YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 6-4, in the completion of Tuesday's rain-suspended game. After the Baysox took a 1-0 lead with a leadoff homer by Reed Trimble in the first inning on Tuesday, play was stopped in the middle of the third due to rain. When play resumed, the Flying Squirrels took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the third with a two-run double by **Victor Bericoto**. In the fifth, **Diego Velasquez** hit an RBI triple to extend the lead to 3-1. **Aeerverson Arteaga** hit an two-run single in the sixth and **Turner Hill** scored on an error in the seventh to open a 6-1 lead. In the top of the eighth, Silas Ardoin singled in a run and Creed Willems hit a two-run double to pull the Baysox within two. **Tyler Myrick** stranded two runners on base in the ninth to close his fifth save of the season. **Nick Sinacola** took over when play resumed on Wednesday and threw three scoreless innings. In Wednesday's regularly scheduled game, the Flying Squirrels were shutout by the Baysox, 3-0. Chesapeake starter Trey Gibson threw a complete-game, one-hit shutout and struck out six batters. The Baysox scored their three runs in the fourth inning with RBI singles by Ardoin and Carter Young sandwiched around a run-scoring wild pitch.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play finale of a three-game home series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This is the second set between these two teams this year. The Baysox won four-of-six at The Diamond from April 15-20. The Flying Squirrels will head to Bowie for three games from Friday through Sunday and return to Prince George's Stadium for the final series between the two teams from August 19-24. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their second series win of the season if they can get a win tonight.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,622 fans per home game, which ranks seventh among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped four-of-six in last week's series against the Fightin Phils to open the second half, splitting the first four before dropping the last two. Of Richmond's 51 losses this season, 28 of them have been by two runs or less (18 by one, 10 by two). Their 18 one-run losses are the most in the EL, two ahead of Reading (16). The Richmond offense is last in the Eastern League in runs scored (243). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.59 ERA.

THE BAYSOX: went 1-5 to open the Eastern League's second half last week at home against the Curve. Chesapeake's roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects list, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 3), RHP Braxton Bragg (No. 9), RHP Trey Gibson (No. 10), RHP Levi Wells (No. 11) and RHP Nestor German (No. 13). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes six Baysox players, including Bradfield (No. 2), German (No. 10), C/1B Creed Willems (No. 11), Gibson (No. 14), Bragg (No. 15) and Bright (No. 25).

STRONG ARMS: Since June 16, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 3.30 ERA (40 ER/109.0 IP) in 13 games. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.01 ERA (6 ER/53.1 IP) in that stretch. Richmond's 2.08 ERA (9 ER/39.0 IP) in their last road set at Altoona from June 17-22 was their lowest of the season for a series and the best in the Eastern League for the week. The previous low was a 3.17 ERA (19 ER/54.0 IP) in their six-game series from April 15-20 against Chesapeake at The Diamond.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Joe Whitman** makes his 15th start of the season and his second against the Baysox. He last pitched on Friday against the Fightin Phils and threw four innings, allowing three runs, before being removed with no outs in the fifth. He faced the Baysox in his home debut on April 16 and allowed four runs over 2.2 innings in a loss, striking out five batters. After going 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA (5 ER/29.0 IP) in five May starts, Whitman has gone 0-3 with a 10.90 ERA (21 ER/17.1 IP) in his five starts since June 3. On May 3, Whitman threw six perfect innings against the Patriots at The Diamond, retiring all 18 batters he faced, and set a career high with 10 strikeouts. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 5. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. **For more on Whitman, see page two.**

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Right-hander Levi Wells makes his 10th start of the season and his third appearance against the Flying Squirrels. He began the season working out of the bullpen, including two his two outings at The Diamond in April. In his first appearance against the Flying Squirrels on April 15, he allowed one run over four innings. He followed with four scoreless, three-hit innings on April 20 in Richmond. Wells last pitched on Friday against the Curve and made his first scoreless start of the season, throwing five one-hit innings with four strikeouts. He went 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (9 ER/16.0 IP) in his first four starts of the season from April 26-May 17, but he has gone 0-2 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) in his last five starts since May 24. Wells was selected by the Orioles in the fourth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Texas State. In his professional debut season last year, he went 0-9 with a 6.21 ERA in 21 starts, throwing 60.1 innings.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan** and **Onil Perez** have combined to catch 43 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 29 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has the third-most runners caught stealing by a catcher in a single season in franchise history, trailing **Jackson Williams** (35 - 2013) and **Andrew Susac** (31 - 2013). For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 42 runners caught stealing for his career is tied with **Andy Thomas** (2023-24) for fifth most in franchise history, one behind **Johnny Monell** (43 - 2011-12).

BERI BOMBS: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** has homered twice in his last five games. He hit a solo homer on Wednesday and added another on Saturday. He has six homers with the Flying Squirrels this season, giving him 28 for his Richmond career dating back to 2023, which is the fourth-most in franchise history. He is two homers behind third-place **Jarrett Parker** (30). Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels on June 3.

SAVING THE DAY: **Tyler Myrick** recorded his fifth save of the season on Wednesday night in the completion of Tuesday's rain-suspended game against the Baysox. It was the 17th save of his Richmond career, tying home for seventh on the Flying Squirrels career saves list with **Heath Hembree**. He is three saves behind **Cody Hall** for sixth on the all-time list.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is ranked tied for fifth in hits (71), seventh in OBP (.370) and tied for eighth in walks (38). **Seth Lonsway** is fourth in innings pitched (75.1), tied for sixth in strikeouts (71) and eighth in ERA (3.58). **John Michael Bertrand** is second in innings pitched (78.0) and 10th in ERA (3.69). **Jack Choate** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (71).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 228 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 5), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 21) and **Jack Choate** (No. 26). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeerverson Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1978: The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 8-5, at Parker Field. Brian Snitker, who played just six Triple-A games in his career, and Terry Harper each hit RBI singles in the second inning. In the fourth, Snitker and Harper both drove in runs again and Larry Whisenton added an RBI triple. Glenn Hubbard brought home a run in the sixth with an infield hit. Bruce Benedict doubled home a run in the seventh. **1983:** The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 8-7, at Parker Field. Tidewater scored three in the top of the third, including an RBI single by Clint Hurdle, who later scored on the second Richmond error of the frame. In the bottom of the inning, Albert Hall scored on a wild pitch by Tides starter Ron Darling. Larry Whisenton cut the score to 3-2 in the fourth with a solo homer. Leo Vargas hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the sixth for a 4-3 Richmond lead. Another wild pitch by Darling scored Paul Runge in the seventh for a 5-3 lead. The Tides scored three in the eighth to take a 6-5 lead. Gerald Perry, who had committed an error in the top of the inning, led off the bottom of the eighth with a homer to tie the score. In the top of the 11th, Ron Gardenhire gave the Tides a 7-6 lead with a solo homer. In the bottom of the 11th, Steve Swisher tied the score with a pinch-hit sacrifice fly and Brad Komminsk hit a two-out, walk-off single to end the game. **2021:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, 2-1. It was their first full-capacity sellout of the year, drawing 9,560 fans, after early season crowd restrictions. Caleb Kilian started and allowed one run over six innings with nine strikeouts. Ronnie Williams threw the final three innings without allowing a run. Jacob Heyward tied the game, 1-1, with a solo homer in the second. Simon Whiteman hit a go-ahead RBI double in the bottom of the seventh. **2024:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 9-5, at Prince George's Stadium. Will Wilson gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the first with a sacrifice fly. The Baysox scored five runs in the third, including a three-run homer by Samuel Basallo, to take a 5-1 lead. Brandon Martorano hit an RBI single in the fourth to pull within three. In the seventh, Alerick Soularie hit a go-ahead grand slam to move Richmond ahead, 6-5. In the eighth, Ismael Munguia hit an RBI single. Jairo Pomares hit a two-run homer in the top of the ninth.
