#### LAST TIME OUT

**St. Paul, MN (April 20, 2023)** - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the St. Paul Saints 5-4 on another cold and wet night. The RailRiders put a run on the board in the ninth to get within one, but could not finish the comeback.

The game was quiet until the third inning when the Saints plated four runs on three doubles and a pair of walks. MLB rehabber Alex Kirillof and Mark Contreras had two RBIs a piece.

The RailRiders got on the board in the fifth with a solo shot from Mickey Gasper. It was his first of the season making it 4-1. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre added another in the seventh. Jesus Bastidas led off the frame with a two-bagger and Estevan Florial drove him in on his ground-rule double. In the eighth, Elijah Dunham walked to reach and came across the plate on Jake Bauers RBI double. The RailRiders trailed just 4-3.

St. Paul quickly got the run back in the bottom half. A solo shot from Hernan Perez gave the home team an insurance run.

The RailRiders tried to mount a comeback in the ninth. Gasper was hit by a pitch to start the inning. After moving over to third on a defensive indifference and a passed ball, Jamie Westbrook sent him home. SWB trailed by just one. Westbrook was stranded at first as a fly ball ended the contest 5-4 in favor of the Saints.

Tanner Tully (L, 0-1) got the start going two and two-thirds allowing four runs on two hits. He did leave the third with runners on and Michael Gomez let them to score. However, Gomez finished with a clean line himself in two innings of work. Matt Bowman tossed 1.1 innings of just one-hit ball. Barrett Loseke kept his ERA clean through the seventh. James Norwood allowed just a solo homer in the eighth.

Jose De Leon threw the first four frames clean for St. Paul. He allowed just two hits and two walks. Randy Dobnak (W, 1-0) let up one home run in his two frames. Connor Sadzeck and Austin Schuller each gave up one run in their single frames. Brock Stewart (S, 2) came in to close and made it a one-run ball game, but slammed the door shut for the win.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**BULLPEN IS BEST** - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre bullpen has lowered its ERA to 3.33 on the season. The starting staff has a 6.62 earned run average. The RailRiders have given up the most runs in the first four innings of a game with 17 total runs from opponents coming in the fourth. There have been eleven runs scored against them in the first and third and 14 in the second. The RailRiders batters spread their runs around more evenly throughout the game with eleven being the highest they've been able to build up in a frame. A four-run inning is the highest they have put on the board.

**FIELDING FAUX PAS** - The RailRiders made errors in back-to-back contests after not recording one in the opening contest in St. Paul despite the freezing weather. The RailRiders are tied for first with El Paso in all of Minor League Baseball with 25 miscues made. The have had only seventh error free games of the season. Earlier this summer they did have a five-error game.

**LOSEKE LEFT STANDING** - Barrett Loseke remains the only member left of the pitching staff to not have given up an earned run in 2023. Last night, he tossed one clean inning of work allowing just a walk and a hit, but recording two strikeouts. The righty has only made four appearances after being called up on April 8 before having an outing in Double-A. He has totaled five innings, letting up four hits and four walks, while striking out five. Loseke was originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 17th Round in 2018 out of the University of Arkansas.

**HOMER HEAVEN** - The RailRiders have had eleven different players launch a home run this season. Mickey Gasper got on the board with his first out of the season yesterday. The team has compiled twenty seven long balls in eighteen contests, tied for fourth in all of Triple-A. Jake Bauers and Andres Chaparro both have six homers, while Michael Hermosillo has three of his own. The Saints batters have amassed just seventeen home runs by twelve different hitters. Four have had a pair each, but Mark Contreras leads the way with three after his grand slam Tuesday.

**STEALING SITUATION** - The team has combined for 21 total steals on the season. Although not currently on the roster, Oswald Peraza leads with five to his name. Elijah Dunham has four total, while Jake Bauers has three swipes. Nine different players have recorded a steal and the RailRiders have only been caught three times.

**BREWER'S BACK** - The RailRiders have added pitcher Colten Brewer to the roster, totalling now 15 arms on staff. Brewer returns after being selected by New York on April 1st. The righty made three appearances out of the bullpen before being designated for assignment. Brewer cleared waivers and was outrighted to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on April 17 and joined the roster the next day. The 30-year-old joined the Yankees after being traded from the Tampa Bay Rays for cash at the end of Spring Training. The roster currently sits with just 27 players, twelve are position players, including three catchers.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#18 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS:** *MLB Pipeline* - NYY No. 20; *Fangraphs* - NYY No. 21; *Baseball America* - NYY No. 12

**SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN:** The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

**DAY GAME EXPERIENCE:** Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

**CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY:** At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Pitched a Sunday Day game, Took game one of the doubleheader

**PERSONAL/CAREER:**

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.
- Born in Kirkland, WA, claims Cary, NC as his hometown.
- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.
