SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots dropped the regular season finale against the Hartford Yard Goats 5-3 at TD Bank Ballpark in Bridgewater, NJ on Sunday afternoon.
 - The Patriots fell to 11-7 against the Yard Goats this season, including a 7-5 record at TD Bank Ballpark.
 - The Patriots closed the season 74-64, marking Somerset's best regular season record since 2024.
 - Patriots' pitching punched out 11 batters, marking the fifth time in the last six games Somerset struck out double-digit hitters. Somerset ended the regular season with a .269 K% - ranking fourth in Double-A.
- RHP Michael Arias (2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 K)** made his first start of the season.
 - Arias recorded his seventh consecutive scoreless outing to pump his scoreless inning streak to 12.0 innings to end the 2026 regular season.
 - After a 13.1 IP scoreless streak from April 30 to June 3, the 12.0 IP scoreless streak is Arias' second of 12.0-plus innings this season.
 - Across his last nine games, he's allowed a 0.60 ERA, 0.87 WHIP and .176 BAA with 14 K to 4 BB in 15.0 IP.
- RHP Chris Veach (2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 K)** worked his fourth consecutive scoreless outing across all levels.
 - Dating back to May 23, Veach registered nine scoreless outings in his last 10 games pitched across all levels. During that span, he posted a 0.73 ERA, 1-0 record, 0.65 WHIP and .100 BAA with 3 SV in 12.1 IP.
- CF Jace Avina (2-for-4, BB, R)** notched his 29th multi-hit game of the season.
 - Reaching base in 12 of his last 13 games of the year, Avina slashed .283/.356/.453 with 2 HR, 5 XBH and 6 RBI in that span.
 - Avina closed the season with a .254/.350/.467 slash line with 21 HR, 68 RBI and 16 SB.
- 3B Roderick Arias (2-for-5, 2 RBI, 1 SB, 1 R)** secured his ninth multi-hit game with Somerset this season.
 - Arias' stolen base was his career-high 38th this season, surpassing his 37 SB with Tampa in 2024.
 - Arias' 38 SB are tied for eighth in the Yankees minor league system.
- 1B Josh Moylan (1-for-3, BB)** ended his season on a season-long 11-game on-base streak.
 - During Moylan's 11-game on-base streak, he went 13-for-33 (.394/.459/.818) with 4 HR, 13 RBI and 6 XBH.
 - After hitting .223/.291/.490 with 16 HR and 40 RBI in his first 70 games of the season across all levels, Moylan debuted a new batting stance on July 11. After the switch, he ended the year slashing .271/.328/.525 with 13 HR and 40 RBI in 52 games.
- 2B Connor McGinnis (1-for-4)** finished the season with hits in three straight games.
 - After having a .547 OPS in his first 20 games at Double-A, McGinnis slashed .267/.353/.476 with 10 HR and 38 RBI in 62 games after clubbing his first Double-A home run on June 16 in Portland.
 - McGinnis ended with a .357/.460/.476 slash line with a HR, 8 RBI and 3 XBH in 15 games against Hartford this season.
