ON TUESDAY... The Hot Rods dropped the first game of the series to the IronBirds 10-1 on Tuesday. Michael Mercado tied a season-high with 5.0 innings pitched, allowing one unearned run along the way. The only offense for Bowling Green came from a first inning solo homer by Greg Jones. Aberdeen hit two ninth inning homers to break it open and secure a series-opening win.

ABOUT ABERDEEN... The IronBirds scored double digit runs for the third time this season on Tuesday. Their 10 runs tied a sea-son-high, which they have recorded three times. Aberdeen scored 10 runs opening night on May 4th and again on May 27th. Out of their 20 wins this season, they have scored more than five runs in nine of those victories.

BATTLE AT THE TOP... The win for Aberdeen on Tuesday makes them the first team in the High-A East to reach 20 wins and lead the North Division by 4.5 games. Bowling Green currently sits at 19 wins and leads the South Division by 3.0 games. The two teams have the best records in the league over the last 10 games, with the IronBirds 8-2 and the Hot Rods 7-3.

STRENGTH VS. STRENGTH... With 187 runs scored, Bowling Green is second in the league in runs and first in run differential (+46). On the other side, it's the IronBirds who have the least runs against them this year, holding their opponents to just 106 runs this year and have the second highest run differential (+42).

VISITORS FROM THE NORTH... This series is the first this season against an opponent for the North Division for the Hot Rods. Bowling Green will play two teams from the North Divison this season, including Aberdeen and Wilmington. The IronBirds crossover with four South Division teams this season, playing Bowling Green, Hickory, Greenville, and Rome in 2021

SUNDAY'S NOTES... Cardenas' 25 game on-base streak and his 15-game hit streak were snapped... This is the first game this season he failed to reach base... Hulsizer had his fourth multihit game of the season... Jones had his sixth multi-hit game this year... Hollis recorded his first hit since being reactivated from the IL... Mercado tied his season-high with 5.0 innings pitched... This was the first game in franchise history against Aberdeen... BG is 7-5 when opponents score first this year... The Hot Rods are 5-10 when opponents out-hit them... This loss ends a season-high five-game win streak... This is the first loss since the series-opening game against Rome last Tuesday..

NOW PITCHING: PEYTON BATTENFIELD ... With 44 strikeouts through 26.0 innings, Battenfield has collected the most K's for a Hot Rods pitcher this season. He collected the High-A East Pitcher of the week for May 10-16. Over that span he tossed 8.0 innings, striking out 16 batters and walking just one. He has made six appearances this season and five starts, all of which he has logged at least six strikeouts. Six was his lowest amount this year, coming in the Hot Rods opening game on May 5th against the Greenville Drive. His 5.0 innings against Rome on June 3rd was a season-high. In a no-decision, he gave up three hits and one run while striking out eight, his highest total since his career-high nine on May 11th.

June 8, 2009

On this day in Hot Rods history, Bowling Green crushed the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 17-5. Future big leaguer Kyle Lobstein started the game, tossing 4.2 innings and gave up one hit and one earned run. The offense was headlined by Mark Thomas, who went 2-5 with 6 RBIs and Brett Nommensen helped with 4 RBIs. Both had homers and contributed to the teams 15 total hits, leading to 17 runs.

Awards: 2019 NYP Blue All-Star, High-A East Pitcher of the Week **2019:** Battenfield played for the Tri-City VallyCats of the Houston Astros organization during his first season in the MilB... He hurled 39.1 innings, amounting to a 2-1 record with a 1.60 ERA... Out of his 14 appearances in 2019, five of those were starts... He kept opponents to just a .167 batting average and finished with a 0.97 WHIP... Battenfield was named a New York Penn league Blue All-star in 2019. **2019 (NCAA):** During his final season as an Oklahoma State Cowboy Battenfield pitched in 30 games, which tied for 6th in program history for appearanc-es in a season... He posted the second lowest ERA, a 3.28, on the team for pitchers with 15 or more outings... Even though he made no starts, he pitched the third most innings on the team, finishing with 60.1 innings pitched... He held his opponents to a .201 average and only let up 21 walks while striking out 74... Battenfield earned a spot on the All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selections... Was one of eight Oklahoma State players to be drafted in 2019. **2018 (NCAA):** The Cowboys were paced by Battenfield's 26 appearances, leading the team in the category... 25 of his 26 outings were in relief... Notched his first-career save, going through two scoreless innings against Central Arkansas on March 20, 2018... Fanned five Sooners over two scoreless innings against Central Arkansas on March 20, 2018... Fanned Honorable Mention All-Big 12. **2017 (NCAA):** As a freshman with OK State Battenfield only saw the mound five times... All of these outings came from the bullpen... Made his college debut at Grand Canyon on February 17, 2017... He fanned four batters over three innings at Oral Roberts on May 16, 2017. **Dresonal:** Parents are Darrell and Shelly Battenfield...
