APPLE SLICES

'CAPS VS. CAPTAINS ROUND 3: Tuesday marks the start of the third and final series of the season between Fort Wayne and Lake County. The TinCaps welcomed the Captains to Parkview Field back in April, where the teams split the six-game series. Fort Wayne won three in a row (Wednesday-Friday) before dropping both games over the weekend. The clubs met for a second time after the All-Star break in a shortened three-game weekend set. Former TinCap and top-ranked Padres prospect Leo De Vries came through that weekend with a go-ahead single in the 10th inning of a 3-2 victory on July 19, which was the first extra-inning contest for Fort Wayne in 2025.

SO LONG, FRIENDS: Left-handed pitcher **Harry Gustin**, outfielder **Braedon Karpathios**, and infielder **Ryan Jackson** received the call to Double-A San Antonio on Tuesday. **Gustin** posted a 2.36 ERA with Fort Wayne across 21 appearances this season. He hit the IL at the end of June and made his return on August 2 against Great Lakes. Gustin allowed two runs in 7 1/3 innings in 4 outings since returning and struck out 11 while walking just 1. Amongst High-A arms with as many innings out of the bullpen, Gustin's 2.22 ERA ranks second.

Karpathios led the team in RBI (55), walks (65), OBP (.370), BABIP (.343), multi-hit games (26), and multi-RBI games (12). His 14 outfield assists are 2nd in High-A and 5th in Minor League Baseball.

Jackson joined Fort Wayne before their series in Dayton on June 17. Upon joining the team, he reached base in his first 16 games played and 41 of his 48 total with the TinCaps. He has four separate on-base streaks of at least 10 games this season. He began the year with a 34-game on-base streak with Single-A Lake Elsinore and is fifth in all of affiliated baseball with 84 walks drawn this season. He played in 32 consecutive games to end his stint with Fort Wayne.

SILENCING STABLE: TinCap relievers **C.J. Widger**, **Bodi Rascon**, and **Luis German** allowed just 1 run in 6 1/3 frames out of the bullpen on Sunday against West Michigan. The trio punched out six and did not walk a batter, making it back-to-back games with Fort Wayne relief pitching not issuing a free pass.

QUALITY START KOENIG: Right-hander **Ian Koenig** tossed a career-long seven innings for his second consecutive start Tuesday night. Striking out a career-high seven, Koenig allowed one walk and found himself in only two three-ball counts. He has gone six innings or more in 5 of his last 6 starts while coming off an impressive July. He is tied for the team lead with Miguel Mendez with five quality starts. The righty finished July with a 1.93 ERA and a 0.94 WHIP across 23 1/3 innings. Koenig ranked 6th in ERA among starters with at least 20 innings tossed last month and 4th in WHIP.

WINNING YOUR 1-1's: TinCaps starter Ian Koenig has spoken about his emphasis on "winning his 1-1 counts" this season. On 1-2 counts this season, opponents are batting .098 against the San Jose, CA native. 2-1 counts this season, opponents are batting .278.

FIRING FERNANDO: TinCap reliever **Fernando Sanchez** allowed one run in 4 1/3 frames out of the bullpen last Wednesday. The southpaw leads all relievers in the Midwest League in ERA (2.19) and is 2nd in WHIP (0.97) among those who have thrown at least 24 2/3 innings dating back to June 28. Sanchez has a 2.50 ERA in 27 appearances with Fort Wayne this season across two different stints with the 'Caps.

SIDE WINDING WISS: TinCaps reliever **Nick Wissman** completed his second save of the season Saturday after leaving the bases loaded in the ninth. Striking out three in two innings pitched, has not allowed a run in his last six appearances. Since June 1, Wissman has made 18 appearances and allowed six runs across 23 2/3 innings pitched (2.28 ERA). He has struck out 22 across the stretch.

SHUTDOWN MAL: Fort Wayne right-hander **Josh Mallitz** struck out three in two scoreless innings on Friday. He has not allowed a run in 10 of his last 11 appearances, striking out 29 across 21 2/3 innings, having a 1.27 ERA in the stretch.

CONSISTENT COSTELLO: TinCap left fielder **Jack Costello** has a hit in his last five games, including a two-run single on Thursday. Costello launched his 6th home run of the season on August 7 against South Bend and is batting .267 (8-for-30) in a 9-game stretch since then.

KING KRUSHING: Following a 0-for-6 start in High-A, catcher **Lamar King Jr.** has four multi-hit games in his last 8 played and is hitting .297 (11-for-37). The No. 14 Padres prospect went 6-for-18 in last week's series against West Michigan, which included an RBI single Saturday. The 21-year-old was awarded California League Player of the Month in June, leading the league in AVG (.408), 2B (11), OBP (.505), SLG (.579), and OPS (1.084).

260 SHOWS OUT: In the Miami Marlins' 13-4 win on Wednesday against the Cleveland Guardians, five former TinCaps showed out. **Xavier Edwards** (2019) led the game off with his second home run of the season and added a triple. Exploding onto the scene, rookie **Jakob Marsee** (2023) launched a three-run homer five batters later. Marsee later connected on a two-run homer in the fifth, ending the night 4-5, 2B, 2 HR, and 7 RBI. **Graham Pauley** (2023) also completed a four-hit night with a home run, while the Guardians' **Gabriel Arias** (2019) bashed a three-run home run. The group had half of the game's hits and went a combined 11-17 with 29 total bases, 5 HR, and 12 RBI. Normally a catcher, **Austin Hedges** (2012) pitched a scoreless inning for Cleveland.

MARSEE MADNESS: 2023 TinCap **Jakob Marsee** put together the best 13-game start to a Miami Marlins career in franchise history with a 1.414 OPS and 17-game start with a 1.246 OPS. On Wednesday, behind a two-home run, 11 total base game, Marsee tied a Marlins franchise record with 7 RBI. Marsee is slashing .375 (21-56)/.455/.768 with 4 HR, 17 RBI, 6 SB, and 9 BB.

- First player since at least 1901 with 4 XBH and 4 BB in first 3 games
- 1 of 4 players ever to have 6 H, 5 XBH, and 4 BB in first 5 games
- Set a Marlins franchise record reaching base 21 times (13 H, 8 BB) through first 10 games
- First-ever MLB player to steal 6+ bases and record 10+ XBH in his first 13 games
- No other rookie in the live ball era (1920) has had a 7+ RBI game and a 3+ SB game in a season
- The only other player to have a 4-game span with a 7+ RBI game and a 3+ SB game is Grady Sizemore (Aug. 2008)

The Padres selected Marsee in the sixth round out of Central Michigan in 2022 before Marsee saw time with Fort Wayne in 2023. With the 'Caps, Marsee batted .273 in 113 games while clubbing out 13 homers and driving in 41 runs, and earned Midwest League Post-Season All-Star honors.

HERE TO SERVE: On Thursday, Fort Wayne TinCaps players, coaches, and staff will participate in their second Service Day of 2025. The team split up between the local **Salvation Army**, **The Rescue Mission**, a local non-profit organization that provides restorative care to those experiencing a homelessness crisis, and **Treasure House**, a thrift store aimed at helping provide affordable goods, job training, rehabilitation, and life-skill programs to those in need. There, the team will help hand out lunches, clean, and perform other duties. The late owner of the San Diego Padres (the parent club for the TinCaps), Peter Seidler, was devoted to combating our nation's homelessness crisis, and the TinCaps continue to honor his legacy.

THROUGH SIX INNINGS: The Fort Wayne TinCaps are 42-3 this season when leading after six innings. After starting off a perfect 24-0, the 'Caps fell for the first time on Tuesday, June 10, against the South Bend Cubs.

2026 UP NEXT: On Tuesday, Minor League Baseball announced the Fort Wayne TinCaps' 2026 schedule. The 132-game campaign features 66 home dates, with most series going six games from Tuesday to Sunday. In 2026, the TinCaps will be at Parkview Field for Mother's Day (May 10), Memorial Day Weekend (May 22-24), Father's Day (June 21), and the Fourth of July. Promotions and game times will be announced later. Season ticket packages for 2026 are available now. Back again, fans can purchase season ticket plans directly through TinCaps.com. Packages are flexible for fans, with options including 12 games, 17 games, a half-season, a full season, and even more customization.

MORE HOLIDAY TRADITION AT PARKVIEW FIELD: The Fort Wayne TinCaps are excited to announce the return of **Parkview Field Holiday Lights – A Walk-Thru Event – presented by Rohrman Automotive, Paul Davis, and Lear Corporation**. The event will be hosted at the ballpark for 44 nights from November 13 to January 3. Back this winter and better than ever, 1.5 million lights will be on display, a 50% increase from 2024. The event features brand-new displays and music for the holiday season.

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
- **MORE THAN BASEBALL:** Parkview Field hosts hundreds of special events yearly, including concerts such as Florida Georgia Line, Dierks Bentley, Zac Brown Band, and Nelly.

SCOUTING REPORT (MLB.com): "The 6-foot-3 right-hander has changed how he pitches pretty drastically from college to the pros. According to Synergy, his slider usage was 62 percent in his final season on campus; that's down to 26 percent in the Midwest League as of late July. It's still an effective pitch at 82-84 mph, dropping well of his high three-quarters arm slot, but it hasn't been his most effective. That belongs to his 85-88 mph changeup. Mallitz sells the cambio well with great arm speed, only for it to fade away from frustrated bats. It's become his primary pitch against lefties. He still sets everything up with a 92-94 mph fastball (touching 98), and an upper-80s cutter helps him bridge the heater and slider.

Maybe because he doesn't need to blow his stuff past batters, Mallitz has better control than a typical relief prospect and could be useful as a long man who faces a lineup once through. At the same time, without the heat, he'll always need to tinker with the usage of his other offerings to find the right balance."
