WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the completion of Wednesday's rain-suspended game and beat the Rumble Ponies in the second game of the night. Wednesday's game was suspended for rain after five innings with the score tied, 2-2. Binghamton took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning on a two-run single by Alex Ramirez. The unearned runs were the only runs against Richmond starter Joe Whitman, who set a career high with 11 strikeouts in his five innings of work. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 2-2, with a two-run double by Thomas Gavello in the top of the fourth inning. Play was halted after Whitman stranded two runners on base in the bottom of the fifth with his 11th strikeout of the game. Play resumed on Friday and Gavello gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with a single in the sixth followed by a sacrifice fly by Aeverson Arteaga. Binghamton scored three runs in the ninth, capped with a walk-off, two-run single by D'Andre Smith. In Friday's regularly scheduled game, Richmond beat Binghamton, 6-1. Sabin Ceballos gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-0 lead in the fourth with a two-run single. Nick Lorusso cut the score to 2-1 with an RBI single in the fifth. In the sixth, Arteaga and Diego Velasquez hit RBI singles to open a 4-1 lead. Gavello and Bryce Eldridge hit run-scoring singles in the eighth to extend the lead to 6-1. TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The week is Richmond's first series in Binghamton since May 23-28, 2023, when the Rumble Ponies took five-of-six. The Rumble Ponies come to The Diamond to face the Flying Squirrels in a six-game series from June 10-15. This week's series is Richmond's second against the Northeast Division. They split a six-game series with Somerset from April 20 May 4.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,022 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the SeaWolves. The Richmond offense ranks third in hits (301), sixth in batting average (.226) and has the second-fewest strikeouts (341) in the Eastern League but are 11th in runs scored (134). The Richmond pitching staff is last in ERA (4.87).

THE RUMBLE PONIES are in first place in the Northeast Division, a half-game ahead of Portland and have won six-of-their-last-INE RUMBLE PURIES are in Tirst piace in the Northeast Division, a half-game ahead of Portland and have won six-of-their-last-eight games since May 14 (G2). Binghamton's roster features seven players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including SS Jett Williams (No. 1), 1B/OF Ryan Clifford (No. 6), OF Nick Morabito (No. 12), RHP Jonah Tong (No. 13), C Kevin Parada (No. 27), RHP Jonathan Pintaro (No. 29) and 1B JT Schwartz (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects lists features six Binghamton players, including Williams (No. 1), Clifford (No. 4), Tong (No. 6), Morabito (No. 17), Pintaro (No. 23) and RHP Jack Wenninger (No. 28).

STARTING STRONG: Richmond starting pitchers have combined for 14.1 innings in this week's series without allowing an earned run. On Tuesday, **Seth Lonsway** threw 5.1 scoreless innings and struck out six batters to open the series. On Wednesday, **Joe Whitman** threw five scoreless innings and set a career high with 11 strikeouts prior to the game being suspended for rain in the top of the sixth inning. **John Michael Bertrand** scattered five hits and a walk over four scoreless innings in Friday night's 6-1 Flying Squirrels win.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Manuel Mercedes makes his eighth Double-A start and his first against the Rumble Ponies He last pitched last Saturday at The Diamond and allowed six runs (five earned) over four innings in a loss to the SeaWolves. Mercedes spent all of last season with High-A Eugene, going 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA. He was tied for second in the Northwest League in games started (25) and ranked fifth in innings pitched (116.0). Mercedes spent the prior two seasons with Low-A San Jose. In 2023, he went 3-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 25 outings (21 starts). He signed with the Giants in their 2019 international class. FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Zach Thornton makes his fifth Double-A start. He last pitched last Sunday and threw five innings with six strikeouts at Hartford to pick up his first Double-A win. Thornton opened the year with High-A Brooklyn and went 3-0 with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER/20.2 IP). He was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month for April. The Mets promoted Thornton to Double-A on April 28. He was selected by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Grand Canyon University. In his first professional season last year, Thornton went 5-4 with a 4.10 ERA in 20 outings (12 starts) between Low-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 21 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for third among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is second in the Eastern League with 12 runners caught stealing. Morgan is tied for fourth in the EL with nine.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting, 111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting, 325 (27-for-83) in his last 22 games since April 27. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. In two games on May 15 (G2)-16, he went 5-for-7 with three homers, two doubles and five RBIs. In his last nine games since May 13, Eldridge is hitting .382 (13-for-34) with three homers, three doubles and seven RBIs.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in all seven Double-A games he has played, including four doubles. He has played one game at shortstop and six games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is tied for ninth in hits (40). Seth Lonsway is third in ERA (2.40), tied for seventh in innings pitched (41.1) and ninth in WHIP (1.09). Joe Whitman is tied for seventh in strikeouts (44). Jack Choate is tied for ninth in strikeouts (43). John Michael Bertrand is tied for first in games started (9) and fifth in innings pitched

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 217 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 22 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

1957: The Richmond Virginians beat the Miami Marlins, 4-1, at Parker Field to take first place in the International 4-1, at Parker Field to take first place in the International League. Bob Martyn hit a two-run double in a three-run third inning. Jerry Lumpe tripled to lead off the sixth and scored on a sacrifice fly by Danny Schell. Jim Kite scattered nine hits to pick up his third win. 1966: The Richmond Braves beat the Columbus Jets, 5-1, at Parker Field. Larry Maxie started the game. He was scheduled to leave Richmond at 10:30 to fly to Los Angeles, where his wife was scheduled to give birth to their second child. With a 7:30 first pitch, he threw a complete game and allowed one run to finish the game in one hour and 50 minutes. Billy Southworth homered twice and drove in three runs. 1984: The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 16-3, at Parker Field behind a season-high 19 hits. Larry Owen, Paul Zuvella and Brad Komminsk each homered. Milt Thompson had four hits. Brian Fisher started and struck out 10 in eight innings, improving to 6-1 with a 1.66 ERA. 1990: The Richmond Braves beat the Denver Zephyrs (American Association), 6-5, at The Diamond. Dennis Hood hit a homer in the eighth to close the score to 4-3 and hit a two-run, walk-off single in the ninth with two outs. 2024: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 17-10, at Prince George's Stadium. Andy Thomas helped trigger a six-run third inning with a grand slam. Bowie responded with four runs in the bottom of the third. In the fourth, Victor Bericoto hit a three-run homer to open a 9-4 lead. Bowie scored three in the fifth and three in the sixth to take a 10-9 lead. In the seventh, Adrian Sugastey tied the score with a single and Luis Toribio brought in the go-ahead run with a groundout for an 11-10 lead. Thomas added a two-run single by Will Wilson, an RBI double by Grant McCray and a sacrifice fly by Sugastey.
