PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 28 games over .500 with a 61-33 record (.649 winning percentage).

- 61 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .645 winning percentage overall this year is the 2nd-best in the Minors, trailing the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (58-31 / .652), Milwaukee's High-A team.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

60 of Omaha's 94 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 33 losses in 2024, with 12 of 33 losses by just one run (36%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 9 of its last 18 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 19-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 29 saves are tied for the 5th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A and the top mark in the league ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank tied for 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 538 to 433 this season, a +105 run differential.

- A +105 run differential this year ranks as the 2nd best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, trailing the Syracuse Mets (+107).
- Omaha is 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers and Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +155.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 34 games (since June 5), a .988 fielding percentage (16 errors in 1,312 total chances) is the BEST in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 10th in Triple-A and tied 10th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 14 of the team's last 20 games ... Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, with a stretch of errors in 6 straight games from June 29 to July 4 ... a 2-error game this past Sunday was Omaha's first game with more than 1 error in exactly 2 months.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 34 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 13 of the 34 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning, including Sunday's victory when trailing from the first pitch of the game, into the bottom of the 9th inning.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a .213 opponents' average, which ranks as tied for the 10th-best in the Minors ... a 1.37 bullpen WHIP is tied for the Triple-E lead and a 3.90 bullpen ERA is 4th in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 22 games this year, roughly one in every 4.23 games.
- Evan Sisk has not allowed an earned run since June 9, a stretch of 15 games and 12.2 innings ... in that span, he's allowed just 4 hits and has 15 strikeouts.
