YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 5-4, in 10 innings. Trailing, 4-3, with two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Simon Whiteman tied the game with an RBI double to force extras. In the 10th, Domingo Leyba drove an RBI single to give the Curve the lead and Noe Toribio held the Flying Squirrels scoreless in the bottom of the inning to close the game with three straight strikeouts. Altoona took a 3-0 lead in the first with an RBI single by Leyba and a two-run homer by Matt Gorski. In the bottom of the first, Carter Aldrete worked a bases-loaded walk to close the score to 3-1. In the fourth, Carter Williams tied the game with a two-run homer. The Curve reclaimed the lead in the fifth with a solo homer by Liover Peguera. Richmond reliever Randy Rodriguez threw three scoreless innings.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Today marks the third of 18 games between the Flying Squirrels and Curve this season. Altoona will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from June 6-11. The Flying Squirrels will head to Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona for a six-game series from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are 11-8 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 5-2 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won nine-of-the-last-13 games and are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in runs (122), RBIs (108), OBP (.347) and OPS (.735) and rank second in batting average (.247). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (228) and ranks second in ERA (3.20).

THE CUPVE are in second place in the division, 2.5 games behind the Flying Squirrels. Altoona has won eight-of-its-last-12 games and three-of-its-last-five. The Curve roster includes five of Baseball America's Top-30 Pirates Prospects: C Henry Davis (No. 3), INF Liover Peguera (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 + best power hitter + best outfield arm) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nick Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Lolo Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. The Altoona roster also includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates Prospects, including Davis (No. 3), Peguero (No. 6), Gorski (No. 17), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 20) and Frazier (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Mason Black makes fifth Double-A start. Last time out, he set a season high with eight strikeouts over four innings against the Baysox last Thursday and allowed one run on two hits. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an Mil.B.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more on Black, see page two.

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Sean Sullivan makes his fourth start of the season. He has not allowed a run through his first three starts this year, spanning 11.2 innings. He last pitched last Thursday at Reading and set season highs in innings pitched (5.0) and strikeouts (6). Sullivan was selected in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Cal. He made his professional debut last season, spending the entire year with High-A Greensboro, and went 2-5 with a 4.68 ERA in 20 games (15 starts).

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 14-8 record this year, tied for the best start in team history through 22 games, even with 2018 and 2022. The team's best start through 23 games was 15-8, which was set in 2022. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .306 (63-for-206) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .309 (29-for-94). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .306 average (102-for-333). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday and made his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect.

MAHAN MAYHEM: Riley Mahan blasted his fourth homer of the season on Tuesday night at The Diamond, a 419-foot, go-ahead shot to right. He has now homered three times in his last two home games, including two homers on April 23 against the Sea-Wolves. In his last 12 games since April 15, Mahan is batting .285 (14-for-49) with four homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs.

HITZ-GERALD: Tyler Fitzgerald was named the Eastern League Player of the Month for April on Thursday afternoon. He was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. At the time of his promotion and for the month of April, Fitzgerald ranked third in the Eastern League in batting average (.324), sixth in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15). Fitzgerald is the first Richmond player to win the Eastern League Player of the Month Award since Ricky Oropesa in 2015.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .400 (8-for-20) with a homer, two doubles and five RBIs over his last four games. He led off last Thursday's game with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs, picking up a pair of RBI singles and a sac fly. Munguia is tied for fourth in the league in hits (23) and second in runs scored (17).

MATIS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season, until going 0-for-3 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. During the streak, Matos reached base 28 total times with 16 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. For the year, Matos has struck out just nine times in 88 plate appearances (10.2 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for second in Eastern League with 18 walks. He is fourth in the Eastern League with a 23.4-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in 12-of-his-19 games played so far this season. In last week's series at Bowie, he hit .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double, five walks and four RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Patrick Bailey is ranked second in batting average (.333), ninth in OBP (.400) and eighth in OPS (.881). Tyler Fitzgerald is sixth in batting average (.324), tied for fifth in OBP (.410), fifth in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for eighth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), tied for second in extra-base hits (11), tied for fifth in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scorred (15). Ismael Munguia tied for fourth in hits (23) and second in runs scorred (17). Riley Mahan is tied for fourth in homers (4), tied for fifth in RBIs (14), ninth in SLG (.554) and tied for ninth in extra-base hits (9). Andy Thomas is tied for second in walks (18). Juan Sanchez is tied for second in wins (4). Kai-Wei Teng is second in strikeouts (30). Evan Gates is tied for sixth in saves (3).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Domingo Leyba is tied for second in batting average (.333), tied for fifth in RBIs (14), tied for fifth in OBP (.410) and tied fourth in hits (23). Henry Davis is tied for second in homers (6), tied for third in RBIs (15), fourth in OBP (.434), third in SLG (.600), third in OPS (1.034) and seventh in total bases (39). Mason Martin is second in OBP (.452), eighth in SLG (.523), fifth in OPS (.975) and tied for eighth in walks (16). Liover Peguero is tied for fourth in stolen bases (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
