Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds were defeated by the Columbia Fireflies on Saturday night, 9-6. **Stone Russell** put Columbia ahead in the first inning with an RBI single, making it 1-0. The home run ball extended the Fireflies' lead over the next two innings, as long balls by **Hyungchan Um** in the second and **Yandel Ricardo** in the third made it 5-0. **Jordan Sanchez** unleashed his power swing in the top of the fourth with his third homer of the year, making it 5-2. **Ivan Sosa** had the answer with a two-run home run of his own in the bottom half, as a four-run frame gave Columbia their largest lead at 9-2. Delmarva chipped away late, scoring twice in the seventh on a **Jose Perez** home run and a **Jordan Sanchez** RBI single. **Miguel Rodriguez** brought home a run with an RBI double, followed by a run-scoring double by **Jose Perez**, making it 9-6, but that was as close as the Shorebirds could get. The Fireflies picked up their fourth win of the week, guaranteeing them a series win over Delmarva.

Can't Stop Nolaya: **Andres Nolaya** has emerged as one of Delmarva's top bats this season and is enjoying his best stretch. Since May 9, Nolaya has the best batting average in the Carolina League at .372 (29-for-78). During this run, he has 16 RBIs, 9 extra-base hits, and 8 multi-hit games, four of which came in a row. His 13 multi-hit games for the season are the most on the Shorebirds.

Make Way for Lo Re: One of the newest additions to the Shorebirds, **Jaiden Lo Re**, has quickly made an impact in the middle of the order for Delmarva. In eight games, Lo Re has seven hits, including four for extra bases, with his first Single-A homer in Augusta on June 5. He has driven in seven runs for the Shorebirds and is coming off one of his best games, when he reached base a career-high six times on June 12 at Columbia.

Mighty Miggy: **Miguel Rodriguez** has been an RBI machine for Delmarva since returning from the injured list on May 26. In his first 11 games this season, Rodriguez has collected a hit in nine, including a current eight-game hitting streak. He has 14 RBIs, with four multi-RBI games. He drove in a career-high four on June 12 at Columbia.

Extra is Better: The Shorebirds' offense has collected extra bases regularly during this two-week road trip. Over the last 11 games, Delmarva's offense has recorded 101 hits, 40 for extra bases, including 25 doubles, 4 triples, and 10 home runs, with **Raylin Ramos** connecting for his first career multi-home run game on June 10 at Columbia.

Hot Rod: In his debut season, **Christian Rodriguez** has emerged as Delmarva's most dependable starting pitcher. Over his last nine starts, he has struck out 54 batters in 47.1 innings. C-Rod has recorded all three of Delmarva's quality starts this season, including a career-high 9 Ks and his longest start, 6.1 innings, on June 12 at Columbia. His 70 strikeouts are the second-most in the Carolina League.

Two Out Hitting: The Shorebirds lead the Carolina League in hits (164) with two outs. Additionally, with runners in scoring position and two outs, Delmarva has the most hits (82) and the highest batting average (.288).

About the Fireflies: Delmarva's second leg of their two-week road trip takes them to Segra Park for a series against the Columbia Fireflies, the first time since 2023. The Shorebirds did not play the Fireflies last season and last saw them at Perdue Stadium in 2024. There are three top-five prospects for the Royals on Columbia's roster, including two top 100 overall prospects, RHP **Kendry Churio** (No. 75) and INF **Josh Hammond** (No. 92).
