#### NEWS & NOTES

**BROOKLYN BACK-AND-FORTH:** This six-game homestand against the Brooklyn Cyclones marks the first of two trips to Dutchess Stadium in the second half of the year for the Cyclones, who return from July 26-31. The Renegades and Cyclones play 30 times this season, with this series representing the third of five series. Hudson Valley is 8-7 across the first 15 meetings in a very competitive season series.

**SO, ABOUT LAST NIGHT...:** Despite **Blas Castaño** taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning, the Renegades fell to the Brooklyn Cyclones 6-1 on Thursday night. Four Brooklyn pitchers held Hudson Valley batters to just three hits in the game, including just one before the ninth inning despite nine walks. **Aaron Palensky** continued his hot hitting with a double and a walk on the night, and **Spencer Henson** drew a season-best three walks in the game.

**SIEZE THE WAY:** **RHP Beck Way** gets the start for Hudson Valley tonight in the midst of a strong run of starts dating back to the end of May. Since a May 21 start at Brooklyn, the 2020 4th rounder has allowed 1 ER-or-fewer, struck out at least five and completed 5.0 innings in five-of-six starts. Way wrapped up a month of June in which he posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP), with 14 H, 6 BB, and 22 K.

**PEREIRA YARD WORK:** **Everson Pereira** continues his assault on the Renegades record book, and enters play Friday just one home run shy of the all-time franchise record. Pereira has been on a roll in the last two-and-a-half weeks, clubbing five long balls, including a pair of two-homer games. The Yankees No. 3 prospect (*Baseball America*) has five career multi-homer games, including four with Hudson Valley.

**SPEED DEMON:** **Cooper Bowman** stole his 27th and 28th bases of the season on Saturday night in Winston-Salem. That is the most steals in a single season by a Renegades player since Jake Fraley set the franchise record with 33 in 2016. Bowman has been successful in 12 of his last 13 stolen base attempts, and is 42-for-46 (.891) on steals in his career.

**RECORD-SETTING SERIES:** In the first three games of the series with Brooklyn, the Renegades have seen two all-time franchise records be broken. **Everson Pereira** became the team's all-time runs scored leader (74) on Tuesday night when he surpassed Chris Winder's

previous record of 72. **Nelson Alvarez** moved into a tie for first all-time in pitching appearances on Wednesday night when he appeared in his 48th game with the Renegades. With the team's move to a full-season club before the 2021 season, there are several more individual and team records in jeopardy before the end of the season.

**HISTORIC THIEVES:** The Renegades have stolen 140 bases on the season, already the second-highest total in team history. Hudson Valley's all-time record is well within reach -- 149 in 2021. At their current rate, the Renegades are on pace to steal an incredible 257 bases this season. Infielder **James Nelson** has 31 career SB with HV, just 2 shy of Jake Fraley's team record, while **Cooper Bowman** is closing in as well with 28.

**HARDMAN HEATING UP:** After a slow start to the season, infielder **Tyler Hardman** has been swinging a hot bat lately, picking up hits in 20 of his last 25 games. The third baseman skied his ninth home run of the season last night, a game-tying opposite-field blast, furthering a hot stretch that has lifted his season batting line from .173/.279/.298 to .247/.327/.434, a 184-point jump in his OPS. The stretch was punctuated by his first career multi-HR game on 6/15 at Greensboro.

**A NEW ERA:** The Renegades pitching staff sports a 3.63 ERA on the season, the second-best in the South Atlantic League (Wilmington, 3.40). It also ranks as the fifth-best staff ERA in High-A, and the 11th-best in the minor leagues. All four Yankees affiliated teams rank in the top 30 in the minors in ERA -- Somerset 3.34, 5th; Tampa 3.65, t-12th; Scranton/Wilkes-Barre 3.96, t-30th.

**SWEENEY SHINING:** **Trey Sweeney** is 3-for-4 with three doubles, three walks and three runs scored in the first two games against Brooklyn. That's continued a larger surge for the shortstop, who hit .270/.363/.472 with 4 HR and 16 RBIs in June. Sweeney has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games.

**ALL-TIME ALVAREZ:** Reliever **Nelson Alvarez** has his sights set on two of the Renegades all-time pitching records. Recording the final five outs to notch his second save of the season on Wednesday, he jumped into a three-way tie for the most all-time in total appearances with 48, joining Oscar Bustillos and Jason Jimenez atop the franchise leaderboard. Alvarez also has racked up seven wins out of the bullpen, which puts him just behind teammate **Charlie Ruedger** (8) for second on the all-time relief wins list, two shy of Mike Venafro's mark (9) set in 1995.

# RENEGADES STARTING PITCHER

**LAST TIME OUT:** Continuing a run of strong starts, Way allowed only one run on one hit in a season-high 5.2 innings last Friday night in Winston-Salem, but got no decision in a 2-1 Renegades defeat. The right-hander has now allowed one earned run or fewer in five of his last six starts. The lone hit and run he allowed in the start was a solo home run to White Sox top prospect Colson Montgomery leading off the fourth inning. Way bounced back to retire the next eight batters to complete his night.

**THE MENTAL GAME:** One of Way's main focuses for the 2022 season has been on dealing with his nerves and maintaining his composure on the mound. "If I can candle my nerves and stay calm out there, I think a lot of the walks will go away. I think that's where that came from." Way to [Randy Miller of NJ.com in February 2022](#). Way dedicated himself to reading books, including the autobiography of Denver Broncos QB (and former MiLB player) **Russell Wilson**, who also spent 2018 and 2019 in spring training with the Yankees. "A lot of the highest-paid athletes, [go through this] too ... I'm just realizing it, and getting like a mentor like Russell Wilson on the football side of the mental game ... I like the way he goes about it. What goes into it is knowing the two different types of breath work. You can have a mindless breath work or you're imagining something. Mindless would maybe be mornings and night where you just focus on, the breath and maybe pitching pops in my mind. Right now, I'm focusing on the image one. I'm breathing and I'm focusing about striking somebody out. I imagine it, and then I could go out and do it no problem. That's what I'm working on. Last year I didn't have that. I was just out there trying to get by."

**NEW TO PITCHING:** At the encouragement of his grandfather, Michael "Whitey" Whitehead, Way did not begin pitching until he was a junior in high school. In his junior and senior years Way threw a combined 29.0 innings, only playing shortstop other than that. Way on his grandfather: "My role model growing up was my grandfather. He was like, 'You're not going to pitch until you're in college. Protect your arm.' He knew the athlete that I could be."

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster.
- Struck out a career-high nine batters in his second start of the season April 15 at Rome, becoming the first HV pitcher to complete five innings this season.
- Allowed 1 ER-or-fewer in five of six starts since May 21. Way has also struck out at least five batters and thrown at least 5.0 innings in five-of-his-last-six starts.

**PERSONAL:**

- Full name is Beck Michael Way.
- Attended Belmont Abbey (N.C.) College in 2017 before sitting out for two seasons (2018-19)... Transferred to Northwest Florida State College prior to the 2020 season, posting a 5-0 record and two complete games with a 0.67 ERA (40.0IP, 3ER) and 58K in seven games (six starts).
- Became the second-highest draft pick (129th) in Northwest Florida history behind only Jeff Farnsworth, who was selected 57th overall (second round) by the Seattle Mariners in 1996.
- Graduated from Cumberland Valley (Pa.) H.S.
