YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats grabbed their first win of the series against the Portland Sea Dogs by a score of 7-4 from Hadlock Field on Thursday afternoon. New Hampshire collected 13 hits and every hitter in the starting lineup tallied at least a hit in the victory. **Leo Jimenez** picked up three hits on the afternoon to extend his season-long on-base streak to 22 games. **Andres Sosa** recorded his first three-hit game at the Double-A level with a 3-for-3 day at the plate. The Fisher Cats scored all seven of their runs in between the second and fourth innings, starting with a two-run single in the second by **Riley Tirota** while **Damiano Palmegiani** followed with an RBI single in the third, his first hit of the series. Starting pitcher **Sem Robberse** got the start for the Fisher Cats and pitched 5.2 shutout innings, allowing five hits and only one walk while striking out five, earning the win.

BATS ARE HOT: The Fisher Cats are now hitting a league-best .279 in the month of July, ahead of second-best Akron (.253). New Hampshire also leads the league in on-base percentage (.360) and OPS (.779) this month. This comes after New Hampshire had the second-lowest batting average in the month of June (.214) and scored a league-low 90 runs...Leading the way offensively this month has been **Miguel Hiraldo** (.333), **Will Robertson** (.317) and **Leo Jimenez** (.304).

BECAUSE HE GETS ON BASE: IF **Leo Jimenez** continues to own the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League after reaching base for the 22nd straight game yesterday. During this stretch, he is hitting .280 with a .380 on-base percentage, 10 extra-base hits (6 2B, 2 HR, 2 3B) and 16 RBIs. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect has the two longest on-base streaks on the team this season at 22 games and 18 games.

BECAUSE (THEY) GET ON BASE: Jimenez, OF **Steward Berroa** and IF **Damiano Palmegiani** own three of the four longest active on-base streaks in the Eastern League. Berroa has reached base 15 straight games and Palmegiani has reached base 13 straight games. Berroa has matched his longest on-base streak this season of 15 games set back in May while Palmegiani is in the middle of his longest on-base streak this season.

DALLAS DAY: RHP **Chad Dallas** makes his ninth Double-A start of the season tonight. The 23-year-old righty faces Portland for the third and final time this season. In two starts vs the Sea Dogs, Dallas has not given up an earned run in 9.2 innings pitched. While Dallas hasn't eclipsed five innings in his last two starts, he has struck out 21 hitters over his last 15.1 innings pitched.

BUFFALO BOUND: The Toronto Blue Jays announced Monday that infielder **Orelvis Martinez** has been promoted from the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, the Double-A affiliate, to the Triple-A Buffalo Bisons. Martinez set a Fisher Cats single-season record with 30 home runs in 118 games last year. He added 17 more in 70 games this season, including 11 in May. From May 10 to July 14, Martinez hit .294 with 13 home runs, 31 RBIs, 33 walks, and a 1.010 OPS. This is the first time Martinez has been promoted to Triple-A in his career.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 21, 2019) - Kevin Smith hit a three-run homer in the first inning and the Fisher Cats went on to a 16-1 rout at Reading. Four players had three hits each, part of a 17-hit attack. Smith went 3-for-5, Josh Palacios went 3-for-4 with two doubles and three RBI, and Vinny Capra and Santiago Espinal also had three hits. Hector Perez went six scoreless innings for the win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (54-43) won 4-0 over San Diego and will head to Seattle for the weekend. Yesterday afternoon, Toronto was up 1-0 going to the bottom of the seventh. **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** hit his 15th homer to make it 2-0 and Alejandro Kirk added a two-run shot in the eighth. Chris Bassitt improved to 10-5 with six scoreless, **Tim Mayza**, Erik Swanson, and **Jordan Romano** each worked an inning to preserve the shutout...Buffalo (44-48) scored three in the ninth to tie, but lost 8-6 at Syracuse on a walk-off homer by Rafael Ortega. **Spencer Horwitz** homered twice and **Addison Barger** added a solo shot for Buffalo...Vancouver (53-33) made it five wins in the last six games with a 7-3 win at Spokane. A three-run homer by **Kekai Rios** in the second inning gave the Canadians a lead they would not give up. Vancouver got five scoreless innings from Devereaux Harrison, who earned the win...Dunedin (40-47) scored four in the fifth inning en route to a 5-1 win over Lakeland. The Jays allowed just three hits and struck out fifteen in the win.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their road trip against the Portland Sea Dogs until Sunday. The next Fisher Cats home stand begins Tue. July 25 against the Hartford Yard Goats at Delta Dental Stadium.
