ROUGHRIDERS SPLIT SERIES BEHIND 8-7 SUNDAY WIN:

After falling on the Fourth of July, the Frisco RoughRiders fought back with an 8-7 win over the Midland RockHounds to split the six-game series Sunday at Riders Field. Midland (8-4, 40-40) jumped in front with another first-inning home run, as Cole Conn lifted off against **Dylan MacLean** (6-1) for a 2-0 lead over Frisco (6-6, 45-35). Down 3-0 in the bottom of the second, the Riders cut the deficit to 3-2 with a two-RBI double from **Max Wagner** off Kenya Huggins (1-4). In the bottom of the third, **Ian Moller** added on with a two-run double of his own, pushing Frisco in front 4-3. **Dylan Dreiling** doubled in one and then **Julian Brock** doubled in three more to give the Riders eight unanswered runs for an 8-3 lead. Frisco carried its lead into the latter innings and, after **Dustin Saenz** surrendered two runs in the ninth, **Jonathan Brand** picked up his second save with a strikeout to strand two aboard in the 8-7 effort.

THIS CURRY IS SPICY:

RoughRiders starter **Aidan Curry** struck out a season-best 11 in his start on Tuesday against Midland over 5.2 innings in a no-decision. His 11 strikeouts tied for the most whiffs by a Texas League starter this season (the 5th time it has happened this season) and was the most by a RoughRiders starter since **Emiliano Teodo** cut down 11 Sod Poodles on June 16th, 2024. Frisco also struck out 18 as a team on Tuesday, their most since April 23rd, 2025 against Corpus Christi. Even after striking out just 6 batters on Saturday, the RoughRiders had the most strikeouts in the Texas League last week with 73 (12.2 per game), the 3rd-most in the minors.

BALLPARK BY THE BAY:

The RoughRiders are back in Corpus Christi for the 3rd time this season before the Hooks even travel to Frisco once. The Riders are 6-3 in Whataburger Field in 2026, including a 3-game sweep of the Hooks to open the season. In the 9 games, the Riders have hit 14 home runs while slashing .274/.362/.451/.813 while averaging 6.7 runs per game on offense. **Max Wagner** leads the way with 4 home runs in Corpus while **Orlando Martinez** is hitting .324 (12-for-37) against his former team.

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567), their 8th-best winning percentage in franchise history and their best since 2024 (.647).

CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:

RoughRiders infielder **Frainer Chavez** has been on fire and won Texas League Player of the Week last week in Amarillo. In the week, he hit .481 (13-for-27)/.548/.889/1.437 with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBIs and 7 runs. In his last 39 games, he is slashing .362 (54-for-149)/.463/.597/1.060 with 14 doubles, 7 home runs, 24 RBIs, 27 walks, 27 strikeouts and 34 runs scored. He hit his third leadoff home run of the season in game two of the doubleheader on June 17th. He now has his new career high with 12 home runs. Overall, Chavez is 3rd in the Texas League in batting average (.301), 3rd in OBP (.406), 4th in OPS (.894), 2nd in hits (90), T-3rd in doubles (20), 7th in walks (50), T-6th in extra-base hits (32) and T-2nd in runs scored (65).

BIG POWER WEEK:

The Riders tied their franchise record with 17 home runs in a six-game series two weeks ago in Amarillo. **Frainer Chavez**, **Dylan Dreiling** and **Max Wagner** all homered 3 times on the week. The team hit .323 (74-for-229)/.385/.594/.979 while averaging 6.7 runs per game. In their last 12 games, Frisco is second in the Texas League with 21 long balls. Their 104 home runs through 80 games are the most in franchise history, as are their 6.2 runs per game (the 4th-highest mark in Double-A since 2005).

OH, YOU THINK THE DARKNESS IS YOUR ALLY:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (168 runs) and the 6th-best team in Double-A (and 2nd in the Texas League) in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.92). **Frainer Chavez** is hitting .346/.475/.462/.937 in the 7th inning or later this season.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

Frisco's 58 runs in the first inning this year are 2nd in the Texas League. They have scored in the first inning in 29 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 14 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 20-34 (including a combined 9-11 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 25-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 19-19 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 80 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in Double-A with 727 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.268) and 2nd in runs (496, 6.2 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 43 percent of their games (34-of-80). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (104), 1st in doubles (148), 2nd in SLG (.446) and 2nd in Double-A in OPS (.807).

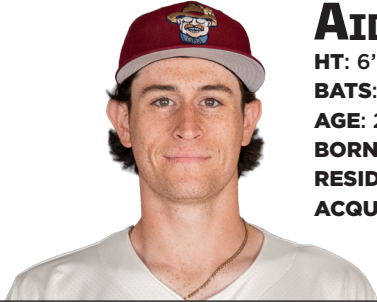

-Originally committed to Bucknell University.

-Was part of the 2017 Ossining Little League team that won the New York state championship and advanced to the Little League World Series.

2026 SEASON

-Before promotion, went 2-1 with 3.48 ERA in 7 starts with High-A Hub City. Struck out 42 in 31.0 IP to 18 walks.

-With Hub City, led South Atlantic League in fly ball rate (51.4%) and 11th in ERA (3.48).

2025 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hub City, owning 4.72 ERA from 4/9-6/11 before spending short stint with ACL Rangers from 6/21-7/23. Returned to Hub City from 7/30-end of season, owning 3.00 ERA over 24.0 IP).

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

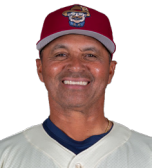
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
