This Section is About T.J. Schofield-Sam: Lansing's first baseman is 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.354), and leads the MiLB leader, Carlos Gutierrez, in OPS, .968-.919. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in total bases (112), base hits (74) and HBPs (18), and ranks 2nd in OPS (.968), tied for 2nd in triples (4), 3rd in slugging (.536), 3rd in OBP (.432), 4th in runs scored (41), tied for 5th in doubles (15) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (24).

Rocking Double-A: Promoted Lugnuts starter Yunior Tur has been exceptional with the Midland RockHounds since being sent up, particularly yesterday - Tur tossed 5 2/3 hitless innings against the Frisco RoughRiders, as Midland took a no-hitter into the 8th before losing 2-1. Overall, Tur has faced 23 batters in the Texas League and allowed only one hit and one walk while striking out seven.

The Next Lugnuts Rookie of the Year: Athletics rookie shortstop Jacob Wilson ranks 2nd in Major League Baseball in batting average (.369) and base hits (97); Wilson played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023. Only one Nut in franchise history has won the Rookie of the Year Award: Carlos Beltran, who played in Lansing in 1996 and won the award for Kansas City in 1999.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (430), 3rd in batting average (.258), 2nd in base hits (528), tied for 1st in doubles (123), 3rd in on-base percentage (.356), 3rd in total bases (786), tied for 3rd in OPS (.739).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (27), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (21), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (219) and 3rd in saves (16).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 65 double plays this season, most in the Midwest League.

Welcome to the Show: Five former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in the Majors this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Marlins to players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23) and Jack Winkler (May 31), increasing the overall total to 197 Nuts who've worked their way from Lansing to MLB.

June 15th in Lugnuts History

2008: The Lugnuts scored 11 runs in the eighth inning, demolishing the Great Lakes Loons, 18-6, to clinch the first-half Eastern Division title on the last day of the half. The Nuts tied a franchise record with five home runs (Matt Liuzza 2, John Tolisano, Mike McDade, Moises Sierra); Eric Eiland set the franchise record with five runs scored (going 3-for-3 with three singles, three walks and two steals); John Tolisano and Matt Liuzza each drove in five runs; and Liuzza and Raul Barron each collected four of the Nuts' 22 hits.

2016: The Great Lakes Loons came one out from throwing their first no-hitter in franchise history, but Wes Helsabeck plunked John La Prise, Josh Almonte singled to center, and J.C. Cardenas, batting from the right side, hit a three-run homer. The Loons completed a 6-3 victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader at Cooley Law School Stadium. Cardenas had hit a three-run homer from the left side in Game 1, a 10-1 rout of Great Lakes.



Starting Out: Corey Avant's first start of the season came due to unusual circumstances: April 25 vs. Fort Wayne, the start time was pushed back an hour due to worry of inclement weather; Avant pitched two innings, allowing one run, before yielding to the scheduled starter, Gage Jump, who struck out 13 batters in 6 2/3 dominant scoreless innings in a 3-1 Lugnuts win... on May 8 at West Michigan, Avant tossed two innings, allowing two runs, as the opener for Steven Echavarria, who followed with 4 2/3 scoreless innings in a 4-2 Lugs victory... Avant started the first game of this series and blanked the Cubs for the first two innings and one out into the third before allowing two straight singles and departing; both runners scored against Jake Garland... the Nuts went on to win, 7-6, in ten innings.

High School: Avant attended Sun Valley H.S., the Spartans, whose fight song is the Michigan State University fight song, Victory for MSU... the school's colors are maroon and gold, a la Central Michigan University... Sun Valley also produced NFL QB Sam Howell... Avant graduated Class of 2020.

College: Onward to Wingate University (named for Washington Manly Wingate, the fourth president at Wake Forest), the Bulldogs, colors: navy and gold... Avant majored in Math Business... redshirted the 2021 season, in which Wingate went 39-13, earned the No. 1 seed, and won the Division II National Championship in Cary, North Carolina, at the USA Baseball National Training Complex... in 2022, the Bulldogs set a program record for wins, going 48-10 with a 29-3 home record (first in the nation in both wins and winning percentage), but lost in the Southeast Regionals; redshirt freshman Avant went 3-1 with a 3.41 ERA in 26 relief appearances / 29 IP: 1 HR, 15 BB, 51 K... followed up in 2023 as a redshirt sophomore, striking out 57 batters in 39 innings (5.31, 23 G, 2 GS, 27 BB), as the Bulldogs finished 32-18, 18-6 in conference, but were eliminated in the SAC Tourney... excelled off the field with a 4.00 GPA, named two-time Academic All-America and served as Commencement Marshal at 2023 graduation
