Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series tonight against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the second-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and secibd-of-six in Reading. The teams did not face off in 2023, as the last time Reading and Akron played was in Akron from Apr. 12-16, 2022. This is the first time the RubberDucks are in Baseballtown since Aug. 10-15, 2021. Akron leads the season series 1-0.

Shake It Off

Reading fell 19-3 to Akron on Tuesday night. Matt Osterberg lasted just 2.2 innings, allowing eight runs on eight hits. Zach Haake then allowed five runs on eight hits, then Akron tagged Matt Russell, Cristian Hernandez and Andrick Nava for six-more runs on 10 additional hits. For Reading, the Fightin Phils got a solo home run from Otto Kemp and RBI from Josh Breaux and Cade Fergus on hits in the ninth. Reading tied a season-high in runs allowed, runs allowed in an inning and home runs in a game. Reading set highs in hits allowed in a game and hits allowed in an inning, with 10 allowed in the eight-run third for Akron. It was the first time Reading allowed 20+ hits in a game sine Aug. 18, 2023, against Somerset. Reading allowed 26 hits in total, marking the first time the R-Phils have allowed 25+ hits in a game since allowing 25 to Bowie on May 28, 1994, in a 22-2 loss to the Baysox.

A Man Called Otto (Races Around the Bases)

In game one on Friday, Otto Kemp his an inside-the-park home run for his fifth home since being called up from High-A Jersey Shore. It was the first inside-the-park homer hit by a Fightin Phil since Arquimedes Gamboa his one against Portland on July 15, 2021. It was also the first inside-the-park home run hit by Kemp in his professional career, but also in his entire life playing baseball. Kemp added his sixth home run on Tuesday night, one that left the ballpark.

On The Move

Carlos De La Cruz was promoted to Triple-A Lehigh Valley ahead of their game on Tuesday. It was a move that was a long-time coming for De La Cruz. After a slow start to the season, De La Cruz turned it on since June began. From June 1 until his call-up (30 games), De La Cruz slashed .314/.390/.529 (.919 OPS). He added 25 runs, six doubles, one triple, six home runs and 18 RBI. His strikeout numbers were down as well as he punched out 33 times in 136 plate appearance. De La Cruz was hitting .208 on June 1, and leaves Reading with a .262 batting average. In total, De La Cruz appeared in 232 games with the Fightin Phils, dating back to his call-up from High-A Jersey Shore on Aug. 1, 2022. De La Cruz hit 39 home runs and drove in 125 RBI over his time in Reading.

Coming from the Shore

Prior to Tuesday night's game, the Phillies promoted pitching prospects Samuel Aldegheri and Jean Cabrera from High-A Jersey Shore. Both have been impressive, winning South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week accolades. Cabrera will start Thursday and Aldegheri will get the ball on Friday.

Phillips is a Phillie

Former Fightin Phil Tyler Phillips made his big-league debut on Sunday. Phillips was impressive, as the righty went four innings, allowing three hits, one run, no walks and seven strikeouts. His seven strikeouts were the most by a Phillie in their Major League debut since Cole Hamels had seven strikeouts in his debut on May 12, 2006, at Cincinnati. His seven strikeouts in relief also broke a 123-year old record of most relief strikeouts in a Phillies Major League debut.

Hey Now, You're an All-Star

Two former Fightin Phils were named All-Star representatives of the Phillies last week. Ranger Suarez (2018) and Alec Bohm (2019) will both represent the Phillies in the midsummer classic next week in Arlington, Texas.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 10, 1955: At Schenectady, Roger Maris belts two home runs for the second straight day and scores four runs in Reading's 11-2 thumping of the Blue Jays. Jim Tolleson also hits a pair of homers and drives in four.

Akron's In Town

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with a 10-3 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently took four-of-six in their split series with Erie. Following this week, Akron hosts Richmond in their first series after the break. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (14), Peter Halpin (15), Parker Messick (21), CJ Kayfus (27) and Dayan Frias (28).

Duck on the Bump

Righty Austin Peterson makes the start tonight for Akron. It's his second start with Akron after being called up from High-A Lake County on June 24. Between the two stops, he's 9-2, with a 2.30 ERA over 16 games. He allowed one hits and no runs, with five strikeouts in a win on July 3 against Erie. He made his pro debut with Single-A Lynchburg last year, going 6-8, with a 4.54 ERA over 24 starts. The Guardians drafted him in ninth round in 2022 out of UConn.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start Apr. 7 at Bowie. Allowed just two-earned runs over five innings, but did not record any strikeouts or walks. Picked up season-best to date seven punchouts Apr. 13 vs Portland, but suffered loss as he gave up five-earned runs over just three innings pitched. Was efficient, throwing 40-of-63 pitches for strikes in loss. Twirled best start of season to date Apr. 19 at BNG. Matched season-high with five innings and set new-season best with nine strikeouts in the win. Tossed best outing of season on Apr. 25 vs SOM, earning second-straight win. Threw season-high six innings and did not allow a run, with five hits scattered. Earned third-straight win May 4 at Portland. Season-high 11 strikeouts, which was the most in a game by a R-Phils since 2018 season. Picked up fourth-straight win May 8 vs Hartford. Streak of four-straight winning decisions snapped with loss May 18 at RIC. Allowed two runs on seven hits. Lasted just four innings as he fell victim to high pitch count. Earned team-leading fifth win May 25 vs BNG, striking out eight over five innings. Matched season-high with eight hits allowed. Has earned a decision in seven-straight starts and win in five-of-six. No-decision on June 2 at HFD, allowing one run over 5.2 IP, but did work around some traffic. Was his first start without a decisions since his first one of season on April 7 (seven-straight decisions). Tossed first complete-game shutout of professional career with seven two-hit innings against Harrisburg on June 8. Named Eastern League pitcher of the Week on June 10. Picked up second-straight win and seventh of season June 14 vs POR. Earned team-leading eighth win June 21 at New Hampshire, allowing two runs and three hits over five innings of work. Struck out five and walked none. Finished June strong with fourth-straight win June 28 vs BOW. Allowed two runs and struck out six over six innings in quality start. Made 19 appearances (7 starts) with Rocket City and had 3.29 ERA. Struck out 58 hitters across 68 innings. Returned to Triple-A Salt Lake on Sept. 1 to close out season. Overall, made seven appearances and four starts in two Triple-A stints and had 7.83 ERA. Pitched for Estrellas Orientales in Dominican Winter League after season. Made six appearances and five starts, posting 3.54 ERA and eight strikeouts over 20.1 innings pitched.
