Today: It's Lug-Con, with vendors and a free comic book giveaway, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth of a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs, High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. Lansing opened the homestand with a six-game split against Dayton and has lost three of the first four games in this series, leaving the Nuts 4-6 during their current 12-game, 13-day homestand.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa handle the MiLB TV call, while Brendan King has the call for South Bend.

Yesterday: Cubs 3, Lugnuts 0. South Bend became the first team to blank the Nuts, thanks to a combined five-hitter from Drew Gray, Koen Moreno and Jose Romero. Pedro Ramirez slugged a two-run homer to supply the offense; CJ Rodriguez went 2-for-3 and Jake Garland tossed three scoreless innings in the loss.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a special Cinco de Mayo celebration on a Capital City Market Kids Day. Then the Nuts head on the road next week for a six-game series at Great Lakes, returning home Tuesday, May 14th, for a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

- \* Explain this one: Euribiel Ángeles, carrying a .262 batting average this season, is hitting .238 (5-for-21) when ahead in the count. However, when behind in the count, Ángeles is hitting .297 (11-for-37).
- \* In games following a loss, **Dereck Salom** is batting .294 (5-17) with an OBP of .429, compared to .188 (1-14) following a win.
- \* CJ Rodriguez, batting .241 this season, is 10-33 (.303) with the bases empty.
- \* Will Simpson has not collected any hits yet in the eighth or ninth inning, but he has drawn five walks in the eighth and seven walks in the ninth.

Getting the Call: 2021-22 Lansing Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris went 0-for-3 in his Major League debut for the A's last night, thus becoming the 186th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors. Harris joins Max Schuemann as Lugs to make their MLB debut in 2024.

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 1-for-3 with a double and a walk yesterday; he has reached base in 22 of 23 games and ranks 3rd in the Midwest League in batting average (.351), tied for 1st in walks (23), 3rd in OBP (.495), 2nd in OPS (1.053), tied for 2nd in triples (2) and tied for 4th in RBIs (20).

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 21 walks place him 4th in the league; Brayan Buelvas is tied for 2nd in runs scored (21); and Buelvas and Henry Bolte are tied for 4th in stolen bases (10).

Trouble on the Bases: The Nuts had three runners caught stealing yesterday, continuing a theme of this series. On Tuesday, the Lugnuts had two runners nabbed on the bases, though they also successfully swiped three bases. On Wednesday, they went 2-for-2 in steals. But on Thursday, Colby Halter was thrown out twice and Henry Bolte was picked off. All told, eight Lugnuts have been tagged out on the bases.

A Grand Start: On April 3, Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 28). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and made his 2024 Midwest League debut last night; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

## **History vs. South Bend**

The Nuts are 207-187 all-time vs. South Bend, 97-88 in Lansing and 110-99 in The Bend.

The Lugnuts played at South Bend each of the last two years, winning three of five in 2023 and losing four of six in 2022 (no-hitting the Cubs in the finale). The last time the Cubs played in Lansing from June 1-6, 2021, a series split.

## **Today in Lugnuts History**

**2010:** Trailing 5-2 to South Bend, Ryan Goins singled and scored in the bottom of the 8th and then capped a two-run game-tying rally in the 9th with an RBI single. It went for naught, though, as the Silver Hawks scored two runs in the 11th for a 7-5 win. South Bend DH Matt Davidson went 4-for-5 with a single, a double, and two homers off starter Ryan Shopshire, scoring three runs and driving in four.

**2015:** Magic Man! The Lugnuts appeared on the verge of blowing a 7-2 lead, but second baseman Tim Locastro made a ridiculous diving stop on a Franklin Navarro potential RBI single sizzler that hopped off the pitcher's mound with a headlong lunge, popped to his feet, raced to second for a force, and whipped a throw to first base to end the game. The Nuts beat the Whitecaps 7-6 at Cooley Law School Stadium.


**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

**2022 Professional Debut:** After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightly in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

**2023 with the Lugnuts:** Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

**Setting the Tone:** Dominated as the Lugnuts' Opening Night starter, April 5 at Dayton, needing only 51 pitches (40 strikes) to toss five scoreless innings... retired first 12 batters, allowed leadoff single to Cam Collier in the 5th, then mowed through final three batters... finished with six strikeouts... Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson completed the four-hit shutout in a 1-0 victory, the only run supplied by a Cameron Masterman RBI double in the sixth inning.

**Third Time's a Charm:** Career stats in Lansing: 3 yrs., 3.79, 12 G, 6 GS, 40.1 IP, 18 BB, 45 K - 2023: promoted from Stockton on August 15, to replace the promoted Brady Basso, and impressed in four appearances to conclude the year.

- 2022: five appearances from April 14-May 10, transferred to Stockton for the rest of the year.

**The Bigger Picture:** After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... in 2023, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation, before he was called up to the Midwest League.

**Changing Things Up:** Former Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels, who broke out last season, earning a trip to the Arizona Fall League and a spot in Double-A to begin this season, credits James for teaching him his change-up grip last year while with Stockton.

**Los Canaleros:** Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team in 2023... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out... the best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.
