NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 16 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 8 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have a 2-7 record over their last 9 games dropping back-to-back series against Indianapolis and now Louisville.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 24 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.
- 24 comeback wins are tied for 6th-most in the International League, tied 9th in Triple-A ... 28 blown leads are 2nd-most in the league, 4th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 16 of their last 27 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 56 games (since May 9), Omaha is 24-32 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 17 of 24 wins and led at some point in 18 of 32 losses, meaning 35 of Omaha's last 56 games (63%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 37 of 56 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.
- Over his last 15 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .350/.406/.583 (21-for-60) with 14 RBI ... Tuesday, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).
 - Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .287 (33-for-115) with 8 home runs and 23 RBI in 30 games ... since his arrival, he is 7th in the International League in runs scored (25), tied 5th in home runs, tied 6th in extra-base hits (17) and tied 8th in total bases (66).

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .323 average (53-for-164) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.014), 3rd in SLG (.622) and 8th in AVG ... his 41 RBI over 44 games since May 12 rank tied as the 5th-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 33 of 44 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.
 - Over his last 11 games (since June 27), Toro is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI, with an 1.152 OPS.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 45 games (since May 16), he's hitting .298 (48-for-161), with 15 XBH and 20 RBI, with 14 multi-hit games, including 4 of his last 6 games.

LOUISVILLE SLUGGING

- While the Bats hold the edge in the season series so far this year, a few Omaha hitters have been a thorn in the side of Louisville both this year and in previous seasons.
- Luca Tresh** is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with a 1.005 OPS and 10 RBI in 10 games against Louisville this year ... his 1.005 OPS ranks 7th among 42 hitters with at least 30 plate appearances against the Bats.
 - Louisville has also struggled pitching to **John Rave** ... over 26 career games at Louisville Slugger Field, Rave has 5 home runs, his most of any visiting Triple-A park ... since 2024, his 13 homers, 30 RBI and 92 total bases against the Bats are the most of any opposing player vs. Louisville.
 - Drew Waters** is a career .353 hitter (24-for-68) at Louisville Slugger Field (since 2021), with 11 extra-base hits and 14 RBI for a 1.085 OPS across 17 games, his best road AVG, OBP (.438), SLG (.647) and OPS of any Triple-A venue he's played in.

ROAD WARRIORS

- A pair of bullpen arms have stepped it up when pitching away from Werner Park.
- Génesis Cabrera** has allowed just 2 earned runs in 8.1 road innings (2.16 ERA) for the Storm Chasers, compared to a 9.28 ERA (11 ER in 10.2 IP) at home.
 - Dan Altavilla** has a 3.78 ERA (7 ER in 16.2 IP) in 16 road appearances this year and an 8.72 ERA (21 ER in 21.2 IP) in 17 home games, between Omaha and St. Paul.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Mitch Spence is making his **14th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **17th overall appearance** of the season.
- ✓ Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.
- ✓ This is Spence's 3rd career start against Louisville and his 5th against the Reds and their affiliates ... he has pitched against the Bats twice this season, including the series opener on Tuesday.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- ✓ **QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence is tied for the Storm Chasers lead in quality starts with 3 ... he allowed just 1 run over 6.0 innings on July 2 against the Indians ... he previously fired back-to-back perfect games on June 7 and June 15 combining to allow 5 runs over 12.2 innings in those games.
- ✓ **ROAD WORK:** Spence has been one of the Chasers' best pitchers on the road this year, working a 3.99 ERA (13 ER in 29.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts and a .173 opponents average in 6 road starts for Omaha ... his combined 5.92 ERA in Triple-A this year is largely inflated from a 13-run outing on May 26 vs. Memphis.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JULY 7 @ LOUISVILLE

- ✓ Threw a season-high 97 pitches in his 13th start of the year for Omaha ... allowed a 2-run home run to Héctor Rodríguez in the 1st inning, but struck out 2 batters in a perfect 2nd inning ... allowed another home run to Rodríguez in the bottom of the 3rd inning, a solo home run, before working around a one-out single for a scoreless 4th inning ... returned for the 5th inning, but exited after a two-out walk.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP A.J. Causey.
- ✓ Worked back-to-back quality starts for the Storm Chasers on May 7 and May 15, allowing 6 hits and 4 walks over 12.2 innings (0.79 WHIP) between the two games.
- ✓ Has made 3 MLB appearances over 3 stints with Kansas City: April 9 to 19, June 15 to 16 and June 26 to 27.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025
 - ✓ Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
 - ✓ Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, 2023 ... spent all of 2024 in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- ✓ Pitched part of 2022 and all 2023 in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an 11-10 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
- ✓ In 2023, led the minors with 163.0 innings ... also ranked 3rd in MiLB in pitches (2,564) and tied for 3rd in starts (29) ... led the International League in innings and starts and ranked 2nd in strikeouts (153).
- ✓ Opened 2022 with the Somerset Patriots (AA) and pitched in 17 games (15 starts) before his promotion to Triple-A on August 2 ... spent all of 2021 with the Hudson Valley Renegades (A+) and put up a 3.94 ERA (46 ER in 105.0 IP) with 118 strikeouts to 37 walks (3.19 K/BB) in 23 games (20 starts) at High-A.
- ✓ Made his professional debut in 2019 with the Pulaski Yankees (R) after New York drafted him in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft ... pitched exclusively out of the bullpen and earned 4 saves.

- ✓ Pitched 3 seasons (2017-19) for the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Peach Belt Conference, D2) ... worked a career 17-10 record with a 3.83 ERA (86 ER in 202.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts (10.8 K/9) for the Pacers ... in 2018, struck out 117 batters in 92.0 innings (11.4 K/9) with a 3.03 ERA (31 ER in 92.0 IP).
- ✓ Is the all-time saves and career ERA leader at Green Hope High School (NC).
