TEEING OFF

- **LET'S GET IT STARTED:** The Jackets look to curtail this 3-game losing streak in a doubleheader, as 14 innings lay on tap in Charleston today.
- **THE PEN IS MIGHTIER:** Augusta's relievers have been on a roll as of late, and had a 38 consecutive scoreless inning streak over 7+ games in early August.
- **RANK 'EM:** Six players from MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Braves Prospects are currently on Augusta's roster, as of the midseason update. The highest regarded is #1 prospect LHP Cam Caminiti, along with INF Tate Southisene (#3), INF John Gil (#15), OF Luis Guanipa (#22), RHP Ethan Bagwell (#29), and RHP Rayven Antonio (#30).
- **GO JOHNNY GO:** Infielder John Gil has lit up the box score as of late, hitting .361 with a 1.057 OPS in the month of August, including four home runs over 17 games.
- **G.I. JOE:** Joe Olsavsky is 18-48 (.375) in his last 14 starts, currently riding a career-high 10-game on-base streak. Olsavsky's on-base percentage is nearly .500 this month, as he forces his way into the lineup and provides quality at bats for the Jackets.
- ALL NATURAL GAINS, BOYS: After a league-worst 49-80 record last year where Augusta set organizational lows in a number of offensive categories, Wynston Sawyer's squad has improved dramatically this year. The Jackets eclipsed last year's win total on July 31st, and numbers are up across the board on both sides of the ball.
- **BRING EM HOME:** Augusta has seen its team average with runners in scoring position rise over the last few weeks, up to .241 after falling below .225 at the middle of July. The Jackets have fell back to Earth of late, hitting just 12-63 w/ RISP in the last 7 games.
- **STRONG START:** The Jackets' starting pitchers have been rock solid as of late, especially at home. Augusta's starters have allowed more than two earned runs just twice in the last 22 home games, continuously keeping the team in the game early.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Jeremy Reyes looks to keep rolling after back-to-back quality starts, as Andrew Lindsay returns from the IL to start for the Dogs.

A mainstay at SRP Park over the last few years, Elvin Nina returns to the GreenJackets to guide the pitching staff for the second straight year. Nina was previously with the FCL Braves for the last two seasons, also as pitching coach, and served in the same role for Augusta in 2021. A native of San Cristobal, Nina played collegiately at both Northeastern Oklahoma A&M and Oklahoma State before being drafted in the 17th Rd of the 1997 Draft by the Oakland Athletics. Nina played 9 seasons in the minors across 5 organizations, while also seeing time in the Chinese Professional League, the Mexican League, and the Atlantic League. RUBEN GOTAY

CO-HITTING COACH

Joining Wilkinson to work with the hitters, Ruben Gotay begins his first year as a coach in the Braves organization, having spent last year coaching in the Mexican League with the Caliente de Durango. Gotay brings a wealth of additional experience coaching in MiLB, having spent 2023 with the Indianapolis Indians, 2021-22 with the Greensboro Grasshoppers, and 2018-19 with the Clearwater Threshers. The Puerto Rican product played professionally for 17 seasons, including parts of four years in the majors with the Royals, Mets, and Braves.

2025 marks the first year coaching in professional baseball for Brad Stoll, who joins the Braves' system following nearly 20 years coaching at Lawrence High School in Kansas. During his time with the Chesty Lions, Stoll won a 6A State Championship in 2009 and saw two former players go on to play in Major League Baseball: Garrett Cleavinger and Bryce Montes de Oca. Stoll's additional experience lies in the Cape Cod League, where he was an assistant with the Falmouth Commodores from 2009-15 and again in 2024.
