LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox secured a series split on the road against the Somerset Patriots with a 6-3 win on Sunday. Kyle Brnovich threw a season-high six shutout innings and did not allow a hit over one walk and six strikeouts to receive the win. It's the longest start by a Baysox starting pitcher this season. Bowie collected RBIs from Dylan Beavers, TT Bowens, Jud Fabian, John Rhodes and Max Wagner and Dylan Heid recorded his third save of the season to close out the road trip with a victory.

BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 10 games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .378 (14-for-37) with two homers, two doubles, nine RBI and an OPS of 1.060. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is tied with Jud Fabian for the team-lead in homers and tied for fifth in all of the Eastern League. Basallo led Baysox hitters with a .297 AVG in the month of May. His OBP jumped from .276 in April to .373 OBP in May. With a single and a walk on Sunday, Basallo increased his on-base streak to 11 consecutive games, which is tied for his season-long.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 36 of 43 games played this season. On Sunday, the Orioles No. 7 prospect reached base a game-high four times against Somerset with two singles and two walks. Beavers leads the team in walks (27), which is tied for the sixth-most in the league. The 22-year-old still owns the longest on-base streak on the team at 15 consecutive games.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (241.0) and strikeouts (288). Conversely, Bowie's starters have thrown the fewest number of innings in the league and in all of Double-A (196.2). Sunday was the first six-inning start by a Baysox starting pitcher all season. The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.22 WHIP, which is good for sixth-lowest in Double-A.

KISSING MAY GOODBYE

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie batted a league-worst .214 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) and scored the fourth-fewest runs (111) in the month of May. The Baysox also struck out the most times in the month (271).

SUPERBAD SETH

RHP **Seth Johnson** makes his 10th start of the season and his second against the Rumble Ponies. Johnson ended the month of May with a 2.79 ERA across five starts over 19.1 innings pitched, the lowest amongst Bowie starters in the month. The Orioles No. 10 prospect has allowed just two earned runs over his last three starts spanning 13 innings. In his last start against Binghamton on May 17, the 25-year-old threw four innings and allowed one unearned run with three strikeouts in a no decision.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are third in the Northeast Division at 26-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Mets most recently split their six game series against Harrisburg at home. The last time Bowie and Binghamton met was from May 14 - May 19 and Bowie won four of six at Mirabito Stadium. Seven of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 16), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 19), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Nolan McLean makes his third start of the season for the Rumble Ponies after recently being called up from High-A Brooklyn on May 20. In his most recent start last Wednesday vs Harrisburg, McLean matched his season-high with five innings thrown and gave up two runs on six hits over two walks and four strikeouts to receive the loss. The Mets No. 19 prospect was formerly drafted by the Orioles in the 3rd round of the 2022 Draft but both sides could not come to an agreement. McLean would eventually be drafted in the 3rd round of the 2023 Draft by the Mets.

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23

Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU

Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2024: In most recent start on 5/29 @ SOM, threw 4.0 IP and allowed just 1 R on 5 H in a no decision. Has allowed just 2 ER over last three starts spanning 13 IP. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. Still looking for first Double-A win. Owns a 2.93 ERA in four home starts.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisiana State (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™". During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
