YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Patriots, 4-1. **Joe Whitman** started and threw six perfect innings, setting a career high with 10 strikeouts. **Evan Gates** continued the no-hit bid into the ninth until allowing a one-out double. **Justin Wishkoski** hit a two-run homer in the fifth, his first home run of the year. **Devin Mann** added a two-run homer in the sixth, his second homer in the last two games. Somerset scored its only run in the ninth with a sacrifice fly by Antonio Gomez. Whitman and Gates combined to face 28 batters in the game, one over the minimum. Dylan Jasso led off the seventh with a walk to end the perfect game bid but was later picked off to end the inning.

NEARLY PERFECT: **Joe Whitman** threw six perfect innings on Saturday night, the longest perfect start for a Richmond pitcher since **John Michael Bertrand** threw seven innings against the Baysox on April 27, 2024 against the Baysox. Bertrand also threw six hitless innings on May 23, 2024 at Bowie. **Seth Lonsway** took a no-hit bid into the sixth inning in the second game of a doubleheader on April 26 at Akron, a seven-inning game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game home series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The two teams meet again at Somerset from July 29-August 3. The Flying Squirrels and Patriots met last season for two series. Richmond opened the year at Somerset dropping two-of-three from April 5-7. The Patriots won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 25-30. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first series win of 2025.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,048 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7.007 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 1-5 in last week's road trip to Akron, their fourth series loss of the year. Their 8-18 start is the worst in franchise history. The 2015 Flying Squirrels started 3-2 before losing a franchise-record 15 consecutive games, falling to 3-17. They snapped the losing slide with a six-game win streak and finished the year 72-68, one game out of a postseason spot. The Flying Squirrels have won both of their May games. Their current three-game win streak is their longest of the year.

THE PATRIOTS split last week's home series against the Hartford Yard Goats. They opened the season dropping two-of-three at Hartford before splitting a home series against Reading and dropping four-of-six at Altoona the following week. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (29) and doubles (57) and rank second in SLG (.424). Somerset's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 6), C/1B Rafael Flores (No. 10), RHP Gage Ziehl (No. 13) and RHP Cam Schlittler (No. 14). There are also four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including Jones (No. 2), Schlittler (No. 10), Flores (No. 15) and Ziehl (No. 16).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his sixth start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Patriots. He started the series opener on Tuesday night at The Diamond and allowed a season-high five runs in three innings of work. In 2024, he started on Opening Day at Somerset and surrendered four runs (three earned) over five innings in a no-decision. He also threw five innings and allowed four runs against the Patriots at The Diamond on June 26, 2024. Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. *For more on Bertrand, see page two.*

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Gage Ziehl makes his Double-A debut. He was selected by the Yankees in the fourth round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Miami. With the Hurricanes, he worked as a reliever in 2022 before moving into a starting role for his final two seasons. Ziehl was also drafted by the Cubs out of high school in the 11th round. He did not pitch last year following the draft. On April 13, he made his professional debut with Low-A Tampa and threw 4.1 scoreless innings, striking out two. He allowed two runs in each of his next two starts for the Tarpons. Ziehl was promoted to Double-A Somerset today and is rated by Baseball America as the No. 13 Yankees prospect.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 17 stolen base attempts this season, which is first among all 30 Double-A teams. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 10 runners caught stealing, which is also tied for first the EL. Morgan is third in the EL with seven.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster last Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On Thursday, he tied his Double-A high with three hits. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .375 (9-for-24) during his current six-game hitting streak.

GO, DIEGO, GO: **Diego Velasquez** is riding a 13-game hitting streak, which is the longest current streak in the Eastern League and the third-longest in the EL this season. In those 13 games since April 18, Velasquez is batting .392 (20-for-51) with a homer, four doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. In his 36 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .315 (75-for-238). His 13-game hit streak is the longest since a 13-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in 2022. The last 14-game hit streak by a Richmond player was in 2017 by **Miguel Gomez**.

CLOSING THE DOOR: On Thursday, **Tyler Myrick** closed the 14th save of his Flying Squirrels career, tying ninth place on the franchise's all-time list with **Brett Bochy** (2012) and **Melvin Adon** (2019, 2022). In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Myrick has converted 82.4 percent of his save attempts, which is tied for fifth-highest in franchise history (min. 15 attempts). In 2023 between Richmond and High-A Eugene, Myrick went 15-for-15 in save attempts, the only pitcher in MiLB with a perfect mark and at least 12 tries.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for eighth in batting average (.319), ninth in OBP (.392) and tied for first in hits (29). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for third in homers (5), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (11) and tied for ninth in total bases (44). **Jack Choate** is tied for seventh in strikeouts (30).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 212 wins in his career, which is four away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Buffalo Bisons, 2-1, at Parker Field. Jim Bronstad allowed one run on six hits in a complete game. Clete Boyer hit his third homer in four games, a solo shot in the fourth to open a 1-0 lead. After the Bisons tied the score in the fifth, Jerry Thomas hit a go-ahead single in the bottom of the inning. **1975:** The Richmond Braves swept a doubleheader against the Memphis Blues at Parker Field. The R-Braves won the first game, 4-3. Junior Moore hit a two-run homer in the third. Frank LaCorte pitched a three-hitter for a 7-1 win in the second game. Manager Clint Courtney was ejected. The night included a Happy Days promotion at Parker Field. **1990:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 8-0, at The Diamond. Steve Avery started for the R-Braves and retired 18 of 20 batters he faced, combining with Bill Laskey for a shutout. Avery took a perfect game bid into the sixth inning before allowing a single. He left in the seventh with a blister on his finger and struck out eight in the game. **2015:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 5-1, at PNG Field. Myles Schroder broke a 1-1 tie with a three-run homer in the top of the seventh inning. The win snapped a franchise-record 15-game losing streak. After beginning the season 3-15, the Flying Squirrels started a six-game winning streak and won 10 of the next 12 games.
