**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 7-5. **Shane Matheny**, in his first at-bat with Richmond this year, hit a solo homer on the second pitch of the game. Later in the inning, **Vaun Brown** scored on an error and **Brandon Martorano** hit an RBI single to open a 3-0 lead. **Carter Aldrete** extended the lead to 4-0 in the third with a solo home run. The Baysox tied the game in the fourth with a two-run single by Zach Watson and a two-run homer by Billy Cook. **Simon Whiteman** worked a bases-loaded walk in the fifth to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 5-4. In the sixth, Coby Mayo gave the Baysox a 7-5 lead with a three-run triple. **Carson Whisenhunt** allowed a career-high four runs, all in the fourth. All seven Baysox runs scored with two outs and two strikes.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second and third games of a six-day, seven-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today is the 7th and 8th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-1 at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29. The Sunday finale of that series was rained out. The Baysox will come to The Diamond for six-game sets from July 4-9 and August 8-13.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 25-of-their-last-36. Their 11-25 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 2011 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 291.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.27 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is tied for the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

**THE BAYSOX** are in last place in the Southwest Division but have won six-of-seven, including five-of-six last week in Erie. Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including INF Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), INF Cesar Prieto (No. 16), RHP Justin Armbroester (No. 22) and OF John Rhodes (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including Mayo (No. 8), Povich (No. 11), Prieto (No. 16), McDermott (No. 17), Rhodes (No. 19) and Armbroester (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Mason Black** makes his 12th Double-A start and second against the Baysox in Game 1. He last pitched on Thursday against the Curve and threw four scoreless innings, allowing two hits and a walk with six strikeouts. He faced the Baysox on April 27 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed one run over four innings with a season-high eight strikeouts. On the year, Black is ranked fifth in the Eastern League (min. 40 IP) in K/9 (11.3). Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his 12th start of the season and his second this year against the Baysox in Game 2. Last time out, Teng threw a season-high five innings and allowed two runs against the Curve on Friday with eight strikeouts. This year, Teng is seventh in the Eastern League in strikeouts (63). Among EL pitchers who have worked at least 40 innings, Teng is ranked first in strikeout percentage (34.1) and K/9 (13.4). Teng has climbed to fourth on the Flying Squirrels' career strikeouts list with 232 over the last two seasons. All other pitchers in the top-nine have spent at least three seasons with the Flying Squirrels. Those 232 strikeouts are also the most among all Double-A pitchers since the start of the 2022 season. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Mychal Givens starts Game 1 on an MLB rehab assignment. He last pitched on May 31 for the Orioles against the Guardians and allowed three runs without recording an out in a loss. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on June 1 with right shoulder inflammation. Givens began the year on the IL with left knee inflammation. His first outing of the season was on a rehab assignment against the Flying Squirrels on April 29 and he threw a scoreless inning. Givens was selected by the Orioles in the second round (54th overall) of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Plant High School in Florida. He pitched for the Baysox in 2015, going 4-2 with a 1.73 ERA in 35 relief outings, earning a selection for the Eastern League All-Star Game. He has pitched 425 MLB games in his career for the Orioles, Rockies, Reds, Cubs and Mets. He returned to Baltimore after signing as a free agent in November.

Right-hander Justin Armbroester makes his 12th start of the season and his second this year against the Flying Squirrels in Game 2. Last time out, he allowed a season-high six runs over five innings in a no-decision at Erie on Thursday. He last faced Richmond on April 27 at Prince George's Stadium and surrendered one run over five innings. In his five career starts against the Flying Squirrels, Armbroester is 0-0 with a 2.46 ERA (6 ER/22.0 IP). In the Eastern League, he is ranked second in ERA (2.45), fifth in WHIP (1.15) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (55.0). Armbroester is rated by Baseball America as the No. 22 Orioles prospect and No. 30 by MLB.com. He was selected by the Orioles in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of New Mexico.

**I LOVE LUCI:** On Saturday night, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep twice in the ACL on July 2, 2019. He also had a pair of two-homer games with Low-A San Jose on May 19 and June 29, 2021. His six RBIs was a new career high. The second-inning grand slam was the third of his professional career, with the others coming with High-A Eugene on August 19 and August 30, 2022. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his eight home runs are tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League. On Tuesday, he reached base twice with a single and a walk.

**WELCOME BACK, WADE:** **Wade Meckler** was reinstated from the injured list on Saturday after missing 12 games. In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.414) and ranks 11th in OBP (.468). He has picked up 10 hits and five walks in his eight Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

**GLOW SHOW:** Infielder **Jimmy Glownke** was promoted to Double-A on May 30. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glownke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glownke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (.146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (14.3) in the league. He has hit safely in eight-of-his-last-nine games, including four hits in his last three since Friday.

**WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY:** **Carter Williams** has hit safely in each of his last 12 games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .348 (16-for-46) with two homers, three doubles, three RBIs and 11 runs scored. His 12-game hit streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the longest by a Richmond player this year, ahead of a nine-game streak by **Carter Aldrete** from May 19-28. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for second in triples (3). **Hayden Cantrelle** is tied for ninth in walks (35). **Evan Gates** is tied for ninth in saves (4). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for seventh in strikeouts (63). **Carson Seymour** is 10th in ERA (3.35).

**WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK:** Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.360), sixth in OBP (.406), ninth in OPS (.885), first in hits (76) and seventh in total bases (101). Coby Mayo is fourth in OBP (.408), ninth in SLG (.528), seventh in OPS (.936), 10th in hits (56), first in doubles (20), tied for ninth in walks (35), tied for second in extra-base hits (30) and tied for fifth in total bases (104). Justin Armbroester is second in ERA (2.45), tied for sixth in innings pitched (55.0) and fifth in WHIP (1.15).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 8), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and **José Cruz** is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
