LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans dropped both weekend games, finishing the series with a 6-1 loss at Kannapolis on Sunday afternoon. Myrtle Beach had six hits with two coming from **1B Felix Stevens**, who brought home the Birds' only run of the game on an RBI double in the fourth. **RHP Richard Gallardo** gave up five unearned runs in the bottom of the fourth to take the loss in his 3.2 innings. The Pelicans took four of the six games to win their 10th series on the season.

FIRST HALF CHAMPS

With a 47-19 record, the Pelicans clinched the Carolina League South Division First Half championship for their first playoff appearance since 2017. The title race came down to the wire, as Myrtle Beach defended a one-game lead over Charleston. The Pelicans finished the first half with the most wins in MiLB.

BIRDS TO THE MOON

Through the last two months of the season, the Pelicans have been one of the top teams in MiLB. Their winning percentage (.696) is the best percentage in MiLB and they have the most wins at 48. Myrtle Beach's run differential is atop MiLB at +148, the next highest is Single-A Cedar Rapids at +119. The pitching staff is second in MiLB lead with an ERA of 3.07 for the season. Before being promoted to High-A on May 30, **CF/DH Pete Crow-Armstrong** led the charge with a .354 average for the season and had a 15-game hitting streak from 4/22-5/10, while batting .462 (30-65). He totaled seven-multi-hit games in a row from 4/28-5/7, which was the second longest streak in Pelicans history. **OF Kevin Alcantara** had a ten-game hitting streak from 6/4-6/15 while posting a .359 average (14-39) with three home runs and 11 RBI. **OF Ezequiel Pagan** has emerged in the month of June with a batting average of .362 (25-69) and OPS of 1.079. Pagan has hit nine extra-base hits with three homers and 24 RBI through 20 games in the month.

AWARDS SZN

This season, the Pelicans have racked up a total of five awards from MiLB and the Cubs. Most recently, **RHP Luis Devers** was awarded the Cubs MiLB Pitcher of the Month for May after holding a 1.48 ERA and 28 strikeouts in the month. **RHP Porter Hodge** also won Cubs Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA with 21 strikeouts through his four starts. Before being promoted to High-A South Bend on May 30, **OF Pete Crow-Armstrong** won the Cubs MiLB Player of the Month for April after hitting .375. Crow-Armstrong was also named the Carolina League Player of the Week on May 4.

LHP Riley Martin also won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on April 25th following the series at Delmarva.

TOP CUBBIES

Currently, the Pelicans roster holds four of the 30 MLB Pipeline top Cubs prospects. Leading the charts is the No. 4 Cubs prospect **IF James Triantos**. The Fairfax, VA native was selected in the second round (56th overall) in the 2021 MLB draft, and hit .327 in 25 games in the ACL in his professional baseball debut with six homers. Another young prospect on this Pelicans roster is **IF Reginald Preciado** (Currently on IL). The Panama native ranks No. 11 in the Cubs system after hitting .333 with 25 RBIs in 34 games in the Arizona Complex League last season. **OF Kevin Alcantara** was added to the roster on 4/12, the No. 7 Cubs prospect. Alcantara was acquired as a part of the Anthony Rizzo trade in July 2021. **IF Kevin Made** made his return to the Pelicans on 4/17. Made ranks as the No. 15 Cubs prospect after hitting .272 across 58 games with Myrtle Beach in 2021.

BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2022 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his fifth year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021, and will be coaching his 16th season in the Cubs organization. During his first three years with the Pelicans, Bailey recorded 216 wins, three half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,250. Bailey moved past Johnny Lipon for fourth place on the MiLB all-time wins list with a 6-5 walk-off win over Charleston on August 10, 2021 for his 2,186th victory. Bailey is the winningest active manager in MiLB, as 2022 will be his 34th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

Three Pelicans combined to throw a no-hitter against the Columbia Fireflies on May 1, 2022 in Myrtle Beach. **Walker Powell**, **Adam Laskey**, and **Jake Reindl** tossed the third nine-inning no hitter in franchise history. It was the first no-hitter for the Pelicans at home, and their second in 10 months. Myrtle Beach also no-hit Columbia on June 23, 2021 in a 5-0 win.

The 24 runs scored by the Pelicans on 5/4 at Salem were the most since at least 2005 and the most runs ever scored on the Red Sox. Myrtle Beach smashed eight doubles and three home runs with a total of 22 hits in the win.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- The Pelicans won the Carolina League South Division First-Half championship with a record of 47-19 to clinch their first playoff appearance since 2017
- The 12-game winning streak for Myrtle Beach from 5/14-5/27 was the longest in recorded history for the franchise
- As a team, the Pelicans have gone 186-699 (.266) with runners in scoring position
- The Pelicans have scored in double figures 11 times through the first 69 games after scoring in double figures 10 times last season
- Through the first six home games, the Pelicans walked-off winners in three of them
- The 24 runs scored on 5/4 at Salem were the most in a game since at least 2005 for the Pelicans, and the most in a Minor League game this season
- The Pelicans pitching staff holds an ERA of 3.07 for the season which ranks second in Minor League Baseball
- The Pelicans own the best winning percentage in MiLB (.696) and the most wins at 48
- Myrtle Beach has not lost series since the three-game opening set at Charleston 4/8-4/10 (2-1)
