#### By the Numbers

Lake County defeated Great Lakes 8-1 to open its 2025 season on Friday night. <u>The Captains' 7-run margin of victory was their largest Opening Day victory since 2017 (9-1 win at Dayton).</u>

11 players join the Captains for the first time to begin the 2025 campaign. This group includes 5 of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 CLE prospects: OF Jaison Chourio (#3/#58 MLB), LHP Jackson Humphries (#18), LHP Michael Kennedy (#19), LHP Josh Hartle (#23), and OF Alfonsin Rosario (#26).

3 coaches join the Captains for the 2025 season in: Bench Coach Yan Rivera, Pitching Coach Andrew Moore, and Assistant Athletic Trainer Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel. Rivera was Lake County's Bench Coach for its 2022 Midwest League runner-up squad.

### **CAPTAINS LOG**

LAST TIME OUT: On Friday night, after trailing 1-0 after the 1st inning, the Captains scored 8 unanswered runs to secure an 8-1 Opening Day road win over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond in Midland, Michigan. Lake County plated 2 runs in the 6th inning and 6 more in the 7th

WILKINSON WHIFFS FIVE: 2024 Midwest League All-Star LHP Matt Wilkinson (ND) got the 2025 Opening Day start for the Captains. The southpaw threw 5 strikeouts in 3 innings, allowing 3 hits, 1 unearned run, and 3 walks in 72 pitches (42 strikes).

SHUTDOWN BULLPEN: The Lake County bullpen tandem of RHP Kyle Scott (W) and LHP Adam Tulloch (SV) combined to pitch 6 scoreless innings of relief for the Captains. In his High-A debut, Scott allowed just 2 hits and 2 walks, striking out 5 across 2.2 innings. Tulloch then struck out 3 in 3.1 frames, allowing just 1 hit and 1 walk.

DEUCES WILD: 3B Juan Benjamin had an impressive showing in his High-A debut. Lake County's 9-hitter went 2-for-3 with a double, and RBI single, 2 walks, and 2 stolen bases. The 21-year-old became the 1st Midwest League player with 2+ H, 2+ SB, and 2+ BB on Opening Day since 2009.

NOW WALK IT OUT: 1B Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 5 Cleveland prospect, drew 4 walks on Friday night, reaching base in 4 of his 5 plate appearances. <u>The 19-year-old became the 2nd Midwest</u> <u>League player to draw 4+ BB on Opening Day since 2005, joining 3B</u> John Whittleman of the 2007 Clinton LumberKings (then-TEX).

SHAKE AND BAKE: LF Esteban González & DH Wuilfredo Antunez both recorded 2 hits and 2 RBI on Friday night. The pair became the first pair of Captains teammates to do this on Opening Day since 2016 (SS Willi Castro & 1B Anthony Miller).

THE GOOD AND THE BAD: As a team, the Captains drew 11 walks while striking out 12 times. This performance marked the first time that Lake County recorded 11+ BB and 12+ K in a game since 7/13/2012 vs. Wisconsin.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win backc-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles

#### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

THE 14-YEAR VOYAGE IS COMPLETE: <u>The Captains won their 2nd championship in franchise history, and their 1st since 2010, the team's 1st year in the Midwest League.</u> This year marked Lake County's 4th Midwest League Championship Series appearance, and 2nd in the last 3 seasons. The Captains also appeared in the 2003 South Atlantic League Championship Series in their 1st season as a franchise.

REGULAR SHOW: Lake County went 77-53 during the 2024 regular season, owning the best winning percentage in the MWL for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in the last 3 seasons. The Captains' 77 wins were tied with the 2010 MWL Championship team for the 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in a season in franchise history.

NO SCORE ZONE: Lake County led the Midwest League with a 3.55 ERA, securing its 2<sup>nd</sup> league ERA title and 1<sup>st</sup> since leading the South Atlantic League in 2003. Former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Trenton Denholm won the MWL individual ERA crown with a 3.29 ERA, while fellow former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Carter Spivey finished 2<sup>nd</sup> with a 3.32 mark. Denholm was the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain to lead the MWL in ERA since the team joined the league in 2010.

TUGBOAT CRUISE: Last year, LHP Matt Wilkinson led Milb with an average of 13.20 K/9 across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg. He also ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in Milb with 174 strikeouts, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP. Wilkinson nearly became the 1<sup>st</sup> Minor League pitcher to win both the Milb ERA and strikeout titles since eventual 3-time MLB All-Star and 2-time World Series Champion Josh Beckett did so in 2001 across Class A-Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Portland.

WELCOME BACK, OMIR!: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would be returning for his 3<sup>rd</sup> season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains franchise history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 142-117 (.548) record at the helm, Santos is 29 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.

CHAMPS BACK FOR ANOTHER: 17 of the 28 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster return from the Captains' 2024 Midwest League Championship team. This group includes 2 of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 CLE prospects in 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez and C Jacob Cozart.

M-V-P! M-V-P!: OF Jaison Chourio, MLB Pipeline's No. 3 Cleveland and No. 58 MLB prospect, had a remarkable season last year with the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The 19-year-old was named the 2024 Carolina League MVP and Top MLB Prospect, while also being named Baseball America's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Minor League Player of the Year.

NEW FACES FROM NEW PLACES: 3 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster were acquired in offseason trades. OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 26 Cleveland prospect, was acquired from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for former Captains and Guardians RHP Eli Morgan on Nov. 20, 2024. Then, on Dec. 10, LHP Michael Kennedy and LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 and 23 Cleveland prospects, respectively, were acquired from the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Guardians also received RHP Luis Ortiz as part of a trade package in exchange for INF Spencer Horwitz.

**LAST TIME OUT:** In the winner-take-all Game 3 of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series, **Dylan DeLucia** (ND) pitched 4.2 scoreless innings in the Captains' eventual 9-4 championship clinching win. The right-hander allowed just 3 hits and 1 walk, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 84 pitches (55 strikes).

**DYLAN AGAINST THE LOONS: DeLucia** fared very well in 2 starts against Great Lakes in 2024. <u>The right-hander tallied a 1.08 ERA against the Loons, allowing just 2 hits, 1 earned run, and 4 walks, while throwing 13 strikeouts in a combined 8.1 innings of work. This includes a strong performance on Aug. 13, 2024, in which he recorded pro career-highs in innings pitched (5.0, since tied) and strikeouts (9).</u>

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: DeLucia** was named Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, on Aug. 26, 2024 for his 2 strong starts at West Michigan. In his 2 starts against the Whitecaps, he pitched 9.2 shutout innings, allowing 4 hits and a walk while striking out 8. **DeLucia** was 1 of 5 Minor League pitchers to make 2 scoreless starts. *In his 3 starts from August 13 to August 25, DeLucia recorded an 0.61 ERA, a .122 opposing AVG and 17 strikeouts.* 

**RETURN FROM INJURY:** After undergoing Tommy John surgery in June of 2023, **Dylan DeLucia** returned in 2024, making 2 starts for the ACL Guardians and 3 for Single-A Lynchburg. With the ACL Guardians, he made 2 scoreless starts and pitched 5 shutout innings, allowing 3 hits and striking out 3 in his first appearances since the 2022 College World Series at Ole Miss. From July 1 to July 21 with Lynchburg, he posted a 4.15 ERA (4 earned runs) while striking out 10 across 8.2 innings. *In his 3 starts for the Hillcats, DeLucia threw 69% of his pitches for strikes.* 

OMAHA LEGEND: DeLucia spent his 3rd and final season of college baseball with Ole Miss in 2022, where he led the Rebels to their first College World Series title and won CWS MOP. In the CWS, he pitched went 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA (1 earned run), 17 strikeouts and no walks in 16.2 innings. On June 23 versus Arkansas – his last college start – he pitched a 9-inning, complete game shutout to send Ole Miss to the CWS Finals. DeLucia threw 100+ pitches in each of his last 4 starts in the Super Regionals and College World Series. There are 35 pitchers to win CWS Most Outstanding Player, including 2024 All-Star Game starting pitcher Paul Skenes (LSU, 2023), former Cleveland Guardian and Lake County Captain Adam Plutko (UCLA, 2013) current Athletics manager Mark Kotsay as a two-way (Cal State Fullerton, 1995), and Baseball Hall-of-Famer Dave Winfield as a two-way (Minnesota, 1973).

**HOTTY TODDY:** In 2022 at Ole Miss, **DeLucia** was named a 3<sup>rd</sup> Team All-American by Baseball America, starting 12 of 21 games in Oxford, MS. The Port Orange, FL native ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in the SEC in innings pitched (95.1), 2<sup>nd</sup> in strikeouts looking (33), 4<sup>th</sup> in in strikeouts (105), and 12<sup>th</sup> in ERA (3.68). In the Coral Gables Regional on June 4, he fanned a career-high 12 batters in a 7-4 win against Arizona. **College Major: Multi-Disciplinary Studies.** 

JUCO BANDIT: After spending the 2019 fall season at the College of Charleston, **DeLucia** pitched 2 seasons at Northwest Florida State College in Niceville, FL from 2020-21, where he was 1st Team All-Conference and 2nd Team All-State. In 23 career appearances and 18 starts, he was 15-2 with a 1.91 ERA, 163 strikeouts and 32 walks across 127 innings. In 2021, he led NJCAA Region 8 with 119 strikeouts and 9 wins. 2 notable NWF alumni are 11-year MLB pitcher and 2005 Lake County Captain Tony Sipp and 11-year MLB outfielder and former Cleveland Indian Jason Michaels.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his final start of the season on Sept. 7 vs. Bowling Green (TB). Pitched 5.2 scoreless innings suffering just one hit. Kennedy also fanned a career-high 10 batters, marking the first time in his professional career that he notched double digit strikeouts. His 5.2 innings pitched was his second-longest start of his Minor League career.

WELCOME TO THE LAND: On Dec. 10, 2024, Kennedy was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with fellow Captains LHP Josh Hartle and current Guardians RHP Luis Ortiz, in exchange for INF Spencer Horwitz.

HIGHLY TOUTED: Kennedy enters the 2025 campaign as the Guardians' No. 19 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. In his career with the Pirates organization, the left-hander compiled a 3.11 ERA, with a 158/44 K/BB ratio over 130.1 innings pitched. In 2024, **Kennedy** had just a 6% walk rate, which ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> among teenagers in the entire Minor Leagues.

ROOKIE BALL LEGEND: With the FCL Pirates in 2023, Kennedy was awarded FCL Pitcher of the Month for August and was named a Baseball America Rookie Leagues All-Star. In August, he had a 0.61 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched, holding opponents to just a .109 AVG. Kennedy threw back-to-back scoreless starts on 8/8 and 8/15, tallying 8.2 straight scoreless innings. Kennedy's 0.61 ERA in August ranked 3rd in all of Rookie Ball (min. 14 IP), and his 6.00 K/BB ratio ranked 4th in all of professional baseball in the month of August.

FIDGET SPINNERS: During 2024 Spring Training, Kennedy was bored in his house in Bradenton, Florida, so he decided to purchase fidget spinners from Amazon. He brought them to the clubhouse, and they were an immediate hit. As a result, the left-hander purchased a Pirates branded fidget spinner for each Single-A Bradenton pitcher. That season, Kennedy finished top-5 on Bradenton in strikeouts (80), games started (15), and innings pitched (73), proving the fidget spinners to be effective.

HIGH SCHOOL STARDOM: A two-way star in high school at Troy High School in Troy, New York, Kennedy was named New York's 2022 Gatorade Player of the Year following an incredible senior season both at the plate and on the mound. As a pitcher, the southpaw did not lose a single game in his high school career, going a perfect 13-0. In his senior season, he boasted a 0.61 ERA, adding 65 strikeouts to just 8 walks. In the final game of his high school career, Kennedy threw a no-hitter vs. Albany Academy, propelling Troy to the Section 2 Class A Semifinals. As a hitter, he was just as good, finishing his high school career batting .437 while slugging 7 home runs.

#### CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4<sup>th</sup> player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1<sup>st</sup> career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1<sup>st</sup> player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. Burgos made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

**INF Angel Martínez:** On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

**INF/OF Daniel Schneemann:** On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

**1B/OF Trenton Brooks:** On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1<sup>st</sup> base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
