### Jersey Shore BlueClaws (33-25) vs Wilmington BlueRocks (27-31)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001) RHP Jean Cabrera (3-2, 3.46) vs RHP Rodney Theophile (1-4, 4.89) Series: Game 2 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 7-0 of 24)

Last Time Out...Jordan Dissin hit a grand slam in the bottom of the fifth inning to give the BlueClaws a lead they would not relinquish in a 5-4 win over Wilmington on Tuesday night at ShoreTown Ballpark for their fifth straight victory...Mitch Neunborn started and threw four scoreles innings...Daniel Harper got the last three outs for his sixth save of the season...Dissin, William Bergolla, and Troy Schreffler all had two hits for Jersey Shore.

State of the Claws... The BlueClaws have won five straight games - including the final four in Greensboro last week and the first game against Wilmington - to move from 3.5 games back to a half-game ahead of the Grasshoppers with just eight games left in the first half (which ends on June 20<sup>th</sup>)...The BlueClaws are in first place for the first time since May 14<sup>th</sup>...Jersey Shore hosts Wilmington this week while Greensboro is at Winston-Salem...The BlueClaws are 8nes over .500 for the first time this season.

Go Go Leandro...Leandro Pineda enters today on a 15-game hitting streak over which he is 22-65 (he extended it with the game winning 9th inning single on Saturday and had two hits on Sunday including a home run)...He is now 29-90 in his last 22 games to get back to .306 on the season...He leads the team with seven home runs on the year after hitting nine last year and also leads the team with 40 RBIs...Pineda had a different 13-game hitting streak through May 12<sup>th</sup>, the longest by a BlueClaw this season...Last season, Pineda hit .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS)...The BlueClaws franchise record hitting streak is 24 by Jiwan James in 2010 but this is the longest BlueClaws High-A hitting streak.

William The Kid...William Bergolla is 35-95 since he entered the April 30th game at .145 for the year...He is the BlueClaws youngest player (19) and tied the BlueClaws record with five hits in the win on Sunday (he is the 10th BlueClaw with five hits in a game and first since Emmanuel Marrero in 2016)...He hit his first professional home run on Saturday night...He ...He is 27-66 in his last 18 starts...The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20).

Just Grand ... The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30<sup>th</sup> – one by Justin Crawford (May 30<sup>th</sup>), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9<sup>th</sup>), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11<sup>th</sup>)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Dissin It .... Jordan Dissin has six home runs on the year and two this week - one on Sunday against Greensboro and a grand slam on Tuesday against Wilmington...Three of his six home runs have come since May 31<sup>st</sup> and he is 8-22 since then...Dissin was a 12<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2022 from Saddleback College in California after playing at Malvern Prep outisde of Philadelphia and spent one season at the University of Richmond.

Welcome, Aidan Miller...Phillies 1st round pick Aidan Miller (27th overall, 2023 draft) joins the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he was hitting .275 with five home runs, 26 RBIs, 16 doubles, and 10 stolen bases...His .483 SLG and his .884 OPS were both second in the Florida State League at the time of his promotion...Miller played at Mitchell High School in Trinity, Florida, 19.6 miles from Baycare Ballpark, home of the Clearwater Threshers

Pair of 1s...Aidan Miller joins Justin Crawford, who made his BlueClaws debut in August, and is the 16th Phillies firstround pick to play for the BlueClaws...The only previous time when the BlueClaws had two together was in 2017 when Mickey Moniak (2016 first round pick) and Adam Haseley (2017 first round pick) played together for the last three weeks of the season.

Record-Breaking Sunday... The BlueClaws tied the club record with 18 runs in their win on Sunday (4/20/11 at Asheville) and set a 9-inning record with 23 hits (they had 23 hits in a 22 inning game in 2006 against Hagerstown)...Additionally, the five hits from William Bergolla tied a club record set nine previous times but not since Emmanuel Marrero on 4/26/16 at Greensboro.

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper has allowed four earned runs in 22.2 innings so far this year with 32 strikeouts...Since May 1st, he's allowed one run in 15.2 innings with 22 strikeouts...Harper was an 18th round pick in 2022 from the University of Kentucky...He also has five saves on the year

Hello Wilmington...The BlueClaws host Wilmington this week at ShoreTown Ballpark, the second series of the year between the two teams...The BlueClaws swept the first one, winning all six between May 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> in Lakewood (outscoring the Blue Rocks 30-10 in six games, and holding to Wilmington to one run in four of the six games).

Jumpin Justin...Justin Crawford enters today with four straight multi-hit games (over which he is 10-20), giving him 19 multi-hit games on the season to lead the BlueClaws...Crawford had his second four-hit game of the season on Sunday at Greensboro...He was a double shy of the first cycle in BlueClaws history on May 30<sup>th</sup> but went 3-5 with a grand slam...He enters today at .293 on the seson (up from .273 after the first two games in Greensboro) and leads the BlueClaws with 20 stolen bases (he has 77 in his career)...He was the 17th overall pick in the 2022 draft from Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas.

By George... Phillies #28 prospect George Klassen has joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he was 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA in nine games... He gave up 3 ER in 38 IP on 21 hits with 57 strikeouts and 12 walks...Klassen was a 6<sup>th</sup> round pick last year from the University of Minnesota...He is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phillies draft pick from the University of Minnesota since 2000 (RHP Brett Schulze, 7th round in 2019 and LHP Nick Lackney in the 18th round in 2019)...Klassen is scheduled to start on Friday.

Promoted...Otto Kemp and Andrick Nava have both been promoted to Double-A Reading....Kemp hit .333 in 41 games with a .440 OBP (leading the league in both categories)...Nava hit .314 in 31 games with three home runs and 21 RBIs.

Save Index...Daniel Harper earned his 6th save of the season on Tuesday after picking up his 5th on Saturday in Greensboro...He leads the team with six saves...Gunner Mayer has three...Andrew Walling and Charles King each have two.

**Going Going Gone**...The BlueClaws (12 HRs in Lakewood and 25 on the road) hit a season-high five home runs on June 9<sup>th</sup> at Greensboro including a grand slam by Emaarino Boyd...Pineda leads the team with seven on the season...Jordan Dissin has six including a grand slam on June 11<sup>th</sup>...Justin Crawford is third on the team with four...William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8<sup>th</sup> at Greensboro.

**Comeback Claws**...The BlueClaws erased a five-run deficit on June 8<sup>th</sup> at Greensboro, their largest comeback win of the season (their largest last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10)...The win was their third in which they trailed entering the ninth inning (4/5 vs Aberdeen – Opening Night, 5/21 at Aberdeen, and 6/8 at Greensboro).

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 32 strikeouts in just 18.1 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

### *Three Saves for Gunner*...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves over the last few

weeks (two at Aberdeen between May 21<sup>st</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> and May 28<sup>th</sup> against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 27 batters in 21 innings (27 of the 83 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Keep On Chuck-king...Charles King earned a save on April 6<sup>th</sup> in his professinal debut...He threw two scoreless innings on May 19<sup>th</sup> to earn his first professional win...King signed with the Phillies in February after spending the two previous seasons with the Padres as a biomechanical pitching analyst...He had not played competitive baseball since graduating TCU in 2021 before signing with the Phillies after spending the winter at Driveline in Scottsdale...14 of his 18 outings this year have been scoreless outings and he has two saves.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once – in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

**Youth Is Served**...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3<sup>rd</sup> youngest), Bryan Rincon (9<sup>th</sup>), Justin Crawford (11<sup>th</sup>), Hendry Mendez (17<sup>th</sup>), and Emmaarion Boyd (21<sup>st</sup>).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15<sup>th</sup> former first round pick to play for the

BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

*Go Phils*...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

*Walk-Off This Way*...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9<sup>th</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

About: 22 year old, 6-1, 160 pound RHP from Maracay, Venezuela

How Acquired: Amateur Free Agent, signed 7/2019

Season Notes: Threw seven innings (one run) for the second straight start on 5/7 vs BG (only Andrew Painter, 2022, has done so as a BlueClaw since the team moved to High-A in 2021)...Gave up three runs over career-long seven innings on 4/30 vs BG (the first BC pitcher to throw seven innings in April since Adonis Medina on 4/21/2017)...Threw six scoreless innings, matching US long, on 4/18 vs BRK...Struck out 10 over five scoreless innings to earn second win on 4/12 at HIC...Gave up one run in five innings of Claws debut on 4/6 vs ABD, earning win...On Opening Day roster.

Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, going 5-7 with a 4.32 ERA, adding an 86/22 K/BB ratio in 81.1 innings...His 3.9 K/BB ratio was second in the FSL among pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched...Gave up one run in 12.1 innings over two postseason starts...In 2022, went 2-4, 5.24 with Clearwater...Won the Paul Owens Award in 2021 after he went 3-2, 1.54 in the Dominican Summer League...Was the first 19 year old pitcher to win the Paul Owens Award since Carlos Carrasco in 2006. Last Three Appearances: 6/6 at GBO – 4 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K...5/28 vs BRK – 6.2 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 9 K...5/21 at ABD – 5.2 IP, 7 H, 5 R/ER, 5 BB, 3 K Season Highs... IP (7, 2x last 5/7 vs WIL)...Rs (5, 2x last 5/21 at ABD)...ERs (5, 5/21 at ABD)...Ks (10, 4/12 at HIC)...BBs (5, 5/21 at ABD)

Season Notes: Had five hits in 6/9 win at GBO, tying BlueClaws record...Hit first professional home run on 6/8 at GBO...Had two hits and two RBIs in 6/1 win vs BRK...Had three hits and two RBIs in 5/26 win at ABD...Had three hits and three RBIs in 5/18 win at HV...Had four hits and scored three runs in 4/6 win vs ABD...Entered the season as the Phillies #12 prospect per MLB Pipeline...Opening Day age of 19 years, 5 months, and 17 days makes him the second youngest BlueClaw debuter since the team moved to High-A in 2021 behind only Andrew Painter (19 years, 2 months 2 days in 2022).

Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, where he played 55 games hitting .255 with 20 RBIs and two stolen bases...Struck out just 17 times and walked 30 in 218 plate appearances...Since 2005, Bergolla and Wander Franco are the only two 18/19 year olds with a 10% or greater walk rate and 10% or fewer strikeout rate (minimum 200 PAs)...Following the season, rated as having the best strike-zone discipline in the Phillies minor league system by Baseball America...Made pro debut with the DSL Phillies in 2022, hitting .380 in 24 games. Season Highs...Hits (5, 6/9 at GBO)...HRs (1, 6/8 at GBO)...RBIs (3, 5/18 at HV)

Acquired: 11<sup>th</sup> round pick, 2022 draft (South Panola HS, MS)

Resides: Batesville, Mississippi Season Notes: Hit a grand slam, his first BlueClaws home run, on 6/9 at GBO...Had three hits, two walks, and a SB in 6/7 win at GBO...Had three hits and RBI in 5/9 win vs WIL...Had three hits and two SBs in 4/19 win vs BRK...Had two hits including game-tying RBI triple, and scored game-winning run on Opening Night, 4/5 vs ABD...Entered the season as the #17 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline...On Opening Day roster.

Career Notes: Spent all of 2023 with Clearwater, where he hit .262 with one home run, 36 RBIs, and 56 stolen bases for the Division Champion Threshers...Stole six bases in a 6/6 win at Fort Myers, tied for the most by a MiLB player last year and since 2005...His 56 SBs were the third most by a Phillies minor leaguer since 2005 (Anthony Gose had 76 in 2009, Johan Rojas had 62 in 2022), and the 9th most in all of Minor League Baseball last year...Committed to Northwest Mississippi Community College before signing with the Phillies. Season Highs...Hits (3, 3x last 6/7 at GBO)...HRs (1, 6/9 at GBO)...RBIs (4, 6/9 at GBO)

Hit first HR on 5/9 vs IL (previous was 5/16/23 w/ CLR)...Three straight multi-hit games (7-11) thru 4/13...On Opening Day roster. 
