in 13-of-16 games.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel has used a vastly improved splitter this season to become a true strikeout artist. This season, he holds a 21.1% K-BB%, he recorded an 11.2% mark in 2024 with Greensboro. Dotel holds a career-best K/9 rate (10.92) and has dropped his BB/9 from 4.57 in 2024 to 2.95 in 2025. He has struck out at least 7 batters in a start 7times in 13 starts. Following his start on June 18, he ranks 3rd in the Eastern League in strikeouts (74), 6th in IP (61.0), T-1st in GS (13), 9th in BAA (.226), 8th in WHIP (1.18).

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 8 of his 13 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count in the first half of the year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 15 in 48.2 IP. His 2.77̈ BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league champion-ship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.


