### PLAYOFF BOUND

- The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.
- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series.
- This week marks Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.
- Omaha is 55-54 (.505) all-time in playoff games, with a 24-11 record (.686) in the Storm Chasers era (2011-present) and 19-14 (.576) under manager Mike Jirschele.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

- After winning the first half with a 49-24 record, Omaha finished the regular season as the best overall team in the International League as well, 30 games over .500 with an overall 89-59 record (.601 winning percentage).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .601 winning percentage overall this year ranked as the 9th-best ... the Palm Beach Cardinals (Cardinals Single-A) were the best team in Minor League Baseball at 83-47 (.638 winning %).
- 89 wins were tied for the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with Scranton/WB and behind Triple-A Sugar Land (93 wins) ... Omaha was 1 of 4 Minor League teams with 85+ wins.
- The Chasers were 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day between May 25 and September 6 ... Omaha also held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- A .601 winning percentage ranks as the 2nd-best in a season, in Triple-A Omaha franchise history ... the only team in club history with a better regular season winning percentage was the inaugural 1969 Omaha Royals (85-55, .607 winning %).

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- 86 of Omaha's 148 games this year were decided by 3 runs or less (58%), including 34 of 59 losses in 2024 (57%), with 18 of 59 losses by just one run (31%).
- Omaha was 27-18 in 1-run games this season ... the Chasers were tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron led the Minors with 33 wins by 1 run.
- Omaha's 41 saves were the 2nd-most in the International League, the 3rd-most at the Triple-A level and 5th-best in Minor League Baseball.
- Evan Sisk's 15 saves overall this year ranked 4th in the International League ... Evan had 13 of the team's last 14 saves ... he is the 15th pitcher in Triple-A Omaha history to save 15 games in a season ... the last to do so was **Jesse Chavez**, with 16 saves in 2011, which represents the Storm Chasers-era record.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

- Omaha outscored its opponents 792 to 662 this season, a +130 run differential.
- A +130 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just ahead of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (+127).
- Omaha ranked 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland Rockhounds led the Minors in run differential at +180 (674 to 494).
- +130 runs as the 2nd-best run differential in franchise history, trailing only the 1969 Omaha Royals that ended the year at +163 (805 to 642).

#### RELIEF AID

- Omaha's bullpen was one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.
- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.71 ERA, 1.33 WHIP and .220/.323/.347 opposing slash line ... the .218 opponents' batting average ranks tied 20th among all 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- Omaha's bullpen combined to not allow a run in 41 games this year, roughly one in every 3.61 games in 2024 ... the bullpen also had 21 games without a walk this season, including 12 times in the 2nd half of the season.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

- Omaha had 46 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (52%) of this year's wins were games where the Chasers trailed at some point.
- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 17 of the 46 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 9 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 13 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.

#### WATERS WORLD

- Outfielder **Drew Waters** was named the International League's Player of the Week for his efforts last week, in the final series of the regular season at Louisville.
- Waters led the league with .565 average, 1.067 slugging percentage and 1.687 OPS, going 13-for-23 at the plate with 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and 2 walks.
- He not only recorded at least one hit in the five six games he played in the series, but with 3 hits in each of his last four games, he became just the second Minor League player in 2024 to record 3+ hits in four straight games.

CAREER NOTES

- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) and combined to go 5-12 over 24 starts between the two levels, with a 5.28 ERA (63 ER in 107.1 IP)...

- Made his professional debut and largely split the season between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), with a stint on the 7-Day Injured List and rehab stint with the ACL Royals (R) as well...

- Drafted by the Royals in the 7th round of the 2021 MLB Draft, out of Central Arkansas... did not pitch professionally after being drafted (or during the college season), underwent Tommy John surgery in August 2020...

- 2018: Graduated from Central High School (Mo.) where he was a three-time First-Team All-Conference pitcher and first baseman... a four-sport athlete in high school was also a punter in football, goalie in soccer and shooting forward in basketball.
