Today: Coming off a season-opening victory last night, the Lugnuts, in their third season as the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the middle contest of a three-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, the High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Starting Matchup: MLB Pipeline's No. 30 prospect in the A's organization, 2022 fourth-rounder **Jacob Watters**, makes his first start of the year, opposed by Great Lakes right-hander **Ben Casparius**, a fifth-round selection in 2021. West Virginia product Watters did not face the Loons last year, with his only 2022 appearances for the Lugnuts coming against South Bend (one inning, August 31) and Dayton (two innings, September 6). UConn's Casparius conversely made six appearances against the Lugnuts going 1-2 with a 6.86 ERA in 19 2/3 IP with five walks and 20 strikeouts. **Blake Beers** is expected to follow Watters to the mound after a couple of innings today.

LUG•NOTES

Meet the New Boss: **Craig Conklin**, the Nuts' Assistant Hitting Coach last season, is the 18th manager in Lugnuts team history. Hailing from Malibu, Calif., Conklin entered professional baseball as an area supervisor at the Major League Baseball Scouting Bureau. He then spent four years scouting Southern California for the Athletics before serving on the Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators' staff in 2019 and on the Single-A Stockton Ports' staff in 2021. This is his first season managing in Minor League Baseball.

Opening Notes: The Nuts have matched up with the Loons on four prior occasions in the season-opening series, going 3-1 on Opening Day. - In 2012, the Nuts raised the curtain with a three-game sweep in Lansing, the tone set by dominant scoreless performances in tandem by future Major Leaguers **Noah Syndergaard** (3 IP, 6 K) and **Anthony DeSclafani** (3 IP, 4 K) on Opening Day.

- In 2016, the Lugnuts were snowed out and rained out in the first two scheduled days at home against the Loons, turning around and heading to Midland for the next two days (a 5-4 loss in which the broadcaster computer was broken by a **Jordan Paroubeck** foul ball and another rainout).

- In 2017, the first day was postponed, but teenagers **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** homered the next day as the Lugnuts swept a four-game home-and-home series.

- And in 2018, the Lugnuts dominated the Loons at Dow Diamond, 12-1, with **Yennsy Diaz** striking out 10 in 5 2/3 innings of one-hit ball. The offense scored six runs in the ninth inning to turn the game into a full-on rout.

Familiar Faces: In addition to Conklin and pitching coach **Don Schulze**, entering his third straight season in Lansing, the Lugnuts' roster includes 18 players with prior experience in Mid Michigan: 17 players who saw time in 2022, including relievers **Brock Whittlesey**, **Jack Owen** and **Jorge Juan** and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros** and **Jonny Butler** who suited up for Lansing in both 2021 and 2022, and not including catcher **Cooper Uhl**, who played 13 games for the Luggies in 2021 and spent all of 2022 in Stockton.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: On Opening Day at Fifth Third Field, the Dayton Dragons walked off with a 6-5 win on Mariekson "Didi" Gregorius's two-out RBI single in the 11th.

2014: In the Cooley Law School Stadium home opener, the Nuts broke out for four runs in the sixth inning (including a D.J. Davis home run and a Santiago Nassy two-run single), blew a 4-2 lead in the eighth, and then walked off triumphantly on a Dickie Joe Thon RBI single in the bottom of the ninth.

2019: First pitch was thrown at 6:07 p.m. By 8:01 p.m., it was over. Otto Lopez hit an RBI single in the sixth inning, and Cobi Johnson (5 innings) and Fitz Stadler (4 innings) combined on a three-hit shutout in a 1-0 win over West Michigan in one hour, 54 minutes.

2022 Retrospective: Jacob Watters made his Midwest League debut on August 31, becoming the Lugnuts' 55th different player, the 20th different starting pitcher and the 895th all-time Nut... he joined Micah Dallas (8th round) and TJ Czyn (12th round) as 2022 draftees on Lugnuts roster; both Dallas and Czyn start 2023 with Single-A Stockton.

Midwest League Debut: Opposed MLB rehabber Wade Miley in his debut, 8/31 at South Bend... retired Jordan Nwogu on immediate broken-bat grounder to first, walked BJ Murray and wild-pitched him to second, RF Joshwan Wright then dropped a Luis Verdugo fly ball to allow Murray to score... issued two more walks but retired Kevin Made on a flyout to center field to end the inning, allowing one unearned run... 27 pitches, 12 strikes.

Pro Debut: Watters has made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts on August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs: he walked Esmarly Tatis, who stole second base, retired Raino Coran on a groundout, tossed a wild pitch to move Tatis to third base, struck out Dilan Granadillo and then ended the inning with a Christian Olivo flyout to Austin Beck.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 following first-round catcher Daniel Susac (currently starring at Stockton) and three straight outfielders (high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th rd.) and Ryan Bergert (6th rd.)... the last West Virginia player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who this year joined John Means as the only two Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Current Ranking: MLB Pipeline ranks Watters the No. 30 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 11 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 40, Overall 40... his scouting report: "The 6-foot-4 Watters has the chance to have two at least plus pitches. His fastball was up to 99 mph as a starter this past spring, averaging close to 96 mph, and he can touch triple digits in shorter relief stints. He complements the heater with a true 12-to-6 power curve thrown in the mid-80s that can miss a ton of bats. He does have some feel for a mid-80s changeup, but it's well behind the two other offerings. For Watters to be able to have a chance at starting at the next level, he's going to have to continue improving his command. He has gotten better at finding the strike zone after walking 10.7 per nine in 2021. In all likelihood, he'll end up back in the bullpen, where he could have an 80 fastball to go along with a 65 or 70 curve."

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system.

Draft Day: Signed for \$40,000 as the 578th pick in the 2021 draft... signing scout: Rich Sparks, the 2006 Dick Bogard Scout of the Year, who scouts Indiana/Kentucky/Michigan/Ohio and also signed A's catcher Sean Murphy, former Lugnuts Marty Bechina, Jeff Criswell, Max Schuemann and Jack Weisenburger... third Michigan Wolverine drafted in 2021, following southpaw Steven Hajjar (2nd round, Minnesota) and shortstop Benjamin Sems (15th round, Colorado).

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.

Hail to the Victors: Pitched four years at Michigan... in College of Literature, Science and the Arts... as a freshman, made two appearances: 1/3 IP vs. Army, 3 BB, 1 K, 4 R, and 0 IP vs. Western Michigan, 2 BB, 1 HBP, 3 R... finished with 135.00 ERA... sophomore year was better: 6.04 ERA, 14 G, 2 GS, 1 sv., 22 1/3, 24 H, 1 HR, 10 BB, 15 K, 5 HBP, 7 WP... as a junior, was at his best, though season was pandemic-shortened: 3.13 ERA, 4 GS, 23 IP, 15 H, 0 HR, 5 BB, 21 K, 6 WP... as a senior: 8.42 ERA, 13 G, 5 GS, 25 2/3 IP, 30 H, 2 HR, 20 BB, 21 K, 7 WP... notable Wolverines: Ted Simmons, Charlie Gehringer, Barry Larkin, George Sisler, Bill Freehan, JJ Putz, Mike Matheny, Chris Sabo, Ryan LaMarre and Jake Cronenworth.
