TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up a six-game series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Sunday afternoon.

LAST TIME OUT: Richmond earned a 4-1 win on Saturday night. Sammy Siani picked up two hits in the defeat.

SLAMMIN' SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has turned in one of his best weeks of the season against Richmond, earning a hit in each of his four games played. During the week, he's batting: .500/.563/.714/1.277 with 1 2B, 1 3B and 4 RBI.

THREE BAGS ARE MY FAVORITE: The Curve matched the franchise record with three triples in a game on Friday, August 2 against Richmond. Yoyner Fajardo tripled home Eli Wilson in the second inning and then Abrahan Gutierrez and Sammy Siani hit triples on consecutive pitches in the seventh inning to match the record. It was the first time since June 2, 2022 that the Curve picked up three triples in a game, which they also did against the Flying Squirrels on that day.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has morphed into one of Double-A's most dominating pitchers since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 8 batters in 55.2 IP with 64 strikeouts, recording a 5-4 record with a 2.75 ERA (17 ER / 55.2 IP) with a 0.81 WHIP. Since June 21, he ranks 2nd in the Eastern League in BAA (.148), 1st in WHIP (0.65), 10th in IP (33.0) and 3rd in strikeouts (47). Chandler has struck out at least 7 batters in 6 of his last 8 outings with the Curve. Chandler was the league leader in BAA (.192) and WHIP (1.01) at the time of his premation to Triple A ladjacancile. at the time of his promotion to Triple-A Indianapolis.

BUT I *WANT* TO BE A PIRATE: The Pittsburgh Pirates assigned Isiah Kiner-Falefa to the Curve on rehab on Friday, August 2, his first game with Pittsburgh after the trade. Acquired on trade deadline day for Curve INF Charles McAdoo, Kiner-Falefa is recovering from a left knee injury that he suffered with Toronto and becomes the fourth Pirate to rehab with Altoona this season, joining C Henry Davis, RHP David Bednar, and LHP Ryan Borucki. IKF went 2-for-4 with a double in seven innings in the field against the Flying Squirrels.

FATHER ABRAHAN, SEND US HOME: For the second time this season, catcher Abrahan Gutierrez sent Altoona to a walk-off victory on August 1 against Richmond. After plating the game-winning run on July 6 against Harrisburg with a fielder's choice, Gutierrez lifted a game-winning sacrifice fly on Thursday night against Richmond for the Curve's fourth walk-off victory of the season.

LOTS OF PUNCHIES: Altoona has had 17 7-strikeout games this season, the most since 2018 when the Curve had 25 7-strikeout peformances. Tyler Glasnow in 2015 recorded 8.7-strikeout games, the most by an individual in a single-season in franchise history. Bubba Chandler has recorded six 7-strikeout games this season. The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (Thomas Harrington, Bubba Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The six 10-strikeout games by Curve pitchers this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

A COMEBACK FOR THE AGES: The Curve matched the franchise record for largest comeback to win on Wednesday, July 31 against Richmond. Trailing 7-0 after the top of the 7th, the Curve rallied for nine unanswered runs to earn a 9-7 win. It was the fourth time in team history that the Curve rallied to win from a 7-run deficit, the first time since April 29, 2018 at Harrisburg.

NO STRESS FOR TRES: July has been the hottest month of the season for Tres Gonzalez. In 17 games during the calendar month, he batted .357/.429/.393 with 2 2B and 8 RBI. From July 23 - August 1 he put together a season-long seven-game hit streak which included three two-hit games and a three-hit game. After recording six multi-hit games in the first three months of the season, Gonzalez had seven multi-hit games in July.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 12 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.43 ERA (20 ER / 74.0 IP) with 60 strikeouts.

THE SQUIRRELS IN FLIGHT: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the postseason in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Managerial wins list. The Flying Squirrels are a touch light in the prospect department, but OF Wade Meckler (No. 14) is back in the fold. INF Diego Velasquez is also here (No. 22) along with RHP Eric Silva (No. 25) and C Adrian Sugastey (No. 30).

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: John Michael Bertrand takes the ball again on Sunday afternoon for Richmond, he allowed 4 runs in 5.1 innings on Tuesday night against the Curve. Bertrand is the second Flying Squirrel in team history to earn two EL Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, first since Eric Surkamp in 2011. Bertrand was San Francisco's 10th round pick in 2022 out of Notre Dame and reached Richmond for 11 starts in 2023 where he recorded a 4.67 ERA. Bertrand began his college career at Furman where he pitched for three seasons before finishing at Notre Dame, his father Jim rowed collegiately at the University of San Diego and his brother JD was a linebacker and team captain for Notre Dame's Football team.
