BULLPEN KEEPS GETTING BETTER: Tyler Hampu and Yanzel Correa combined for 5 scoreless innings of relief on Thursday night ending in Hampu earning his first win. The Grizzlies pitching staff has posted a 2.87 ERA, the lowest in all of Single-A in the last month. The bullpen's 4.06 ERA is the 2nd lowest in the California League this season (San Jose- 3.48).

CORREA KEEPS 'EM QUIET: Yanzel Correa matched his longest outing of the season while twirling three scoreless innings of relief in the 6th, 7th, and 8th innings. It was his second scoreless outing of the season and both have come in his three outings since returning to the Grizzlies at the end of May.

GARCIA GAINING STEAM: Francisco Garcia blasted his first homer of the season Thursday night and added a two-run double that opened up the game in the tenth inning. It was his first multi-RBI game of the season and he has strung together consecutive multi-hit games in his first two starts in June.
