YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fifth straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 4-2. Luis Matos gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the fifth with an RBI single. Ben Malgeri tied the game with an RBI single in the fifth. Grant Witherspoon gave Erie a 3-1 lead with a two-run double in the sixth. Dillon Dingler opened the lead to 4-1 in the eighth with an RBI single. Carter Williams closed the gap to two with an RBI groundout in the ninth. Carson Seymour started and pitched four scoreless innings, allowing two hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning fourof-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC Park from September 12-17. The Flying Squirrels are 13-15 against opponents from the Southwest Division and 7-7 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS fell out of first place for the first time since April 21 with Saturday's loss to the SeaWolves. Their current five-game losing streak is their longest of the season. They split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve and have dropped six-of-their-last-seven games, including each of the first five games in this week's series. The Richmond pitching staff is second in the EL in ERA (3.36).

THE SEAWOLVES were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. They have won nine-of-their-last-11 games overall. In the Eastern League, the Erie offense ranks tied for first in total bases (424), second in homers (37), second in runs (163), second in RBIs (152) and second in triples (8). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Landen Roupp** makes his second start of the season. He made his season debut against the Sea-Wolves on April 23 and worked three scoreless innings with six strikeouts. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. *For more on Roupp, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Keider Montero makes his third Double-A start and his second against the Flying Squirrels this week. He took the mound on Tuesday against Richmond and allowed four runs, tying a season high, over 4.1 innings with eight strikeouts and one walk. He made his Double-A debut last Wednesday at Bowie and allowed four runs over 3.1 innings. Montero began the season with High-A West Michigan and allowed five runs over in his first two starts before firing back-to-back scoreless starts on April 20 against Dayton and April 26 at Cedar Rapids, striking out 15 batters in eight innings. He spent the 2022 season with the Whitecaps and went 7-7 with a 4.51 ERA over 25 starts.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop Marco Luciano was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. Last Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has reached base in six-of-his-eight games started this season.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .352 (19-for-54) with a homer, eight doubles and five RBIs over his last 14 games, including seven two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is fourth in the league in hits (34), tied for fourth in doubles (8) and tied for sixth in runs scored (20).

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the third-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in 10-of-his-12 games since then and in 28-of-30 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 12 times in 127 plate appearances (9.5 percent), the second-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his second Double-A homer in last Sunday's win over the Curve. He drove an RBI single on Thursday and another on Saturday. For the season, Matos is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in hits (31).

BURGOS THE KING: Reliever Raymond Burgos has pitched 10 games without allowing an earned run this season, tied for the longest streak in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg's Amos Willingham. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was a extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (94.1%). He is the only pitcher in the EL (min. 15.0 IP) with a 0.00 ERA.

DLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3). Ismael Munguia tied for fourth in hits (34), tied for fourth in doubles (8) and tied for sixth in runs scored (20). Luis Matos is ninth in hits (31). Hayden Cantrelle is fifth in OBP (.416). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for seventh in strikeouts (36). Juan Sanchez and Nick Swiney are tied for second in wins (3). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (3).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Pérez is eighth in batting average (.297). Trei Cruz is sixth in homers (6) and sixth in SLG (.511). Colt Keith is third in RBIs (21), tied for fifth in hits (33), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (13) and seventh in total bases (57). Grant Witherspoon is tied for fifth in RBIs (19). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in the league in games pitched (12).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).




