YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 2-1. Binghamton walked off with a sac fly by Agustin Ruiz in the bottom of the ninth inning. Trailing, 1-0, with two outs in the top of the ninth, Brady Whalen drove a solo homer to tie the game. It was his third hit of the night. Binghamton opened the scoring in the third inning with a solo homer by Matt O'Neill, the only run allowed by Landen Roupp over 2.2 innings of work. Blake Rivera followed with 1.1 scoreless relief innings. Carson Seymour worked out of the bullpen and threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit with no walks and one strikeout. Binghamton starter Jose Chacin worked six scoreless innings and struck out seven batters.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels fourth the first of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first set in Binghamton since 2019. That year, Richmond swept a three-game set at NYSEG Stadium from June 21-23. Since 2017, the Flying Squirrels are 8-4 in Binghamton. They have won three consecutive road series in Binghamton, going 2-1 in 2017, 2-1 in 2018 and 3-0 in 2019. The last series loss for Richmond in Binghamton was a three-game sweep from June 24-26, 2016. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, 2021, but it was canceled. This year, Richmond is 4-2 against opponents from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped from a tie for first place in the Southwest Division down to fourth with Thursday's loss. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 13-of-their-last-20. Richmond has won three-of-five dating back to Saturday. The Richmond pitching staff has a 3.63 ERA, which is second in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 143.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 206.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 2.84 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have alternated wins and losses over each of their last nine games and split last week's series in New Hampshire. After starting the season 11-10, the Rumble Ponies have gone 8-12 in their last 20 games. Binghamton's .219 team batting average is the second-lowest in the Eastern League. Their 4.86 team ERA is ninth in the league and their 5.58 bullpen ERA is third-highest. Binghamton's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 11), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 12), RHP Junior Santos (No. 20) and RHP Luis Moreno (No. 24). Jose Peroza is rated as the organization's best defensive infielder. MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list includes RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 7), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 9) and RHP Junior Santos (No. 17).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack makes his eighth start and ninth outing of the season. Today is his first start against his former Mets organization. He last pitched on Saturday night against Akron and allowed four runs over 3.1 innings in a no-decision. After posting a 3.38 ERA in four April starts, he has a 10.13 ERA in four outings (three starts) in May. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Luis Moreno makes his eighth start and ninth appearance of the season. Last time out, he threw four innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision at New Hampshire on Sunday. He has allowed four-or-more runs in four-of-his-eight outings this season. Moreno signed as an international free agent with the Mets in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic. He split the 2022 season between Low-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn, going 8-7 with a 2.84 ERA in 25 games (17 starts). This year marks his first season at Double-A.

THE NEW GUY: Playing his second game with the Giants organization on Thursday, **Brady Whalen** picked up three hits, including a homer and a triple. With the Flying Squirrels trailing, 1-0, with two outs in the ninth, he hit a solo homer to tie the score. Whalen signed with the Giants as a free agent in December and missed the start of this year with an injury. He was activated on the Richmond roster on Saturday and played his first games for the Flying Squirrels this week in Binghamton.

HEY HAYDEN: On Wednesday night, **Hayden Cantrelle** homered twice for the second time in his career. He finished the night with three hits and four RBIs. He has reached base 10 times in his last five games dating back to Saturday, hitting .333 (4-for-12) with two homers, five walks, one HBP and five RBIs. For the year, Cantrelle is ranked sixth in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.407).

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered three times over a five-game stretch from May 17-21. He has driven in eight runs over his last eight games since May 17. In his last 16 games since May 6, he is batting .307 (19-for-62) with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. For the season, Aldrete is ranked tied for sixth in the Eastern League with 24 RBIs.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit last Thursday night and added his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a three-run shot to center.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated **Wade Meckler** on May 17 and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. This year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.427) and ranks tied for 10th in OBP (.474). He began the season with High-A Eugene and hit .456 in 20 games. He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 regular-season games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond relievers have posted a 2.84 ERA this season, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors. Of Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 15 innings and have not made a start this year, four Flying Squirrels relievers are ranked in the top-11 in ERA. **Raymond Burgos** has the lowest ERA (0.96), **Nick Swiney**, who is now in Triple-A, is ranked second in ERA (1.15). **Blake Rivera** (1.59 ERA) is sixth and **Wil Jensen** (2.00 ERA) is 11th. Out of all Eastern League pitchers, starters and relievers, who have thrown at least 25.0 innings this year, Jensen has the fourth-lowest ERA.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked sixth in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is eighth in batting average (.300) and tied for ninth in hits (39). Carter Aldrete is tied for sixth in RBIs (24). Riley Mahan is tied for sixth in RBIs (24). Hayden Cantrelle is sixth in OBP (.407). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3). Carson Seymour is ninth in ERA (2.94). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for ninth in strikeouts (46). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (4).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Rudick is fourth in batting average (.317), fifth in RBIs (25), first in OBP (.456), fifth in SLG (.563), third in OPS (1.019), eighth in hits (40), tied for fifth in doubles (10), sixth in walks (28), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (17), seventh in total bases (71) and fourth in runs scored (30). Jose Peroza is 10th in batting average (.292), eighth in SLG (.528), eighth in OPS (.917) and tied for fifth in doubles (10). Wyatt Young is tied for seventh in walks (27). Nate Lavender is tied for seventh in saves (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

The team also tied the franchise record for most hits in a game (22). Jarrett Parker went 4-for-5 with two homers and set the team's single-game RBI record with seven.
