For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**ROAD WARRIORS:** To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Winning 5 of the first 6 games in Frisco this week, Springfield is 36-20 (.643) away from Hammons Field this season. The Cardinals' .636 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655). The Cards are .500 (29-29) at home this season, but are 15-7 over their last 22 games at Hammons Field.

HITS, HITS, HITS: The top offense in the Texas League all season long, the Cardinals have turned up the temperature as the weather has also heated up. Through 16 games in the month of August, Springfield is batting .297, the top mark in Double-A by 20 points (Portland Sea Dogs, .277), The Cardinals have double-digit hits in 7 of their last 8 games and are batting .343 since August 10. For the season the Cards are batting .270, tops in Double-A, and have scored 584 runs, tops in the Texas League.

The Cardinals have also already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 43 longballs in 45 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 66 homers in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest SLG (.418) and OPS (.770) in the 2nd half of Texas League play after ranking 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the 1st half.

CARDIAC CARDS: This past week in Frisco, the Cardinals saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in four of their six games at Riders Field, Springfield went 5-1 agaisnt the RoughRiders. The Cards scored 23 of their 44 (52%) runs in the series in the 7th inning or later, and outscored the Riders 19-7 from the 8th inning on.

TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPOW HONORS: For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF Bryan Torres was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; Nathan Church was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. Cooper Hjerpe earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23.

Torres had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP. Torres' week continues a red-hot month of August in which he is leading qualified Texas League hitters with a .436 batting average (24-for-55) with 3 2B and 7 RBIs while getting on base at a .508 clip. During his 7-game hitting streak, Torres is 18-for-32 (.563).

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 38 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all gualified hitters in the circuit with a .374 average, 10 HR and 36 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .655 and with a 1.084 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, Crooks batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games and is batting .426 (21-for-50) with 4 HR and 17 RBIs over 14 games in August.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Among active, qualified hitters Jimmy Crooks (.324/.410) and Bryan Torres (.324/.413) are 1-2 atop the league in batting average and OBP, while Crooks leads the circuit in OBP, SLG (.514) and OPS (.929). Torres is 1st in hits (121) while Nathan Church is tied for the league lead in runs scored with 68.

KING OF THE "K": With 11 K's on Saturday night and 37 strikeouts over his last 4 starts, Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews continues to lead MiLB in whiffs. With 168 K's, Mathews leads Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson of the Cleveland organization by 12 (156).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 20.0 IP (0.45 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. Svanson has been unscored upon over his last 17 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 14 K over his last 18.0 IP. The Cardinals are 47-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


