FRES-NOTES

STACKING KS: Fresno's pitching staff missed more bats as their nine-game road trip wrapped up. After totaling 26 strikeouts across the first three games in Stockton, the staff piled up 42 more over the final three games at Visalia, including back-to-back 16-strikeout outings on Saturday and Sunday — duplicating their second highest single-game total for the second and third times this season. The season high for the Grizzlies pitching staff is 17 K's against the San Jose Giants on May 29th at Chukchansi Park. They previously also registered 16 against this week's opponent, the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in Rancho on May 21st. Across all nine games of the road trip, Fresno's arms struck out 97 batters in 76.2 innings, a rate of better than 11 per nine. The Grizzlies 913 K's on the season are third in the Cal League, while Rancho's pitching staff leads the league with 982 at the start of the series.

JULY POWER SURGE: Fresno's offense has found another gear this month — a .280 average and .859 OPS in July are both season highs, and the 19 home runs in just 14 games represent the club's most productive power month of the year, even ahead of April's 30-homer pace over a longer 24-game stretch. On a per-game basis, July's home run rate (1.36 per game) is the best of any month this season. The power showed up early and often against Stockton — Fresno hit 10 of its 12 road-trip home runs during the six games in that series alone, including a 4-homer game on July 9th. The bats remained lethal, albeit selectively, at Visalia by comparison, mustering 3 home runs across the quick three game series, but the overall trip output (12 HR in 9 games) still represents one of Fresno's more productive power stretches of the season.

LOOKING FOR SOLID GROUND: Rancho Cucamonga is the one team that's had Fresno's number all season. The Grizzlies are just 4-8 against the Quakes across 12 meetings in 2026, their only losing record against any opponent on the schedule. Fresno's pitching has struck out 111 batters across the first 12 meetings (9.7 per nine innings), right in line with the team's season rate — including a 16-strikeout outing on 5/21 that stands as one of the staff's best swing-and-miss performances of the year. Seth Clausen (0.00 ERA, 12 SO in 7.0 IP), Yanzel Correa (1.42 ERA, 8 SO), and Dylan Crooks (3.38 ERA) have combined to allow just 3 earned runs across 18.2 innings against the Quakes.
