LAST OUTING: Patrick picked up his 12 win with 6.0 scoreless innings and eight strikeouts against Jacksonville on august 25.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's third start against Gwinnett. He took a no-decision in his first start (5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 ER) in Nashville's 4-3 loss on June 15 before getting the win on August 1 (5.1 IP, 1 ER, 6 K).

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Tossed three scoreless innings in Sounds debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul
- Held Omaha to a couple of hits and a run over six innings for first quality start of season on April 19
