## LAST TIME OUT: The Saints were able to get a split of their

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints were able to get a split of their doubleheader in Rochester on Tuesday, dropping game one 6-2 before rebounding for a 4-1 victory in the second game.

\$\mathbb{S}\$ Randy Dobnak was tagged for all six runs over 4.1 innings, walking three and striking out a pair in his start. After falling behind 6-0, Michael Helman singled in a run, followed by a Matt Wallner double to make it 6-2. Hobie Harris allowed a pair of inherited runners to score in relief, throwing 1.2 innings, not charged with any runs of his own. The Saints struck out just twice and struck out only one Red Wing hitter in the loss.

\$\mathbb{S}\$ In game two, Caleb Boushley made his first start since returning from the Big Leagues, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run baseball. Matt Wallner clubbed his sixth home run of the season in the third inning to give the Saints a 2-1 lead. The Saints would score four unanswered runs after the first inning to get the win. Josh Winder spun 2.0 innings of shutout relief picking up his first save of the season.

**MONTHLY REVIEW:** As May winds down, below is how the Saints have fared by month in 2024. Of note, the Saints 78 walks issued in May are the fewest in Triple-A.

MARTIN MASHING: By collecting a hit in both games of Tuesday's doubleheader, Austin Martin became the 22<sup>nd</sup> player in franchise history to register a 10-game hit streak. In his 10 games with the Saints, Martin is hitting .394/.551/.576. Since returning to the Saints' lineup on May 21, he ranks third in the IL with his .538 on-base percentage and seventh in with his .385 batting average. His nine walks since being optioned back are tied for the second-most in the league in that span.

**CUTTING DOWN K's:** In their 6-2 loss to Rochester in game one of the doubleheader, the Saints struck out just twice, the fewest in franchise history. They struck out only one Red Wing hitter, which is also the fewest in franchise history.

SERIES STUFF: By winning Saturday's game, the Saints clinched their first six-game series victory in their eighth such series this season. It is the longest into the season the Saints have gone in franchise history without picking up a full series victory. Last year, they accomplished it in their third series, in 2022 they did it in the first series and got it done in their fourth series in 2021.

RETURN OF ROYCE: The Minnesota Twins sent Royce Lewis to St. Paul on Major League rehab on Saturday. Lewis is the ninth Major League rehab player to join the Saints this season. Lewis is 3-for-12 with a double, a stolen base and a run scored.

\$\sigma\$ In 49 career games with the Saints, Lewis has hit .319 with 11 home runs, owning a .978 OPS. Six of his 11 home runs came in 12 games with the Saints last year. He's also gone 16-for-19 in stolen base attempts in his Triple-A career.

BULLPEN BRINGING IT: Over the last 13 games, the Saints bullpen has been locked in, going 4-1 with a 2.76 ERA, the third-best in Triple-A, in that span. The 58.2 innings the bullpen has thrown in that stretch are tied for the seventh-most of any staff in Triple-A. Their 21 walks issued are the second-fewest in the IL, sporting a league-best 1.16 WHIP, trailing only Round Rock's 1.09 WHIP, who's bullpen has thrown only 45.0 innings.

**LIFE ON THE ROAD:** The Saints are halfway through their 12-game roadtrip, taking four out of six games in Buffalo and will now play the first six games in Rochester. Below is how the Saints have fared offensively in the first versus the second week in their previous five two-week

LAST APPEARANCE: 5/22 @ BUF...made Saints debut, throwing 2.1 innings, allowing three runs on three hits, one home run, walking one and striking one out...all three runs were scored in the first inning on an Orelvis Martinez home run...allowed only three baserunners after the home run...allowed leadoff single in the second, retiring the next four batters to finish the start...primarily threw cutter (14 pitches, 29%)...took first loss in 5-1 Saints defeat.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: First start/appearance of 2024

FROM THE TWINS TO THE TWINS: The last 2 seasons for Plutko have been spent in the KBO, where he has dominated for the LG Twins, going 26-8 between the 2022 and 2023 seasons. After signing for \$500,000 in 2022, he went 15-5 in his first season, re-signing for \$ 1.4 million in 2023. He followed that campaign with a season that saw him go 11-3, but did not make it to the championship series due to a hip injury.

**REMEMBER THE PAC 12:** Plutko finished his career as one of the best pitchers in program history at UCLA, where he finished his three-year stint there with second-most wins (29), starts (52) and IP (351.1) in school history. His career ERA of 2.25 and 272 career strikeouts both rank 7th on UCLA's all-time lists. His sister, Sara, was a three-year soccer letterwinner at University of Oregon and his wife, Allison, was a four-year gymnast at UCLA and was on same team as gold medalist Carly Patterson.

LEAVE A MESSAGE AFTER THE TONE: When he was promoted to Triple-A Columbus (Cleveland organization) in September, 2021 he missed the phone call from Cleveland's Director of Player Personnel Carter Hawkins because he was at a friend's wedding. They had just got done saying, "I Do" and got done taking the bridal party photos. Got a call from Cleveland and he put it straight to voice mail. When the call came again his wife Allison prodded him to answer because it could be important, so he did.

NOT PERFECT, BUT STILL PRETTY GOOD: On June 2, 2018, Plutko was spinning a gem with Columbus, not allowing a baserunner until the ninth inning at Syracuse when he issued a one-out walk. He followed that with a fly out and a strikeout to finish off the no-hitter. It was just the ninth complete-game no-hitter in the IL since 2005. It continued a stellar stretch for Plutko, who took a no-hitter into the sixth just two starts prior with Cleveland against the Chicago Cubs
