YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 8-1. Altoona scored single runs in the second through fifth innings to open a 4-0 lead before scoring two in the sixth and two in the seventh to pull ahead, 8-1. Richmond scored its only run in the seventh when Carter Howell hit a triple and came in to score on a groundout by Jairo Pomares. The Flying Squirrels committed five

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve in the fourth of a six-game series, the final games of the 2024 season. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six against the Curve at The Diamond from June 4-9. From July 30-August 4 in their other visit to PNG Field this year, the Flying Squirrels dropped the first four games of the series before winning the last two. The Curve won four-of-six at The Diamond from August 20-25.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won seven-of-11, including the first five games of last week's series against Akron. In their last 22 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .269 (201-for-748) and averaging 9.1 hits per game (201 total), also the best in the league, and averaging 4.6 runs per game (101 total).

THE CURVE are 11-4 in their last 15 games dating back to August 27, including a six-game sweep against the Fisher Cats from August 27-September 1. The Altoona roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Terrmarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 18), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Altoona players, including Johnson (No. 3), Solometo (No. 7), Barco (No. 8) and Cheng (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Morreale makes his ninth Double-A appearance and his eighth start of 2024. He last pitched on Saturday at The Diamond against the RubberDucks and allowed one run over five innings for his first Double-A win. He has faced the Curve twice, allowing one run over eight combined innings. As a starter with Richmond, Morreale has a 1.91 ERA (6 ER/28.1 IP). He combined for eight scoreless innings in his first two Richmond starts on August 3 at Altoona and August 10 against Hartford. Morreale was promoted to Double-A on July 26 after spending parts of four seasons in High-A with the Eugene Emeralds. This year, he went 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 25 bullpen appearances for Eugene. Morreale was selected in the 14th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Georgetown University. For more on Morreale, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefft-hander Anthony Solometo makes his 17th Double-A start of the season. In his last outing last Friday at Hartford, he pitched one innings and allowed six runs in a loss. His previous start on August 31 against the Fisher Cats, he threw six scorelss innings. Solometo has faced the Flying Squirrels four times this year, going 0-2 with a 4.38 ERA (6 ER/12.1 IP). Solometo was selected in the second round (37th overall) by the Pirates in the 2021 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 Pirates prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 92 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 21 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 21 GIDPs this year are tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005).

WELCOME HOME, BRYCE: Bryce Eldridge was assigned to the Flying Squirrels last Tuesday. The 19-year-old first baseman was selected with the 16th pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Madison High School in Vienna, Va. With his debut, he became the fifth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history born in Virginia, joining Jarrett Parker (2013-14), Matt Winn (2016-19),(2018-19) Connor Overton and Spencer Bivens (2023). At 19 years, 10 months and 14 days old, Eldridge became the second-youngest player in franchise history, trailing only Anyesber Sivira (2019) and just ahead of Heliot Ramos 2019, 2021). As the 16th player selected in last year's draft, Eldridge is the seventh-highest draft pick in franchise history, trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018), Hunter Bishop (10, 2019), Patrick Bailey (13, 2020), Tyler Beede (14, 2014), Will Bednar (14, 2021) and Will Wilson (15, 2019). This season,

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 69 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .299 (82-for-274) with seven homers, 17 doubles, 16 walks and 44 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Dating back to August 24, Bericoto has homered three times in his last 12 games including a grand slam on September 1 at Erie. Last Thursday, he hit the second walk-off hit of his Flying Squirrels career, a 10th-inning single to beat Akron, 7-6. Through Tuesday, Bericoto had an RBI in seven consecutive games, tied for the longest streak by a player in the Eastern League this season and tied for the longest in franchise history, even with a seven-game streak by **Clay Timpner** from April 28-May 10, 2010.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Diego Velasquez is batting .357 (20-for-56) in his last 15 games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has 13 hits in his last 10 games played with five RBIs. Among Giants full-season minor leaguers, Velasquez ranks fourth in batting average (.284), eighth in OBP (.363), ninth in OPS (.743), third in hits (116), tied for seventh in triples (4), ninth in total bases (155) and fifth in stolen bases (21).

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell has collected 20 hits in his last 17 games since August 21, batting .290 (20-for-69) with a double, a triple and 11 runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), first in triples (7), fourth in hits (121), fifth in extra-base hits (39) and seventh in total bases (174).

PACKING THE HOUSE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels are ninth in average attendance. In 2022 and 2023, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance for the first times in franchise history. This year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 13 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew** the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024) and Sandro Fabian (2021). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-24 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 64 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, a new franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 34 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 32 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), LHP Jack Choate (No. 19) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 22). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and Choate (No. 19).

Bryce Eldridge on his 2024 season so far and reaching Double-A:

'I feel like I have accomplished my goals. The year is not over yet. ... I am just going to keep shooting high. I was telling myself this year I wanted 20 home runs, I think that's a pretty good mark for me. Especially being a power hitter, a guy who if I can get the ball in the air, most of the time it will go. We made that happen. From the jump, my goal was to get to Double-A this year. I realized what I am capable of if I set my mind to something. I really pushed to make it happen. I made it hard for them not to move me up and here we are. It's been a fun ride. It's going to keep getting better from here on out."
