LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats flirted with a shutout in a 7-1 victory over the Reading Fightin' Phils on Friday night Starting right-hander Chad Dallas threw seven shutout innings, allowed three hits, no walks and equaled his career-high with 11 strikeouts to earn the win. Devonte Brown drove in a game-high three RBI within the first five innings with an RBI double in the third, his first Double-A RBI, before hitting a two-run homer to left-center in the fifth. New Hampshire broke the game open in the eighth with four runs across on five hits. Will Robertson added to the lead with an opposite-field RBI single, Trevor Schwecke tripled in a pair with a fly ball to center field, his first triple of the season and Phil Clarke brought home Schwecke with an RBI single to give New Hampshire its largest lead of the game 7-0. T.J. Brock threw a scoreless eighth with two strikeouts before Reading eventually scored its first run of the game on a sac-fly by Rixon Wingrove off Adrian Hernandez.

STRIKEOUT CENTRAL: New Hampshire pitching has struck out 54 batters in the four games this series. Three of the four starting pitchers this week have struck out double-digit batters. Chad Dallas matched Ricky Tiedemann with 11 strikeouts last night while Michael Dominguez struck out a career-high 10 on Wednesday. Last night, the Fisher Cats had 15 strikeouts with no walks allowed. The only other time that happened in a game was May 10, 2017 when they had 16 strikeouts and no walks in a 4-3 win at Hartford.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?: OF Devonte Brown has made an immediate impact since joining the Fisher Cats on Tuesday from High-A Vancouver. The 23-year-old has three hits in the series and all have gone for extra-base-hits. Last night, Brown checked off his first Double-A RBI with a double in the third and then his first Double-A homer with a two-run shot in the fifth. The undrafted free agent out of NC State has 15 home runs and 52 RBI in his first full pro season between both High-A and Double-A.

HIRALDO IS HOT: 2B Miguel Hiraldo wrapped up an incredible month of August. The second baseman hit .333 (led team, T-3<sup>rd</sup> in league), with seven homers (led team) and 26 RBI (led team, T-3<sup>rd</sup> in league). The 22-year-old drove in half of his RBI for the season in the month of August. It was also the most RBI driven in by a Fisher Cat in a single month this season.

RODEN ON A ROLL: OF Alan Roden collected a game-high three hits last night, his fourth 3+ hit game at Double-A. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect has 11 multi-hit performances in 35 games played, including in eight of his last 14 games. Roden is hitting .321 since joining the team on July 19.

SATURDAY NIGHT Q: RHP Luis Quinones makes his 10th start of the year and his second against Reading. The 26-year-old last pitched on Sunday at home vs Binghamton but his start was cancelled after two innings due to inclement weather. Quinones struck out a season-high seven in five innings last time out against Reading on Aug. 9 in New Hampshire. The Puerto Rican has struck out five or more batters in four straight starts but has only made it to the fifth twice this season.

NEWCOMERS TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: OF Devonte Brown, RHP CJ Van Eyk, IF Abiezel Ramirez, and IF Jeffrey Wehler are the four newest Fisher Cats to be added onto the roster this week. Brown signed as an undrafted free agent out of NC State in July 2022. Van Eyk is a former top 10 Blue Jays prospect who did not pitch last year while recovering from Tommy John surgery. A former Rays farmhand, Ramirez played only four games with Vancouver before earning promotion to Double-A. Wehler started the year in independent ball with Staten Island before eventually having his contract purchased by the Blue Jays on June 9.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (September 2, 2018) - In the next to last game of the regular season, the Fisher Cats topped the Hartford Yard Goats 8-5. Juan Kelly hit a three-run homer in the bottom of the fifth inning to rally New Hampshire into a 6-5 lead. Jon Harris started and earned his 12th win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (74-61) outslugged Colorado 13-9 last night. The Blue Jays had a 17-hit attack, including six in the seventh inning when the Blue Jays rallied into the lead. George Springer tied the game with a single and pinch-hitter Alejandro Kirk drove in three with a double for a lead. He pinch-hit for Danny Jansen, who had one of three Jays homers...Buffalo (65-63) won 8-5 over Indianapolis. Orelvis Martinez went 3-for-5 with a homer and three RBI. Rafael Lantiqua also had three hits. Connor Cooke earned the win in relief and Nate Pearson finished up for his second save. Buffalo moved to within a game of first place in the IL's second half with a fifth straight win...Vancouver (74-49) lost 4-3 in ten innings to Hillsboro. Glenn Santiago hit a two-run homer in the seventh inning to put the Canadians up, but the Hops responded to tie in the eighth. Vancouver did score in the bottom of the tenth on a single by Dasan Brown but left the bases loaded...Dunedin (59-64) lost 7-1 at Daytona Beach.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats are on the road against the Reading Fightin' Phils until Sunday. Then, they will visit the Bowie BaySox for six games beginning Tuesday. September 5. The final home stand of the regular season begins Tuesday. September 12 against the defending Eastern League champions and this season's first-half champions, the Somerset Patriots.
