**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Hudson Valley won the finale of the six-game series at Dutchess Stadium, beating Brooklyn 6-2 to take four of six games. RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out seven but allowed back-to-back home runs and all four runs (three earned) that scored in the four-run fourth to give Hudson Valley a 4-0 lead. INF **Jose Peroza** homered in the fifth, clobbering his third of the year. In the ninth, the Cyclones loaded the bases but did not score against Renegades RHP **Josue Panacual**.

**THE CENTER OF THE UNIVERSE:** Coney Island is the headquarters of the Fourth of July, hosting the Nathan's Famous Hot Dog Eating Contest at the corner of Surf Avenue and Stillwell Avenue. This morning, **Miki Sudo** won her eighth contest in the past nine years, devouring 40 hot dogs in 10 minutes, beating the next-best opponent by 14 dogs and buns. On the men's side, the legend himself, **Joey Chestnut**, ate 63 hot dogs and buns in 10 minutes at noon. The 38-year-old "Jaws" has won seven in a row and 15 of the past 16.

**STAR-STUDED MOVES:** Mets No. 4 prospect, OF **Alex Ramirez**, has been promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn. Ramirez ranks fourth in the system behind No. 1 C **Francisco Alvarez**, No. 2 3B **Brett Baty**, and No. 3 SS **Ronny Mauricio**. Ramirez, who is just 19 years old, spent the past two seasons at St. Lucie. He is joined today by OF **Stanley Consuegra** who earns his first promotion to High-A.

**HAMEL COMES HERE:** RHP **Dominic Hamel**, the Mets No. 9 prospect has also earned a promotion to the High-A Brooklyn Cyclones. Hamel was drafted by New York in the Third Round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist.

**HOUSEKEEPING:** RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned a promotion to Double-A Binghamton after tossing 15

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Baltimore Orioles affiliate, who clinched the first half title in the North Division, comes to Coney Island for the Fourth of July. Aberdeen promoted several of its key players from the first half, including OF Colton Cowser, INF Coby Mayo, and INF Connor Norby. However, the 'Birds still have No. 21 OF John Rhodes, No 28 SS Darell Hernaiz, and No. 29 RHP Jean Pinto who make up the only Top 30 Baltimore prospects on the roster.

1/3 innings with one earned run, posting a 0.59 ERA. He saved seven games in seven tries.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 33 home runs in the past 41 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**ARMS STRONG:** Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

**FIVE MILLION:** This past home series against Jersey Shore, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night.

**SECOND HALF START:** Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Santos allowed three doubles to start the game, giving up three early runs against Hudson Valley. He settled down to allow one run over five innings after the early trouble.

**HIGH-RANKING MEMBER:** Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

**NSYNC:** Santos had been a much more dominant pitcher in May after a rocky April. In May, the 20-year-old righty had a 2.25 ERA with a 21% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate after an 8.03 ERA in four April starts with an 18% strikeout rate and 16% walk rate. In April, Santos did not make it into the fifth inning but has lasted into the fifth inning three times in May.

**BREAKOUT:** The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

**VALUED MEMBER:** Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

**WEIRD START:** Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos' clunky start may have been affected by Friday night's postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels.
