Round Rock and Oklahoma City face off in the series finale on Sunday afternoon, with first pitch set for 1:05 p.m. at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Spencer Howard is slated to take the mound against Dodgers RHP Andre Jackson.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Express fell 5-1 on Saturday night against the Dodgers, marking the fourth consecutive loss for Round Rock. In the first, back-to-back singles from SS Zach McKinstry and 3B Miguel Vargas started the action before CF Kevin Pillar singled to score McKinstry. RF Ryan Noda hit into a fielder's choice, allowing Vargas to score as Pillar was taken off the bases. Noda then stole second base before 2B Eddy Alvarez doubled to extend the lead to 3-0. Round Rock scratched a run across in the third inning. A one-out walk for 2B Nash Knight was followed by a bunt single from LF Bubba Thompson. CF Leody Taveras sent Knight home with a single up the middle as the Express trailed 3-1. In the sixth, with runners on the corners, Alvarez placed a bunt down the first base line to score Pillar from third and make it 4-1. In the ninth, PR Drew Avans stole second and third base before a throw from Express C Meibrys Viloria went into left field and allowed Avans to score, extending the Dodgers lead to 5-1.

HOWARD GOES AGAIN

Express RHP Spencer Howard returns to the mound for the second time this series. In his Round Rock debut on Tuesday, he allowed one run over 3.2 innings against Dodgers batters. Howard struck out six and did not issue a walk.

MILLER MOWS DOWN OKC

Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller set a new career high with nine strikeouts during his start on Saturday. He finished with 5.0 innings of work and allowed all three of his runs in the first inning. The previous career high in strikeouts for Miller came on September 20, 2021 against Oklahoma City when he tallied eight. The nine Ks were also the most by a Round Rock pitcher this season

THOMPSON TURNS IT ON

Express LF Bubba Thompson swiped his 17th base of the season during Saturday's fifth inning and leads all of Triple-A in stolen bases. The righty went 1-for-5 during the contest and holds an average of .325 (38-117) this season, which ranks sixth in the Pacific Coast League.

LEODY HITTING OPPO

E-Train CF Leody Taveras is utilizing the opposite side of the field often to start the 2022 campaign. He's hitting to the other side 46.6 percent of the time through his 23 appearances, which is the fourth-highest number among PCL hitters. In 2021 with Round Rock, Taveras went to the opposite field 36.4 percent of the time. He is currently ranked second in the PCL in average (.345), fifth in slugging (.586) and ninth in OPS (.960).

TIME TO GET OFF THE SCHNEID

The loss for the Express marks the first time that Round Rock has lost a series this season. Saturday was also the fourth consecutive loss for the Express, the team's longest losing streak of the season. In the last four games, Round Rock has scored just 2.5 runs per game. Entering the homestand, the Express were averaging 9.8 runs per contest with a batting average of .347 in those games.

HOME RUNS...?

Saturday's game was just the third time this season that Round Rock has played in a game that featured zero home runs for either team. The last time it happened came on April 26 at Dell Diamond against the Salt Lake Bees. Round Rock now holds a 3-6 record in contests where the team does not hit a home run.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
