**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Fisher Cats, 9-3. **Luis Toribio** hit a solo homer in the top of third inning and **Jairo Pomares** added a solo homer to lead off the fifth to open a 2-0 lead. In the fifth, **Victor Bericoto** hit a three-run homer to extend the Richmond lead to 5-0. In the bottom of the fifth, **Kekai Rios** and **Devonte Brown** brought in runs with groundouts and **Alex De Jesus** hit an RBI double to close the score to 5-3. **Will Wilson** brought in a run with a double and **Brady Whalen** added a two-run double in the top of the seventh to push the lead to 8-3. **Toribio** capped the scoring with an RBI single in the ninth. **Dylan Cumming** started and allowed two runs, both in the fifth, closing his night with 4.2 innings of work. **Evan Gates** pitched 1.2 scoreless innings, lowering his season ERA to 1.27. **Mat Olsen** closed the game with a scoreless ninth. **Whalen** went 4-for-5 with a double, a walk and two RBIs.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, in the fifth of a six-game series on the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This series is the only meeting between the Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats this year. This is also the first series for the Flying Squirrels in Manchester since August 2-7, 2022, a six-game split. This series marks the second of three road sets this year for Richmond against teams from the Northeast Division. They opened the season going 1-2 in a three-game set at Somerset from April 5-7. Next week, they will play their final road series against the Northeast Division with six games at Portland.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a five-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night. They had gone 3-9 in their previous 12 from since May 29 through Tuesday. In their previous 13 games from May 15-28, they went 11-2. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9.

**THE FISHER CATS** are in fifth place in the Northeast Division. This year, the Fisher Cats have the second-most hits (495) in the Eastern League. New Hampshire's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including OF **Alan Roden** (No. 7), LHP **Adam Macko** (No. 9), SS/3B **Josh Kasevich** (No. 11), RHP **CJ Van Eyk** (No. 17) and 3B/SS **Alex De Jesus** (No. 23). Baseball America's top-30 Blue Jays prospects list includes three New Hampshire players, including **Kasevich** (No. 7), **Roden** (No. 8) and **Macko** (No. 11). Baseball America also lists **Kasevich** as the best defensive infielder, **Macko** as the best curveball, **Roden** as the best hitter for average and **Garrett Spain** as the best outfield arm.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 12th start of the season and the first of his career against the Fisher Cats. He last pitched on Sunday at The Diamond against the Curve and allowed five runs, all in the fourth inning, over a six-inning outing. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. He has made six scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings. Bertrand has the second-highest groundball percentage (53.7%). He is also ranked fifth in BB/9 (2.00), fifth in walk percentage (5.4%), eighth in WHIP (1.13), ninth in innings pitched (63.0) and 10th in ERA (3.14). Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

**FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Left-hander **Trenton Wallace** makes his 12th start of the season. He last pitched on Sunday at Erie and allowed three runs over 4.1 innings, striking out seven in a loss. In his first six starts of the year, through May 11 Wallace went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA (5 ER/28.2 IP). In his last five starts since May 17, he has gone 1-2 with a 4.63 ERA (12 ER/23.1 IP). In the Eastern League this season, Wallace is ranked second in BAA (.185), fourth in ERA (2.94), eighth in strikeouts (67) and 10th in WHIP (1.13). Wallace was selected by the Blue Jays in the 11th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Iowa, where he was the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year that season. His father, **Greg Wallace**, is the long-time head baseball coach at Augustana College, where he coached Flying Squirrels outfielder **Carter Howell**.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** **Andy Thomas** is batting .359 (28-for-78) over his last 24 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .271. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday night, **Thomas** came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. Last Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season. He added two hits on Friday and an RBI double on Saturday. On Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout.

**OPEN THE GATES:** This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). **Gates** posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings May 23 and 26 against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on May 31 against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. **Gates** followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on June 4. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings since May 31, spanning 10.1 innings. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, **Gates** has pitched 68 Double-A games, combining for a 3.16 ERA (35 ER/99.2 IP).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last eight games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two homers, three doubles, two walks and seven RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, **Bericoto** hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on Friday night. In his last 18 games since May 22, **Bericoto** is batting .284 (19-for-67) with five homers, four doubles, nine walks and 16 RBIs.

**THE BEST PERFORMANCE EVER BY A GUY NAMED BRADY IN NEW ENGLAND:** Since being assigned to the Flying Squirrels at the beginning of the road trip, **Brady Whalen** is batting .455 (5-for-11) with a double, five walks, two RBIs and two runs scored with a .625 on-base percentage and a 1.170 OPS. He walked twice in both of his first two games on Tuesday and Wednesday. On Friday night, he reached base five times, going 4-for-5 with a double, a walk and two RBIs. It was his first four-hit performance in his 504 affiliated games during his professional career. **Whalen** re-signed with the Giants on May 15 after beginning the season with the independent Lexington Legends of the Atlantic League, where he hit .345 with four homers and eight doubles over 16 games. Last year in his first season with the Giants organization, **Whalen** played 38 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .259 with five homers and 24 RBIs.

**HELLO, JAIRO:** In this weeks series in Manchester, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .500 (8-for-16) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs. He went 1-for-4 on Tuesday before picking up a pair of hits, including a double, on Wednesday night, driving in a season-high three runs. He matched the three RBIs on Thursday night with a double and a homer. **Pomares** homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in the game. His eight hits over the last four games are the most in a four-game span for him this year.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 26) and LHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, **Sugastey** is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including **Brown** (No. 15), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), **Sugastey** (No. 23), OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26) and RHP **Carson Ragsdale** (No. 30).
