Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights play game four of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Charlotte won last night's game, 5-1, but has dropped two of three in the series. Tonight, left-hander Ethan Small starts for Nashville against right-hander Kade McClure for Charlotte.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small starts for Nashville in tonight's game. The left-hander is making his fourth start of the season, and third at home. Small is 1-0 with a 0.68 ERA (13.1 IP/1 ER). He has allowed only 5 hits and 7 walks to go along with 18 strikeouts while limiting hitters to a .111 average in 2022. Last time out he tossed 6.0 shutout innings on April 16 at Gwinnett. He enters the season as the #7 prospect in the Brewers organization according to MLB Pipeline and #9 prospect according to Baseball America. He made nine starts for Nashville in 2021 and went 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA. He's also coming off a season where he was named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star and pitched for the National League Futures team in the MLB Futures Game. Milwaukee selected Small as the 28th overall pick of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft.

Kade McClure: 26-year-old Kade McClure starts for the Knights in game four of the set. The right-hander is making his fourth start of the season with three of them coming on the road. He's 0-0 with a 4.73 ERA (13.1 IP/7 ER). McClure last pitched on April 16 vs. Memphis and got a no-decision despite allowed 5 runs (all earned) on 7 hits in 3.2 innings. He allowed 4 home runs to the Redbirds and threw 52 of his 75 pitches for strikes. McClure split his 2021 season between Charlotte and Double-A Birmingham. He went 4-7 with a 4.87 ERA (105.1 IP/57 ER) in 24 starts across the two levels. He walked 35 and struck out 113. This is McClure's first career appearance against Nashville. The White Sox drafted him in the 6th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisville.

He Gets On Base: Garrett Whitley had two more hits last night and extended his on-base streak to 11 games. It's tied for the fifth-longest on-base streak in the International League this year. During the streak, Whitley is hitting .270 (10-for-37) with 2 doubles, 1 RBI, 8 walks and 3 stolen bases.

White Hot: Sounds infielder Tyler White continues to swing a hot bat and knocked in another run with a base hit last night. White has recorded at least one RBI in five consecutive games and has hit safely in six straight. He's hitting .455 (10-for-22) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI and 2 walks during the streak.

Fourth Time Around: Tonight's start by Ethan Small marks Nashville's fourth time through the original starting rotation set forth in 2022. To date, Nashville starters are 7-3 with a 3.06 ERA (70.2 IP/24 ER) with 24 walks and 66 strikeouts. Dylan File is averaging the most pitches per game (81.0) and Josh Lindblom has the most strikes per game (54.0) of all the starters.

Defense Wins Games: The Sounds have not made an error since April 14 at Gwinnett, going 61.1 innings without a miscue in the field.

vs. Charlotte: The Sounds and Knights are scheduled to play each other 14 more times in 2022 after tonight, with two of the series at First Horizon Park (April 19-24, July 26-31) and one in Charlotte (September 6-11). Nashville won 7 of 12 games last year, the first time the two clubs have met. The two teams split a six-game series in Charlotte June 1-6 and the Sounds won 4 of 6 games June 22-27 at First Horizon Park. Nashville is 9-5 all-time against the Knights.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA is still an International League-best at 2.71. The Sounds have the lowest ERA in Triple-A Baseball and the second-lowest ERA in all of Minor League Baseball behind only Single-A Lake County at 2.52.

Hold the Line: Nashville relievers have amassed 18 holds this season, far and away the most in Triple-A baseball (Columbus and Oklahoma City are tied for second-most with 12).

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 519-464 record during this span.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Small made his third start of the season on April 16 at Gwinnett and tossed 6.0 shutout innings in Nashville's 10-0 win. He limited the Stripers to just 1 hit and 3 walks while recording 7 strikeouts. The south-paw threw 51 of his 83 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small made his Triple-A debut against Charlotte on June 24, 2021 at First Horizon Park. He went 2.2 innings and allowed 2 runs on 3 hits and 5 walks. He recorded 1 strikeout and threw 37 of his 62 pitches for strikes.
