TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve welcome Chesapeake for their second series of the First Half.

Another day, another lefty for the Baysox. Luis De Leon takes the ball for the Baysox tonight, he struck out 6 Curve batters in 3.2 innings on May 5 down by the Bay. In his last outing, he allowed ten runs in 2.1 innings after going 0-2 with a 3.26 ERA in 5 starts in May (26 K in 19.1 IP, 1.45 WHIP). De León has easy mid-90s lefty velo and a suite of plus secondaries, but he's good for one stretch of losing the strike zone per season. De Leon was ranked No. 64 in Fangraphs' preseason Top-100 and features a hellish splitter, change-up, slider arsenal that can really dominate hitters.

NEW YORK CITY'S OWN: First baseman **Callan Moss** is T-2nd in the Eastern League with 17 doubles this season. Moss has 5 2B and 7 RBI in 7G this month.

PEYNTING: Righty **Peyton Stumbo** delivered one of the best outings of his professional career on Wednesday, June 10 against Chesapeake; firing 5.2 scoreless innings with 7 strikeouts and just 4 baserunners allowed (2H, 1BB, E2). In his last 9 outings, he holds a 1-2 record and a 3.95 ERA with 38 strikeouts in 41.0 IP. He's held his opponent to 2 runs or fewer 6 times in has 9 starts.

WE LIKE MIKE: Righty **Mike Walsh** has taken over as one of Altoona's top bullpen arms. Walsh has been unscored upon in 6-of-8 outings with Altoona and has 5 strikeouts in 3.1 innings over his last 2 outings, which includes a back-to-back on June 5 and June 6.

PUPPIES: Among the 20 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 11 have made their Double-A debut this season. Two players, **Carlos Caro** and **Shalin Polanco** did so on Wednesday, June 10, Caro walked 3 times and scored 2 runs in the 10-3 win. Ironically, only 3 pitchers (21 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut, though LHP **Connor Oliver** will do add his name to the list on Friday night when he starts for the Curve.

SO LONG, PARTNER: Altoona's roster underwent a shakeup after the team wrapped up a two-week road trip to Hartford and New Hampshire. RHP **Khristian Curtis**, RHP **Derek Diamond**, LHP **Jaden Woods**, INF **Keiner Delgado** and C **Derek Berg** all moved to Triple-A Indianapolis. Curtis leaves as the Eastern League leader in strikeouts with 67, Woods allowed just 3 baserunners in his last 4 outings with 11 strikeouts. Berg picked up a hit in 16-of-18 games in May and has 10 RBI in his last 12G and had 2 hits in a game 7 times in 11 games on the team's two-week road trip.

NEAR PERFECTION: In the finale of the team's 12-game road trip, the Curve tossed a 1-hit, no-walk shutout of New Hampshire in a 4-0 win. **Connor Wietgreffe** allowed the lone baserunner in the game, a double from Jace Bohrofen which P.J. Hilson nearly caught on a diving attempt. **Alessandro Ecolani** and **Derek Diamond** set down every hitter they faced and combined for 8 strikeouts in the win.

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 14 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs, they matched a season-high with 4 homers on June 4 at New Hampshire. The Curve have hit 57 home runs in 59 games, they're on pace to hit 136 homers which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022. 15 different players have hit a home run this season, 2nd-most by an Eastern League club.

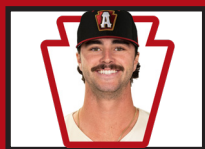
