- The Blue Jays manufactured two seventh inning runs to take a 4-3 victory over Tampa on Thursday night at TD Ballpark.
- Ryan Watson pitched 5.1 strong innings in his Single-A debut, striking out seven.
- After Tampa claimed a 2-0 lead, Dunedin scored twice in the bottom of the fourth. Arjun Nimmala belted a solo homer, and then Tucker Toman brought in a run on a sacrifice fly to knot the game at two.
- The Tarpons regained the lead with an RBI single from Hans Montero with two outs.
- The Blue Jays scored twice on just one hit in the seventh, as Nic Deschamps scored on a Nimmala sac fly, and Bryce Arnold scored the game's eventual deciding run on a wild pitch.

ONE RUN RENDEZVOUS

Last night's one-run defeat marked the fifth consecutive one-run game for the Blue Jays, and their 32nd this season - the most in the FSL. The Jays are 16-16 in those contests. 57 of the Blue Jays 83 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 30-27 record in those games.

GAINING GROUND

With last night's Blue Jays win and Fort Myers loss, the Blue Jays are just one game out of first place in the FSL West second half standings.

SERIES SUCCESS

With last week's five games to one series win, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in seven of their last eight sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series). A win tonight would clinch at least a series split.

NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

Blue Jays No. 3 prospect Arjun Nimmala continued his tear last night with his fifth home run of the season. In 11 games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Nimmala has a hit in 10 and is hitting .350 (14-40). 10 of those hits have gone for extra bases, the second-most extra base hits in the FSL since June 27.

JAMMIN' IN JULY

Dunedin's 7-2 start to July is the best in the Florida State League. The hot start is thanks in large part to the team's bats. Across nine games this month, the Jays are hitting .273 (2nd in the league), with a league-leading .900 OPS. Their 11 home runs this month is tied for the league lead with Bradenton.

BLUE JAYS BLASTS

Dunedin has homered in five straight games and seven of their last eight games.

CRISTIAN CRUSHES BASEBALLS

Cristian Feliz extended his season-long on base streak to nine games last night with a double and two walks. Feliz's 14 home runs this season are second in the FSL behind Ariel Almonte's 16. In six games against Clearwater last week, Feliz went 8-17 with 3 HRs and a league-leading 1.591 OPS to earn FSL Player of the Week honors. Feliz is on pace to hit the most home runs by a D-Jay in a single season since Orelvis Martinez hit 19 in 71 games in 2021.

FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

HITTERS PARK

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 78 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 86, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 42 home runs allowed at home.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Andres Sosa and Brennan Orf added to the mix Tuesday, Dunedin has hosted 16 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).
