**TODAY** marks game #46 of the 2024 regular season, the 1st game of a 6-game homestand, the 1st game of a 6-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, and the second time these two have met this season. These two teams played 24 times during the 2023 regular season, with the Whitecaps losing the season series 11-13. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 31st season in professional baseball, while the Loons are in their 18th season of professional baseball affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

**UP NEXT:** The 'Caps head to South Bend to take on the Cubs in their only meeting this year in a six-game series from June 4-June 9 at Four Winds Field before returning home to LMCU Ballpark for a six-game series against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers from June 11-June 16.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**WHITECAPS DROP SERIES TO CAPTAINS:** The West Michigan Whitecaps bullpen could not hold a big lead as part of a 7-6 loss to the Lake County Captains on Sunday at Classic Park. Despite holding a five-run lead, Sunday marked the second straight day the Whitecaps bullpen allowed a grand slam to lose a significant advantage. The Whitecaps miss out on a chance to leave Eastlake with a series split and instead settle on taking two out of six, but still return to Comstock Park having posted a winning road trip with a 7-5 record away from West Michigan. The Whitecaps stormed out in front with a five-run third inning against Captains starting pitcher Carter Spivey, highlighted by a Danny Serretti RBI-single and a single from Dom Johnson that, combined with a Lake County error, plated three more runs, helping West Michigan take a 5-0 lead. The advantage was short-lived, however, as the Captains rallied with a run in the fourth and five more in the fifth, four of which came home when Mooney launched the go-ahead grand slam to give Lake County the 6-5 lead. After Izaac Pacheco tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the sixth, C.J. Kayfus blasted another go-ahead shot, giving the Captains a 7-6 advantage. The Captains finish the week moving their record to 26-19, while the Whitecaps fall back under .500 to 22-23. Lake County starting pitcher Carter Spivey (3-1) tossed seven innings and gave up six runs (three earned) in picking up his third win of the year. Max Alba (2-2) allowed the home run to Kayfus, suffering his second loss of the year. Captains pitcher Magnus Ellerts tossed a scoreless ninth to collect his fourth save of the season. Seth Stephenson led the Whitecaps offense by going two-for-five at the plate in a losing cause.

**NIGHT OWLS:** The Whitecaps are 17-11 in night games this season, but posting just a 5-12 record in contests played during the day.

**PITCH PERFECT:** Entering play for the series beginning May 28, the Whitecaps sit 3rd in the Midwest League with a 3.92 ERA. They're 3rd in BAA at .215, During their series at Peoria and the team winning five of six from May 14-19, including each of the final five games, 'Caps pitching allowed just ten total runs, combining for a team ERA of 1.50 throughout the series.

**JADEN GOES HAMM:** Jaden Hamm - April's Midwest League Pitcher of the month - has a league-best 1.04 ERA while posting 47 strikeouts and just five walks.

**SUPER TUESDAY:** The Whitecaps are currently 7-1 in the first game of any series they've played this season, and 6-1 in Tuesday games.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold six of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

**HEALTH REPORT:** The 'Caps IL holds seven players in Ps Aaron Haase, and Jordan Marks, IFs Abel Bastidas and Andrew Jenkins, OF Cole Turney, and C Colin Burgess.

*Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20 innings pitched in 2023. The teenager held his own in his first full season at the low-A level, tossing 100 innings while going 4-5 with a 4.50 ERA and generating 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (holding opposing hitters to a .237 batting average against).*

**LAST START:** Marcano ran into trouble with giving up hard contact again in his last start, giving up six runs on ten hits and allowing his first home run of the year as part of a 12-3 loss to the Lake County Captains on May 22 at Classic Auto Group Park.

**2023:** After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano pitched well once again, limiting toe Peoria Chiefs to just two runs (one aired) in five innings in earning the win in the 'Caps 5-3 win over the Peoria Chiefs on May 22 at Dozer Park.

**2022:** Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

**2021:** Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

**More:** His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.

His size is very projectible - listed at 6'2, 150 pounds, there is still plenty of room to grow into his body.
